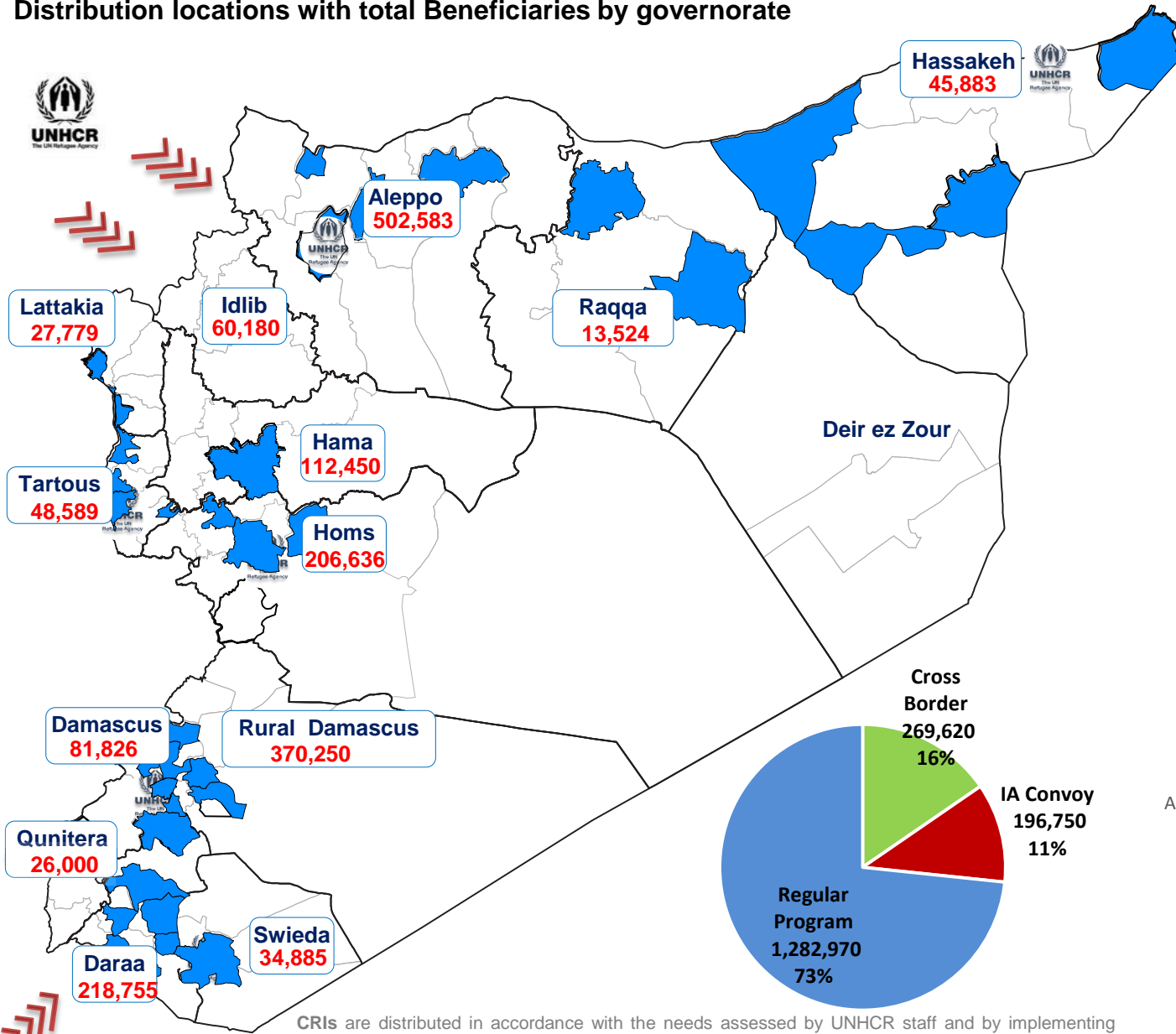

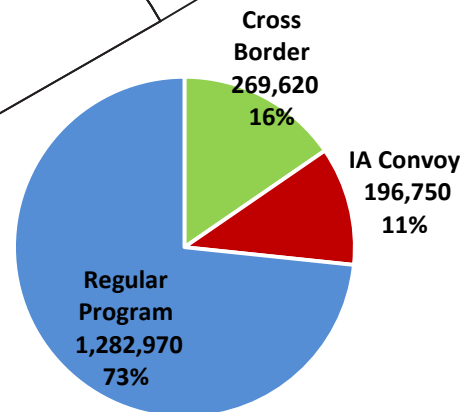
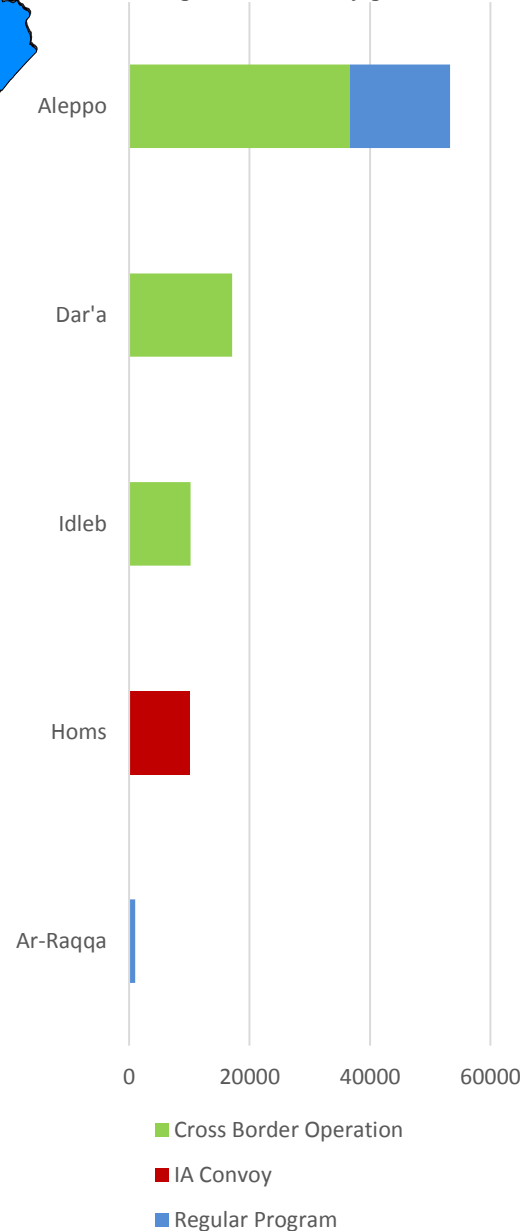

Distribution locations with total Beneficiaries by governorate



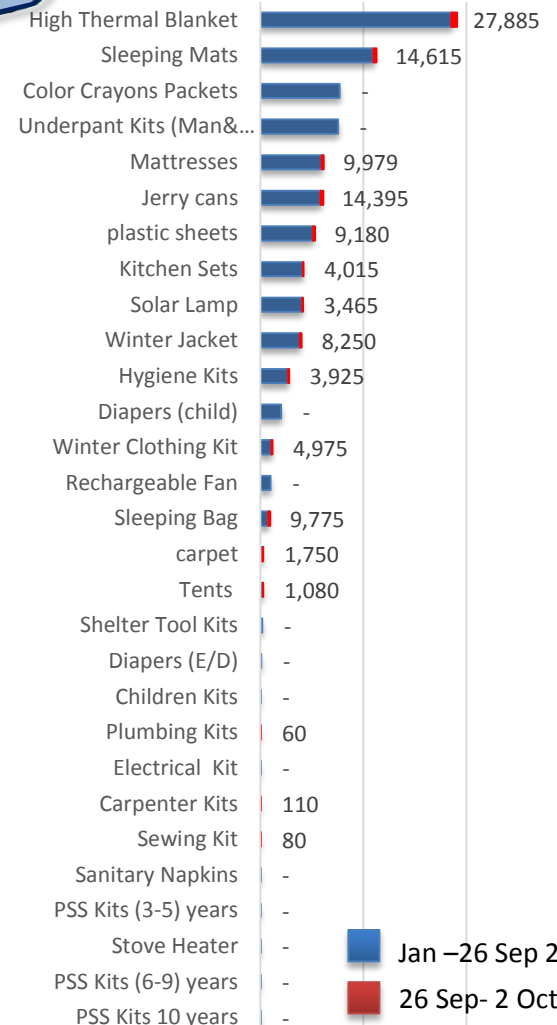
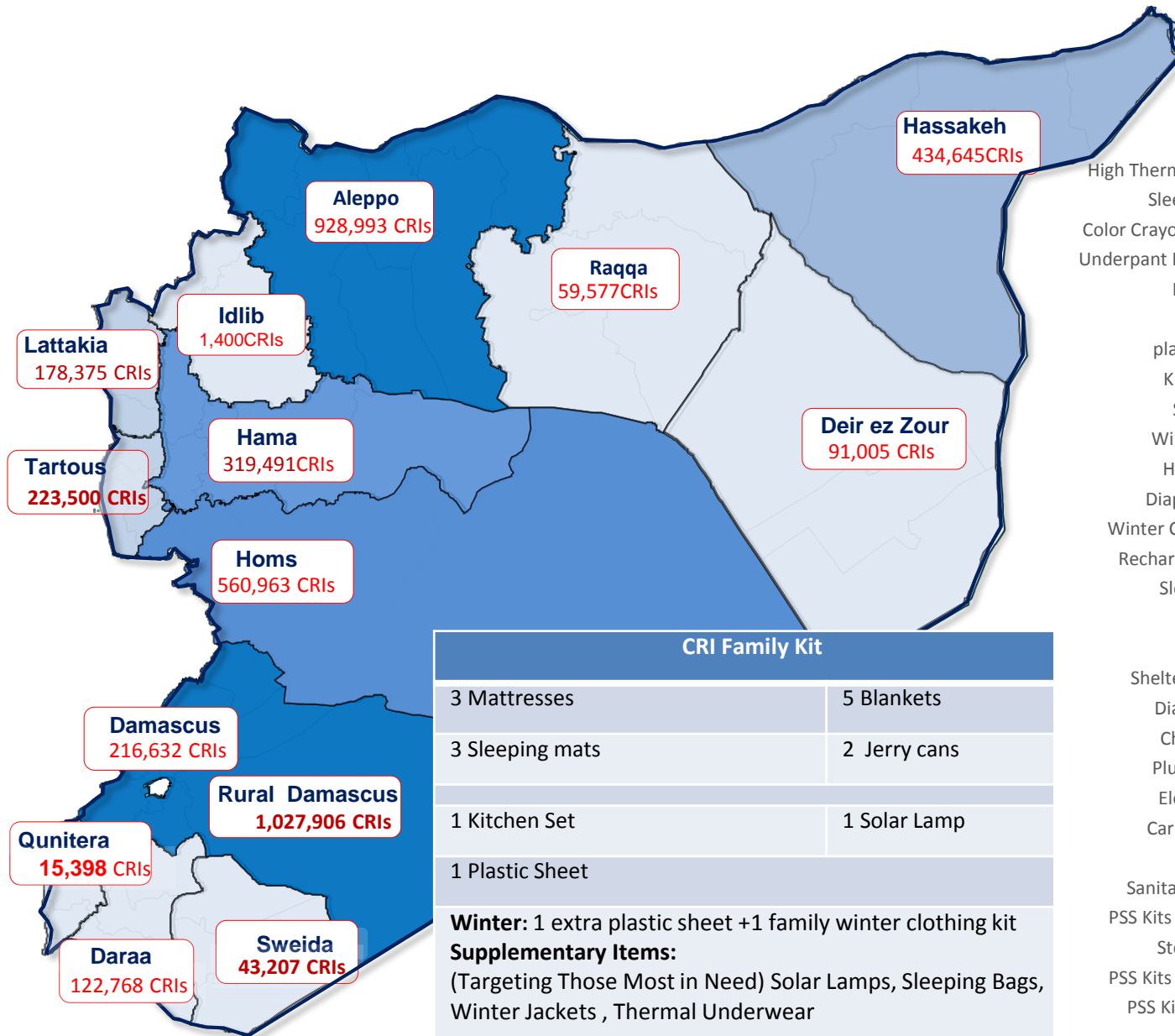
Aug Beneficiaries by governorate
