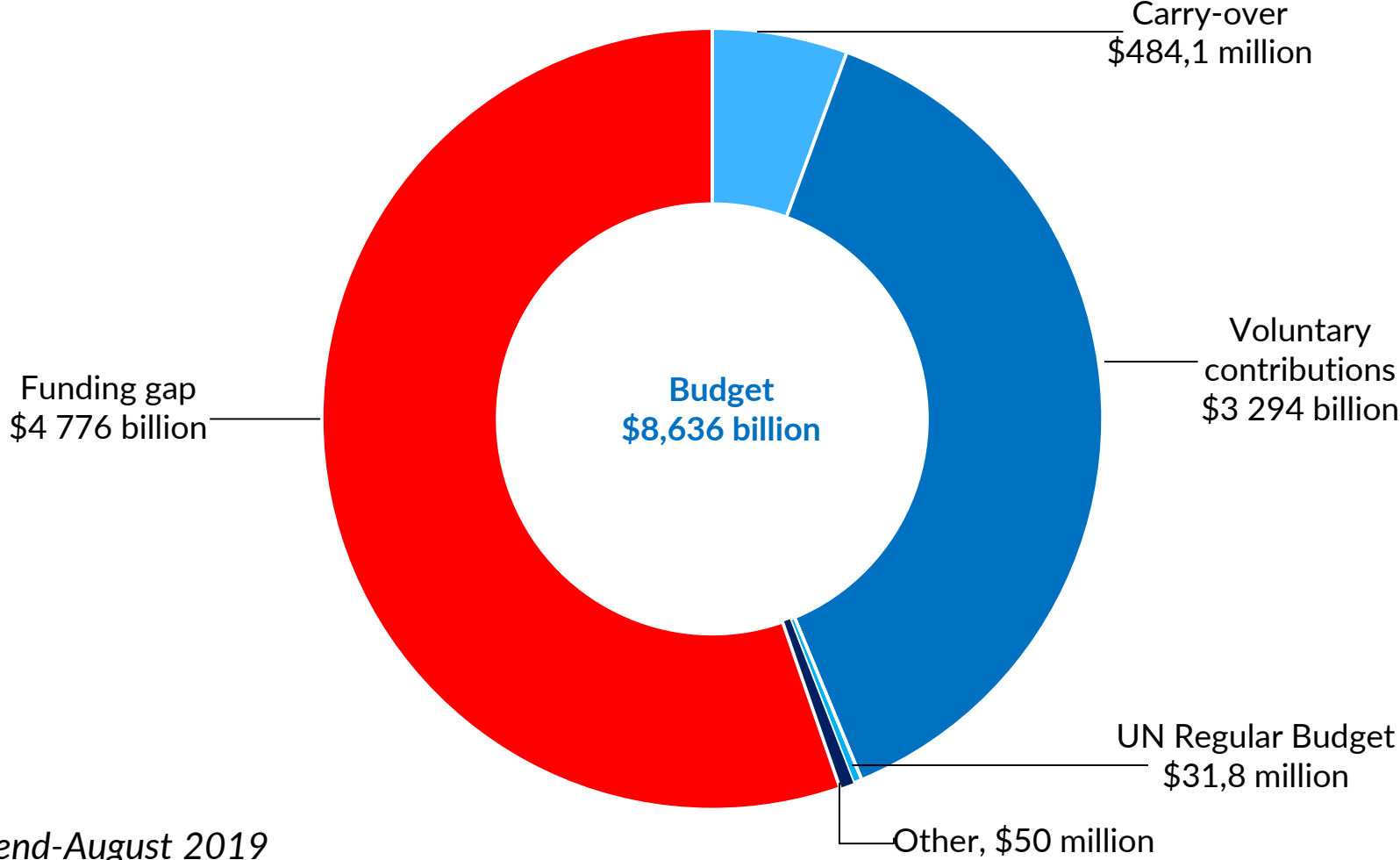

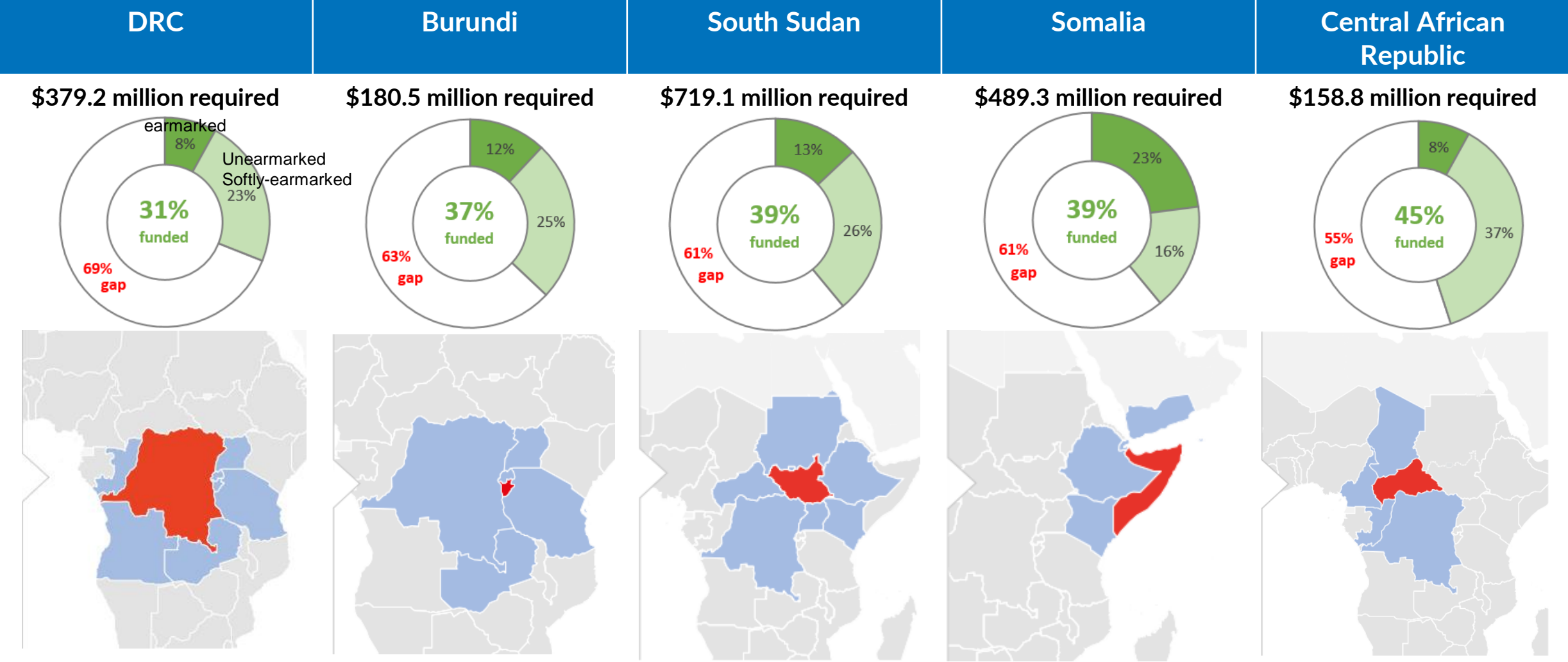
# 2019 Funds available

millions

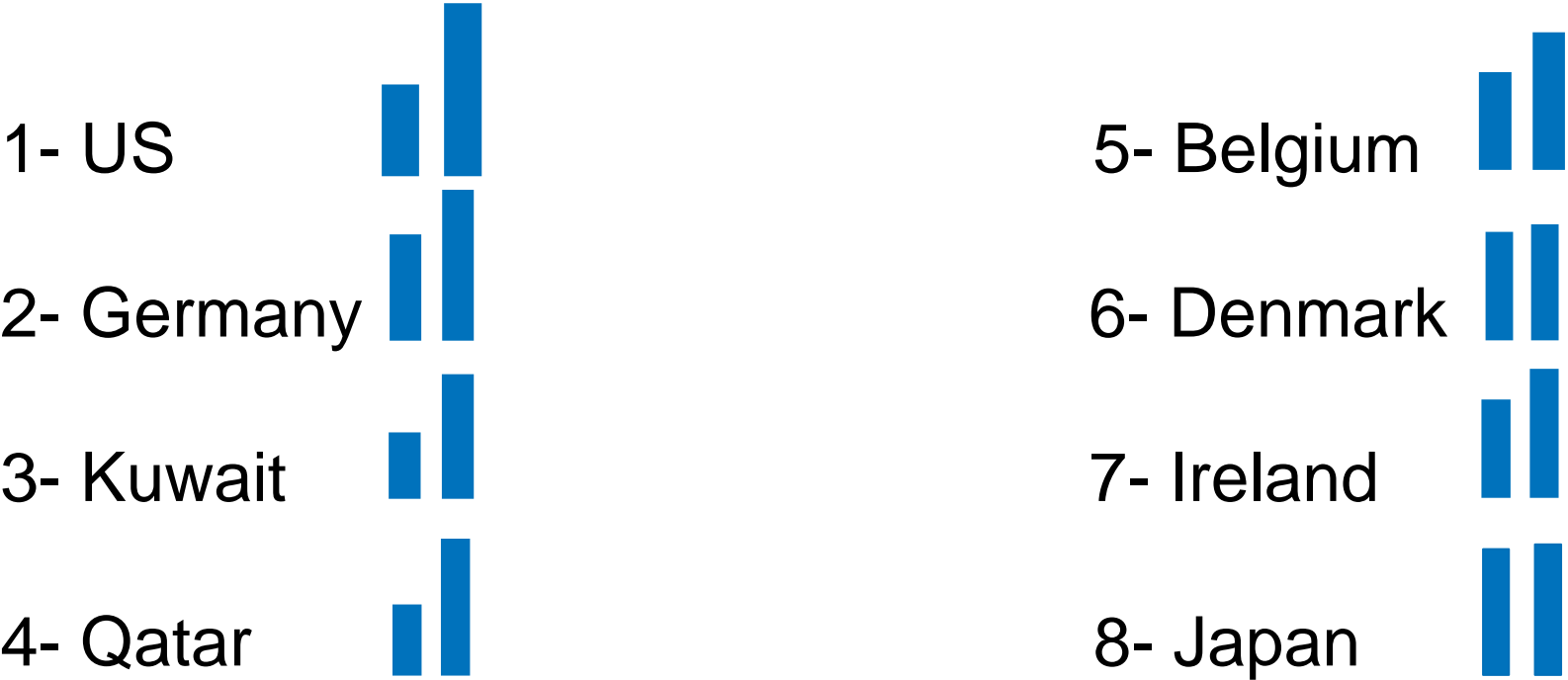

# Most underfunded situations

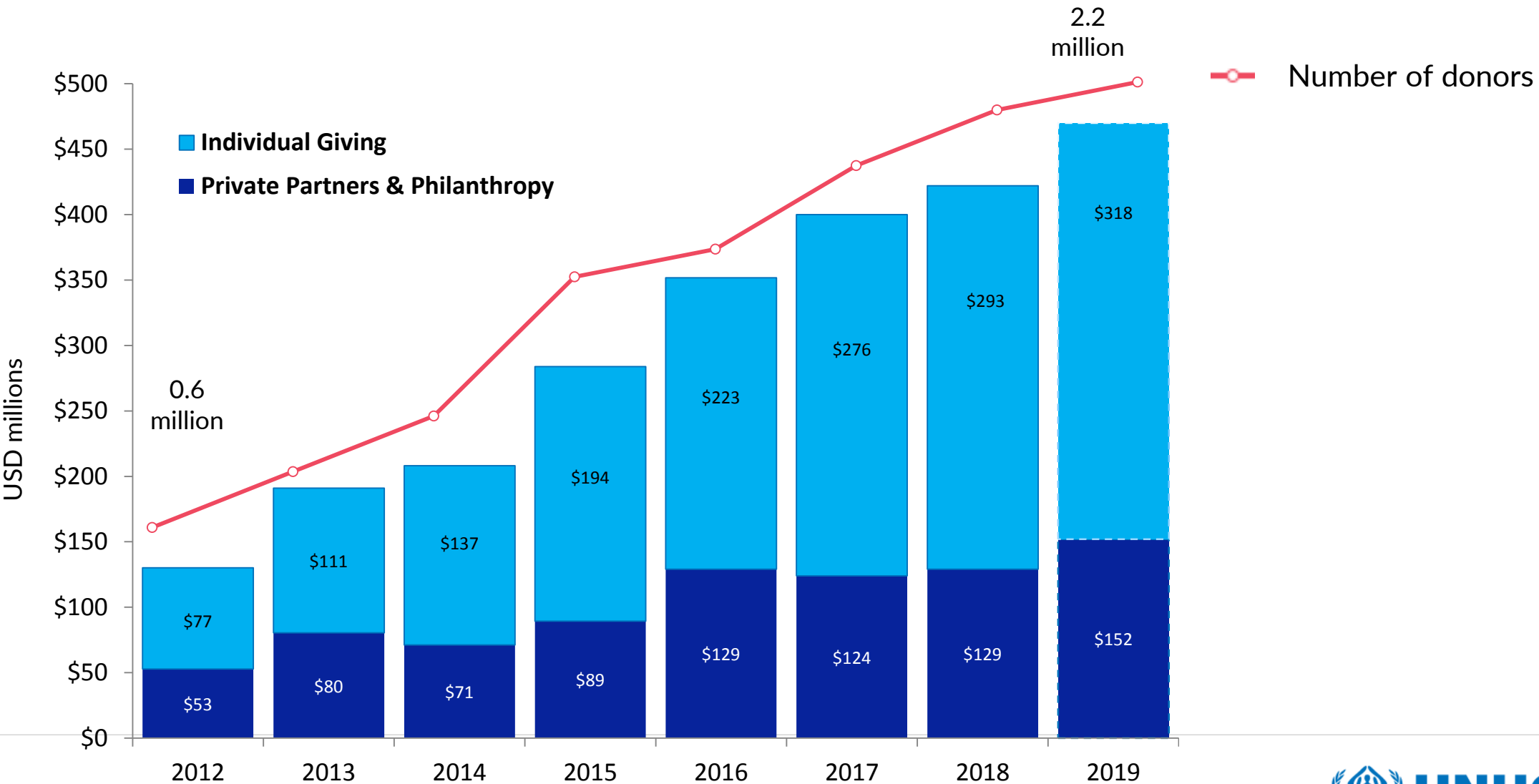


# More predictable support in 2019

- Several governments have contributed more to UNHCR in 2019 than they did to this date last year:

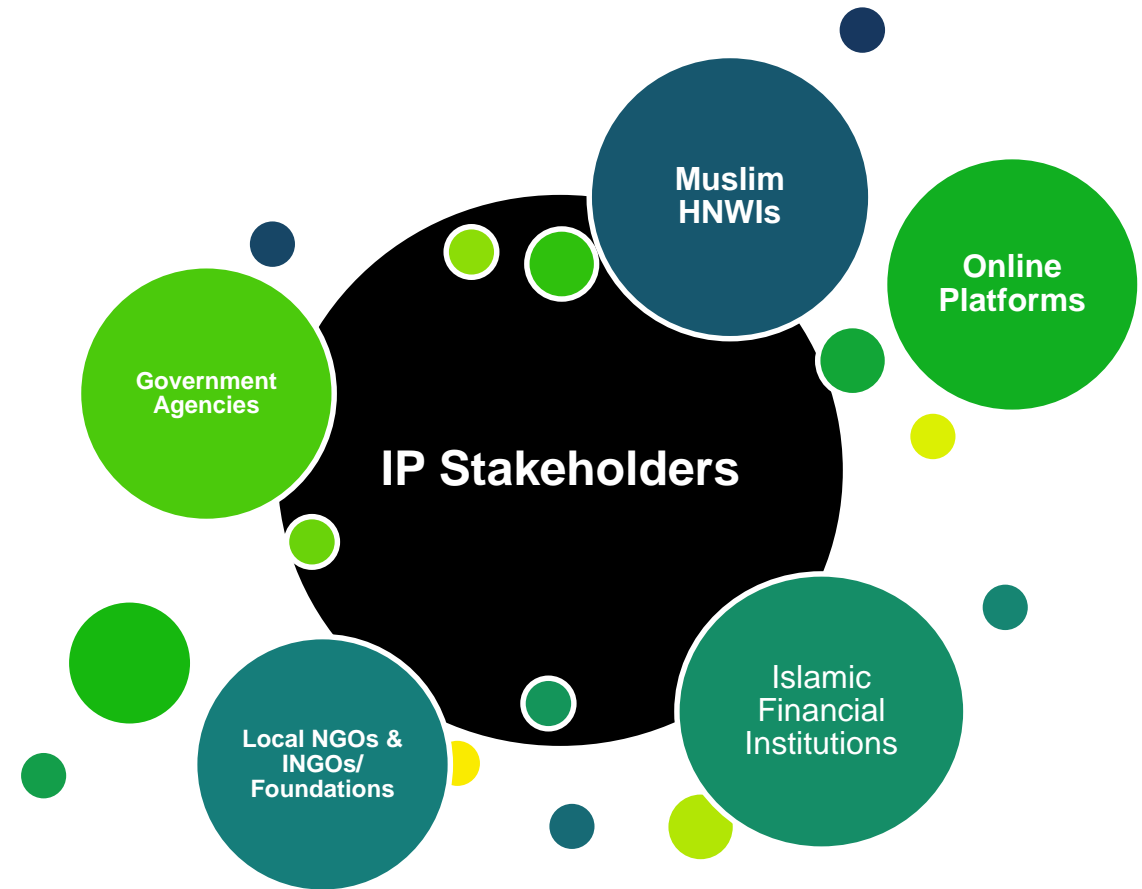


# Private sector income | 2012-2019



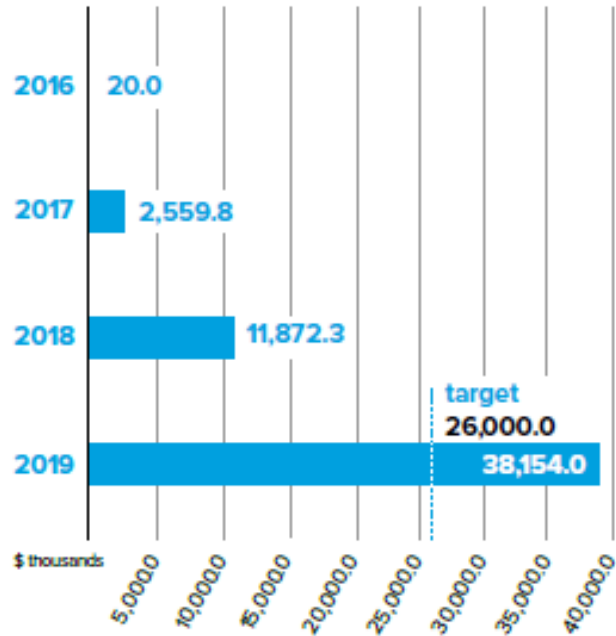
# Potential of Islamic philanthropy

- Zakat funds solicited by UNHCR since 2016 are earmarked for cash-based interventions



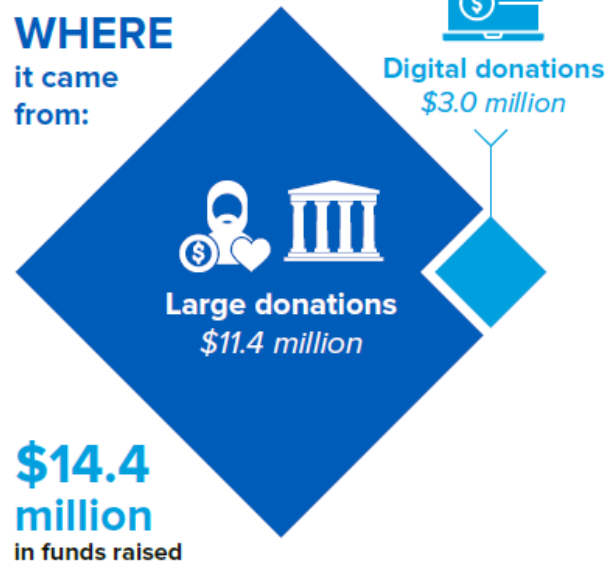
# UNHCR's Refugee Zakat Fund

## Zakat fundraising by year



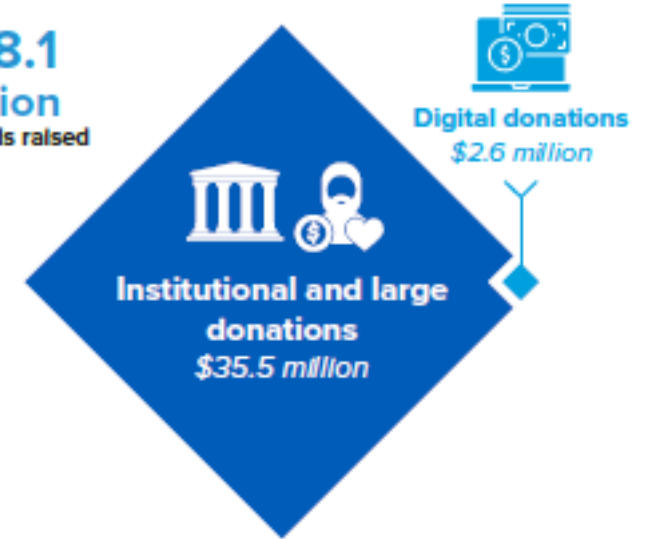
