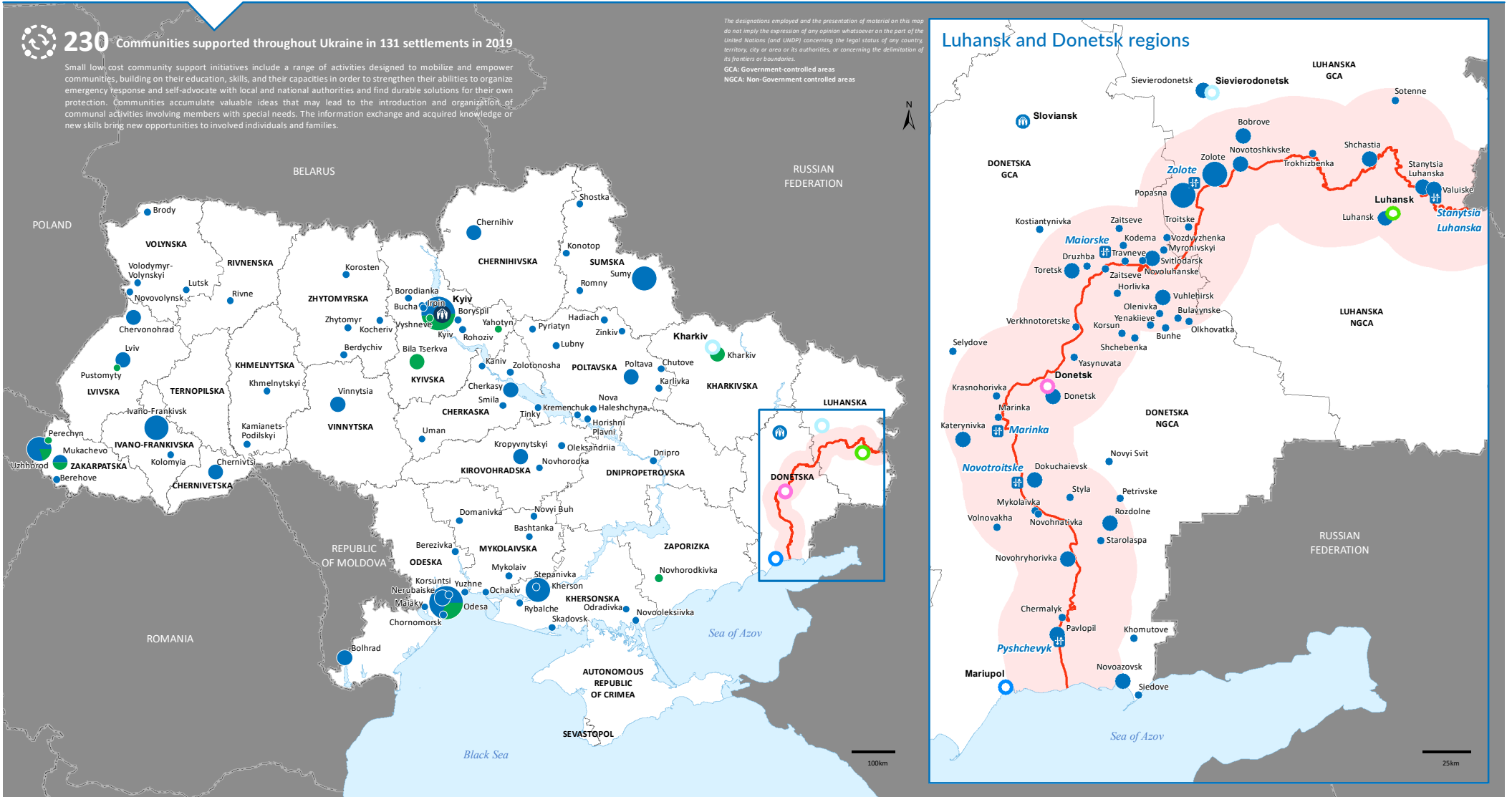


230 Communities supported throughout Ukraine in 131 settlements in 2019

Small low cost community support initiatives include a range of activities designed to mobilize and empower communities, building on their education, skills, and their capacities in order to strengthen their abilities to organize emergency response and self-advocate with local and national authorities and find durable solutions for their own protection. Communities accumulate valuable ideas that may lead to the introduction and organization of communal activities involving members with special needs. The information exchange and acquired knowledge or new skills bring new opportunities to involved individuals and families.
