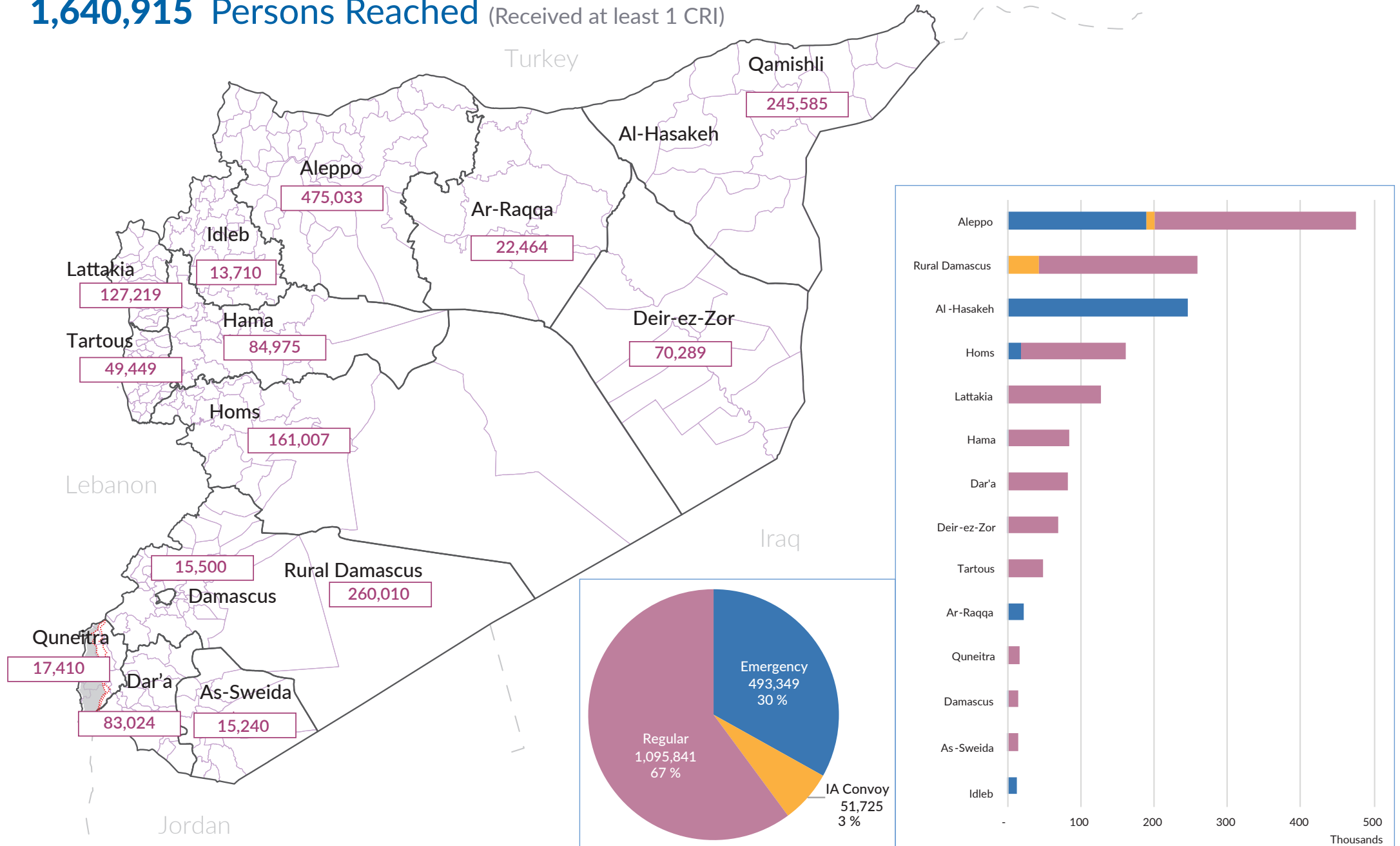

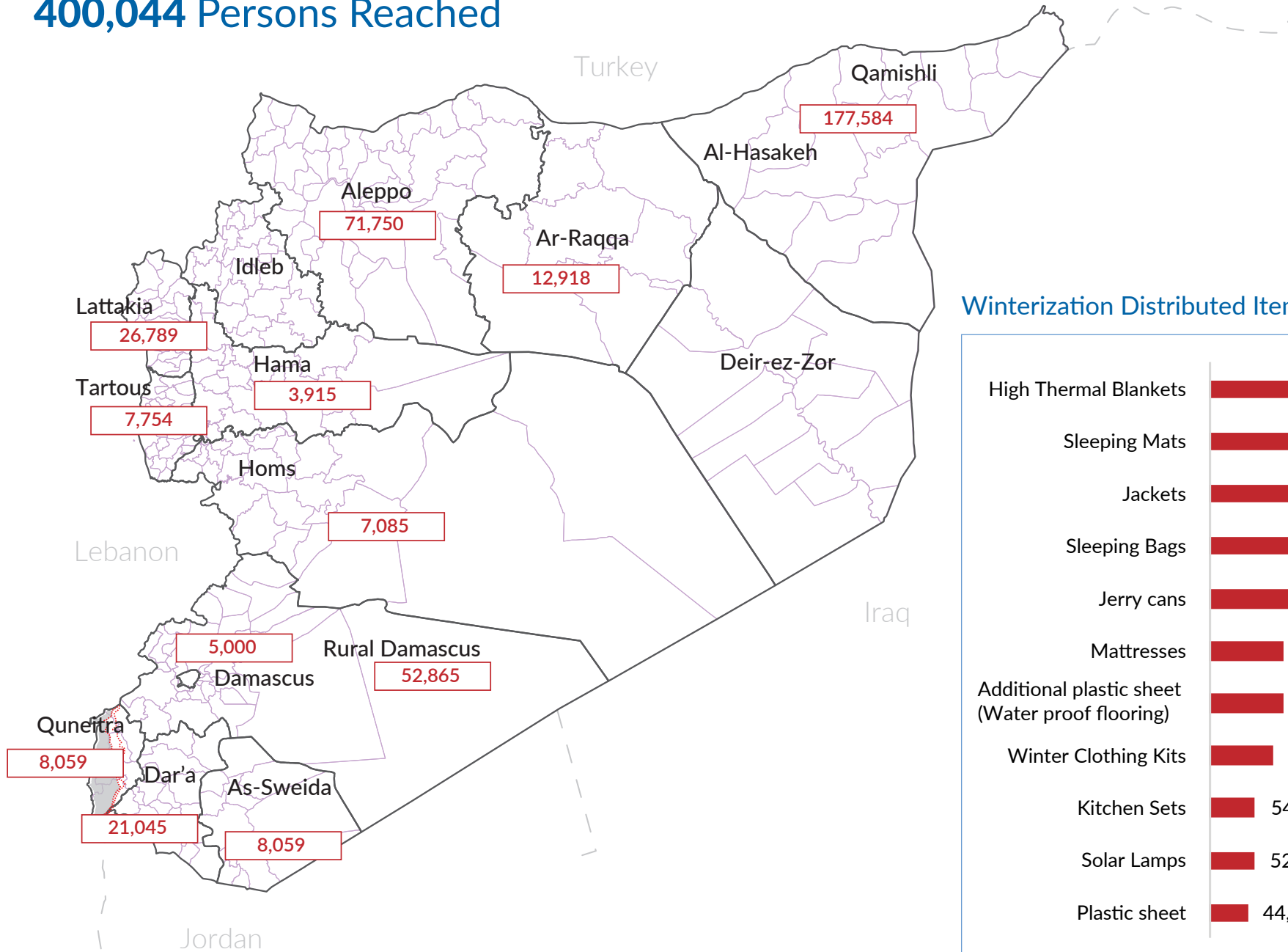
# UNHCR SYRIA CORE RELIEF ITEM (CRI) DISTRIBUTION

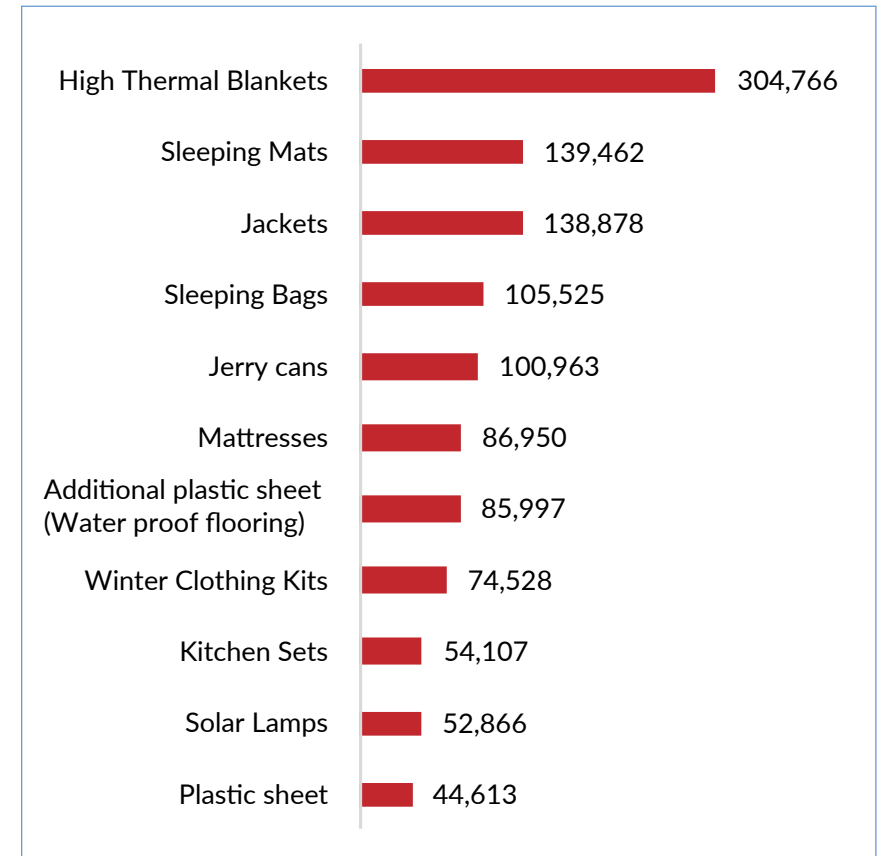


# UNHCR SYRIA WINTERIZATION PROGRAMME 2019/2020

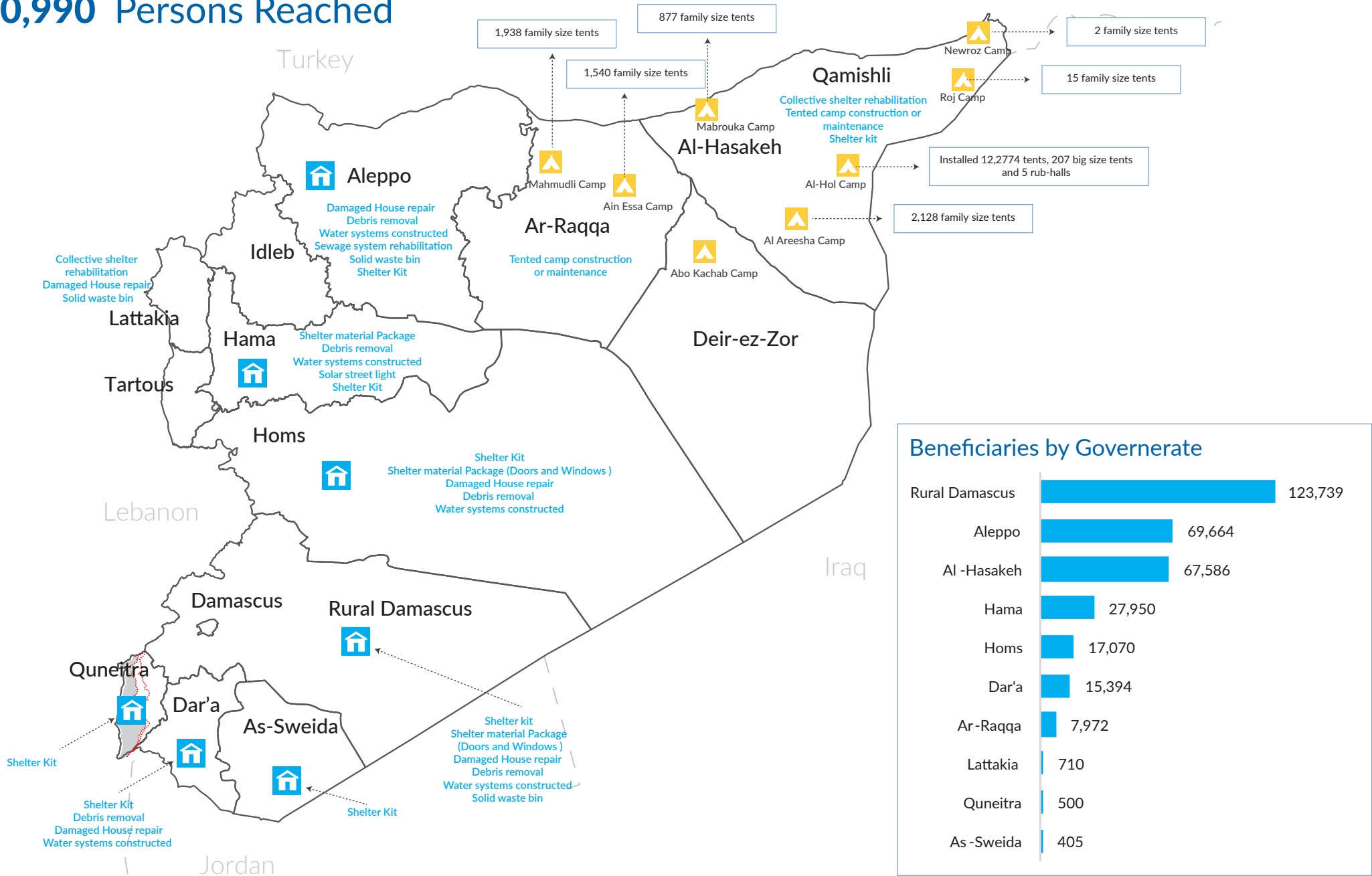

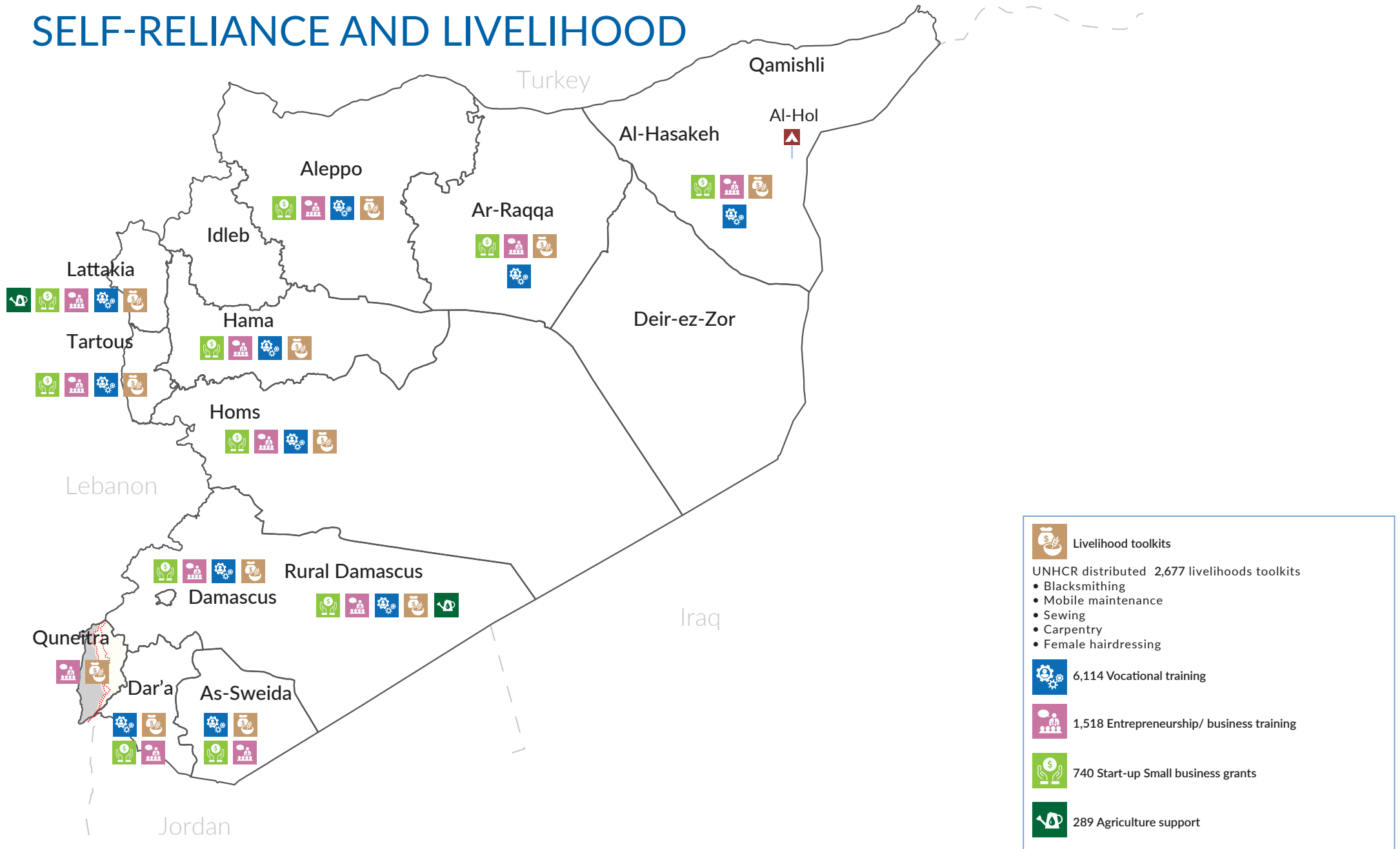

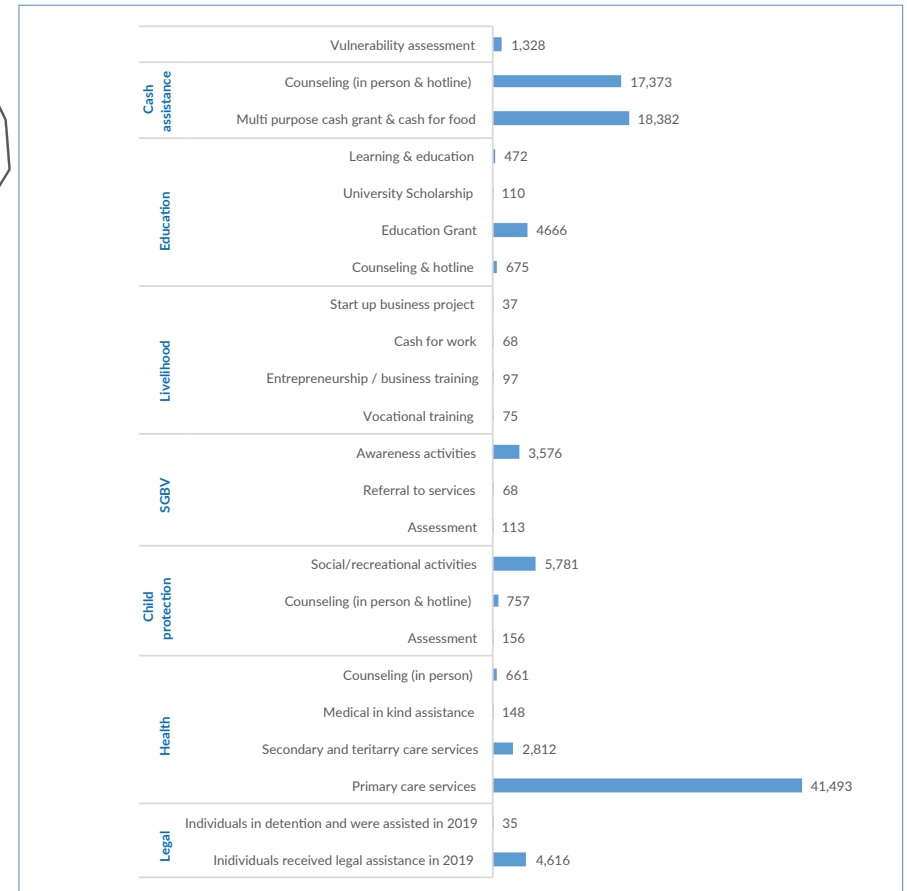
