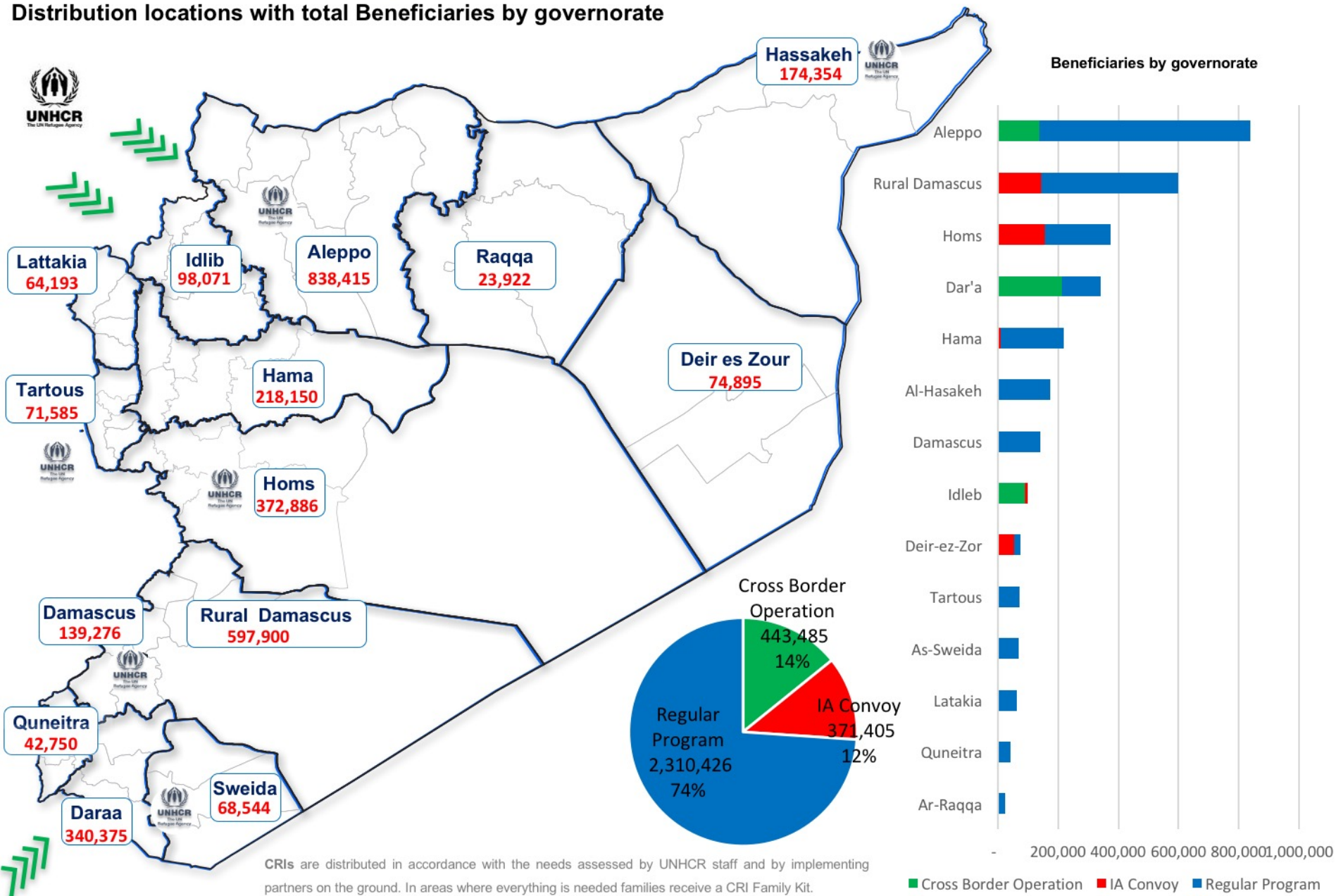

Distribution locations with total Beneficiaries by governorate

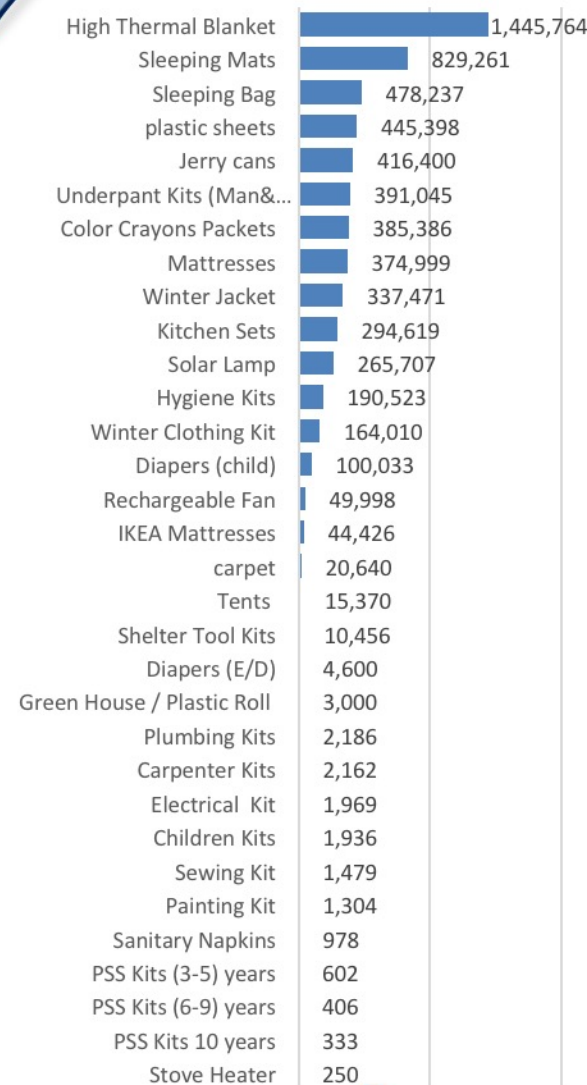
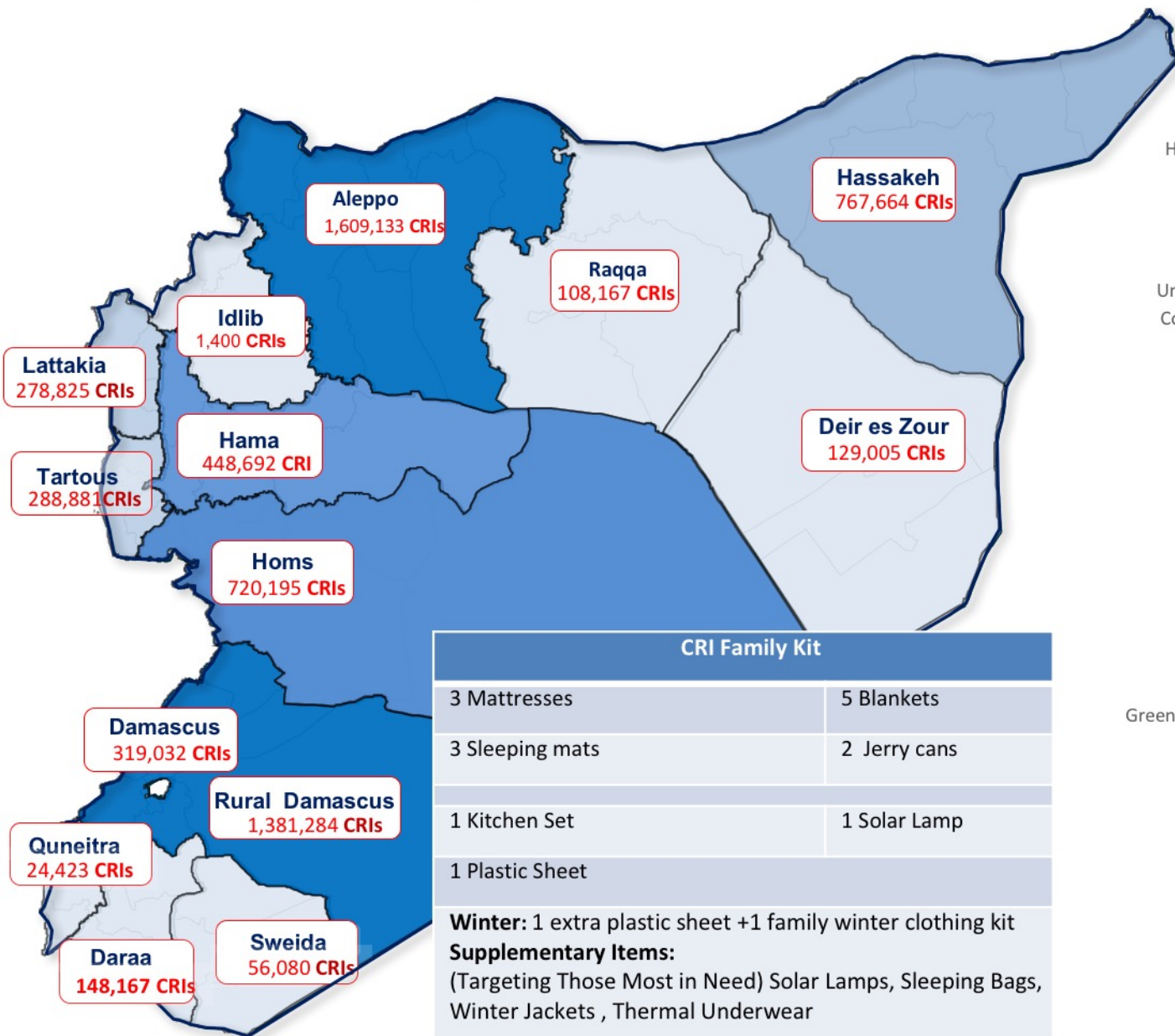

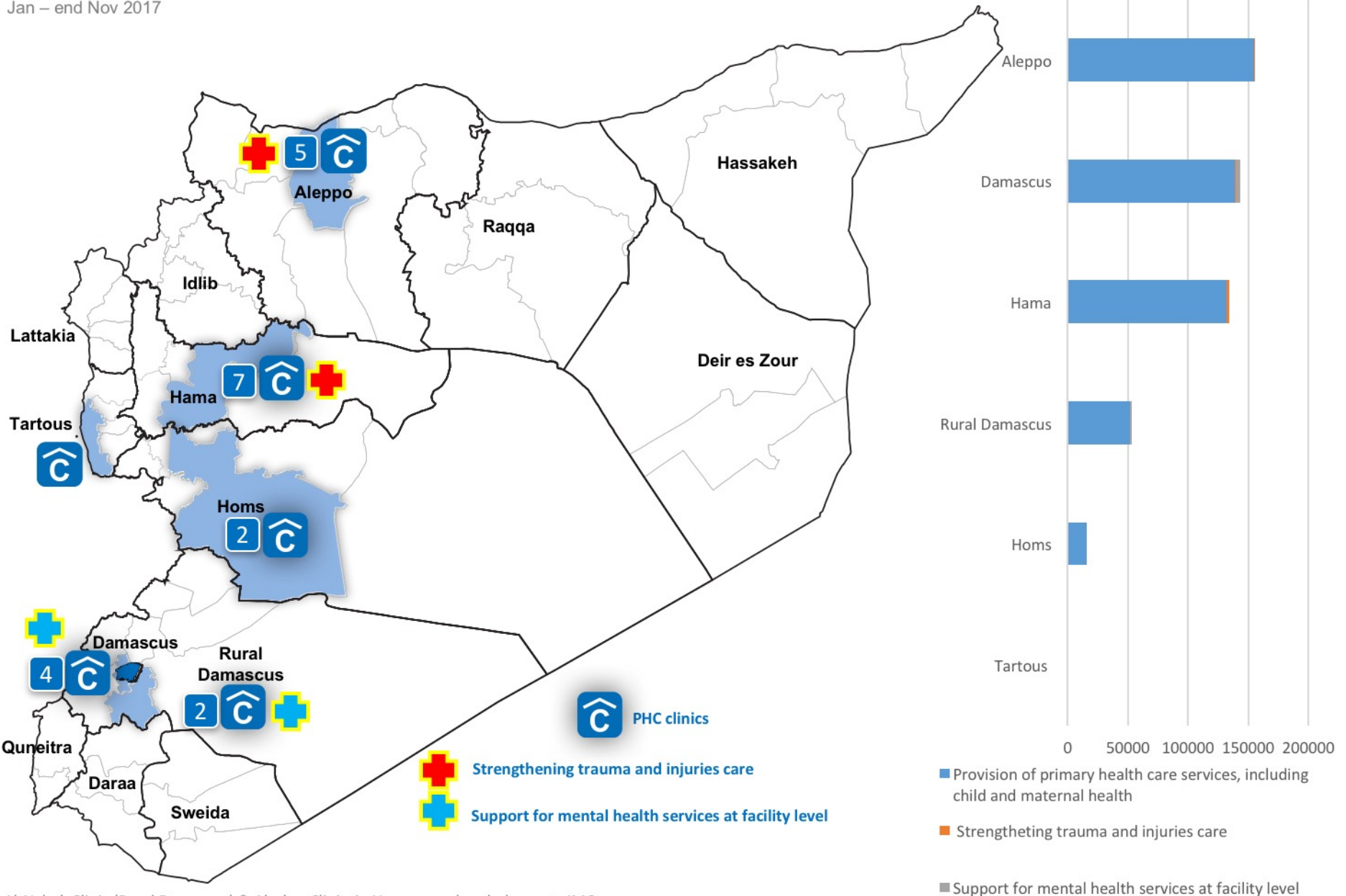

# 502,268 Beneficiaries have access to Health Care

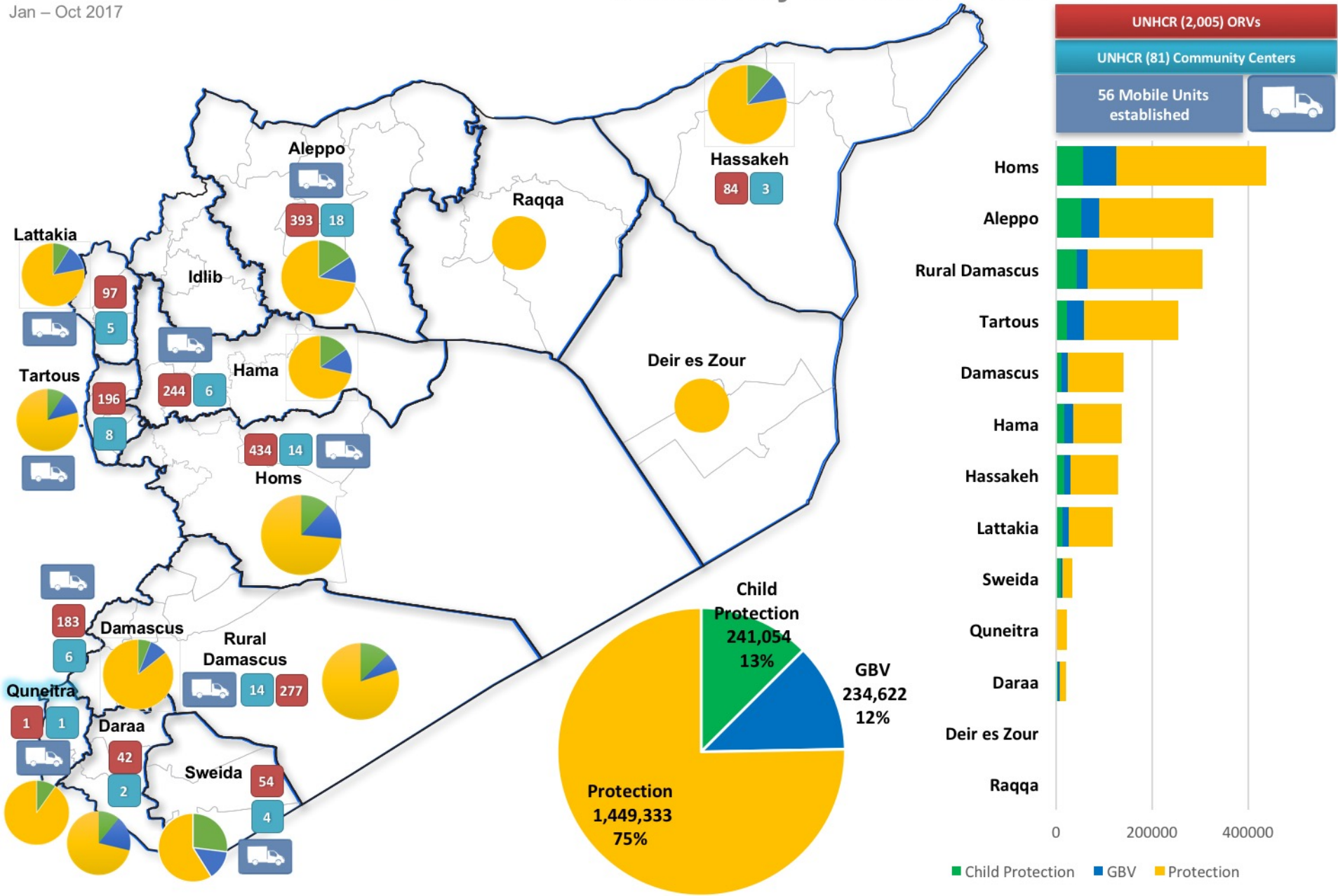
