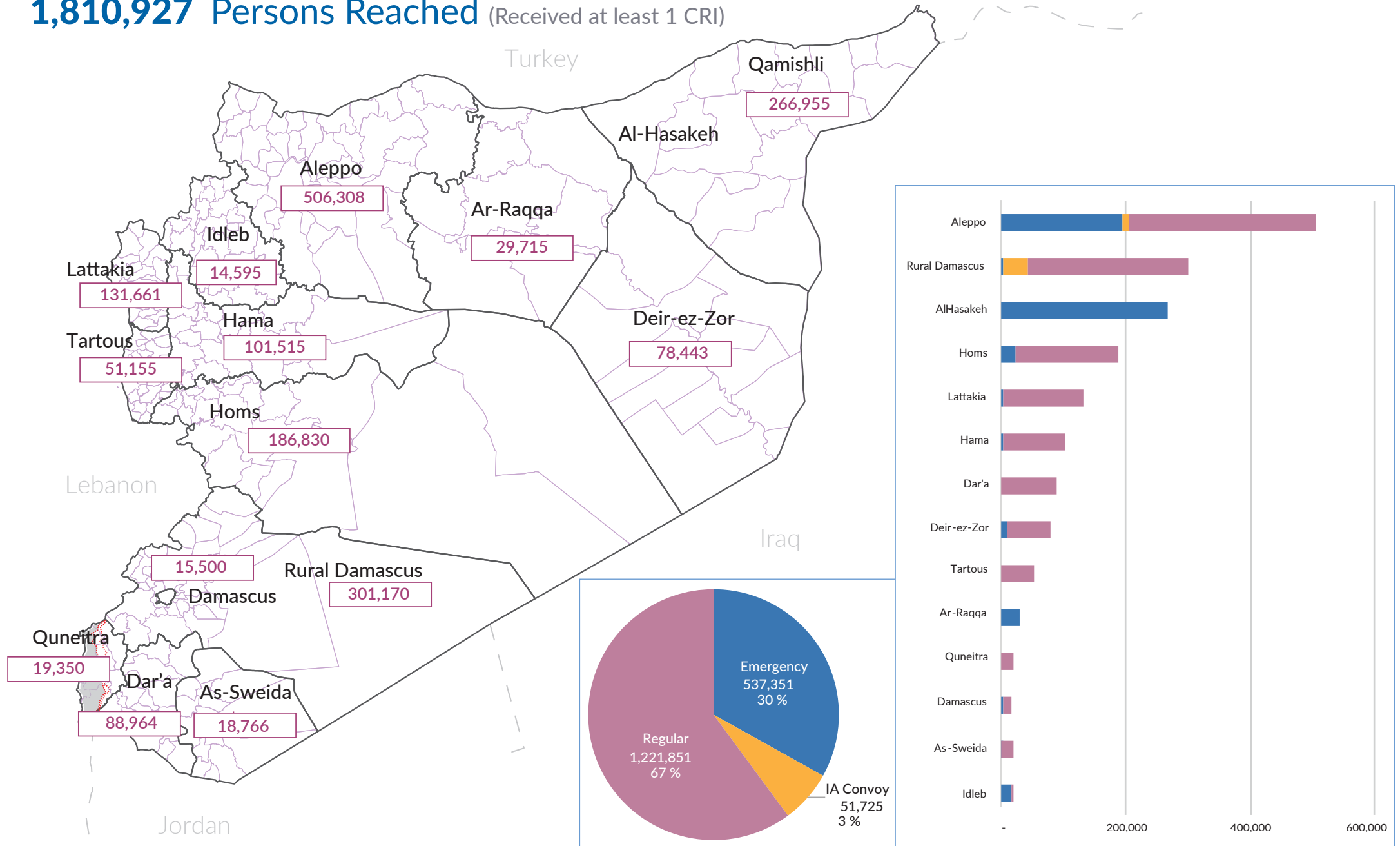

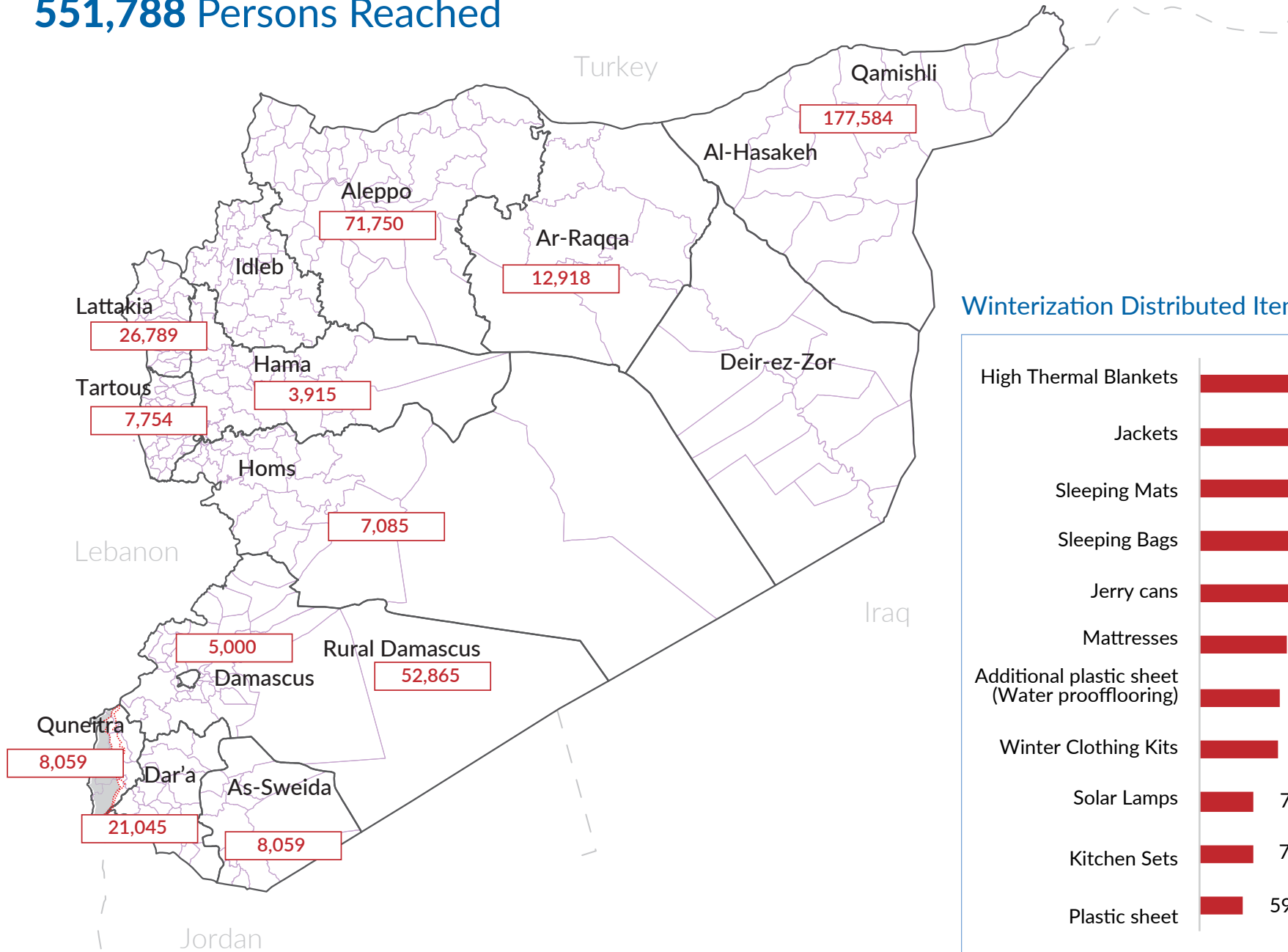
# UNHCR SYRIA CORE RELIEF ITEM (CRI) DISTRIBUTION

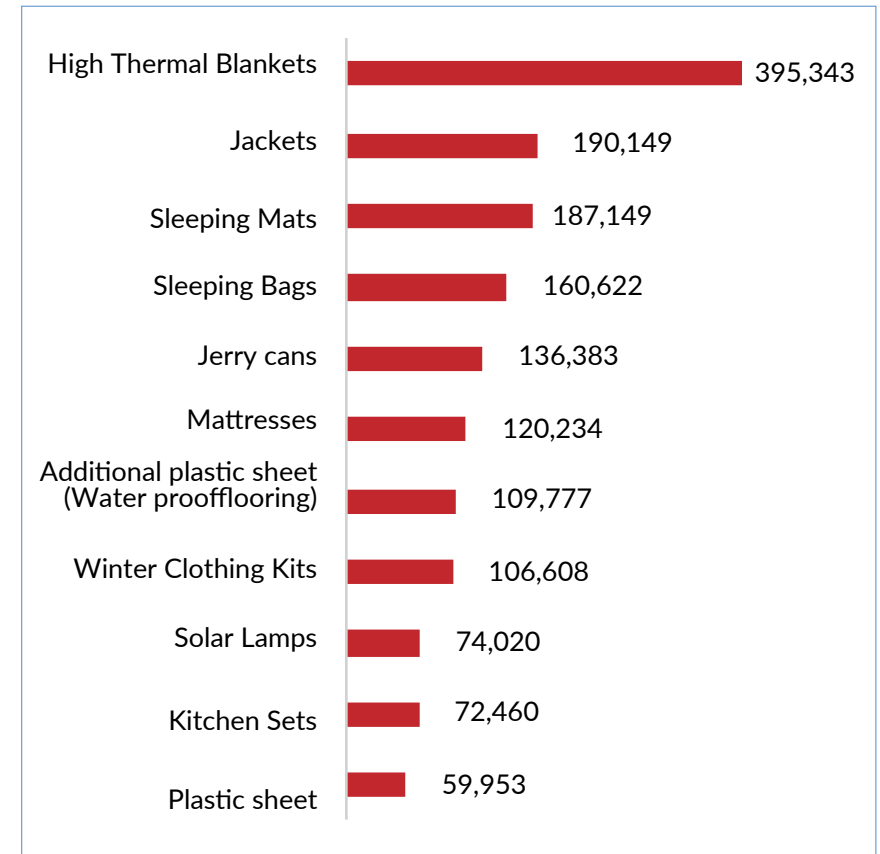


# UNHCR SYRIA WINTERIZATION PROGRAMME 2019/2020

## 551,788 Persons Reached

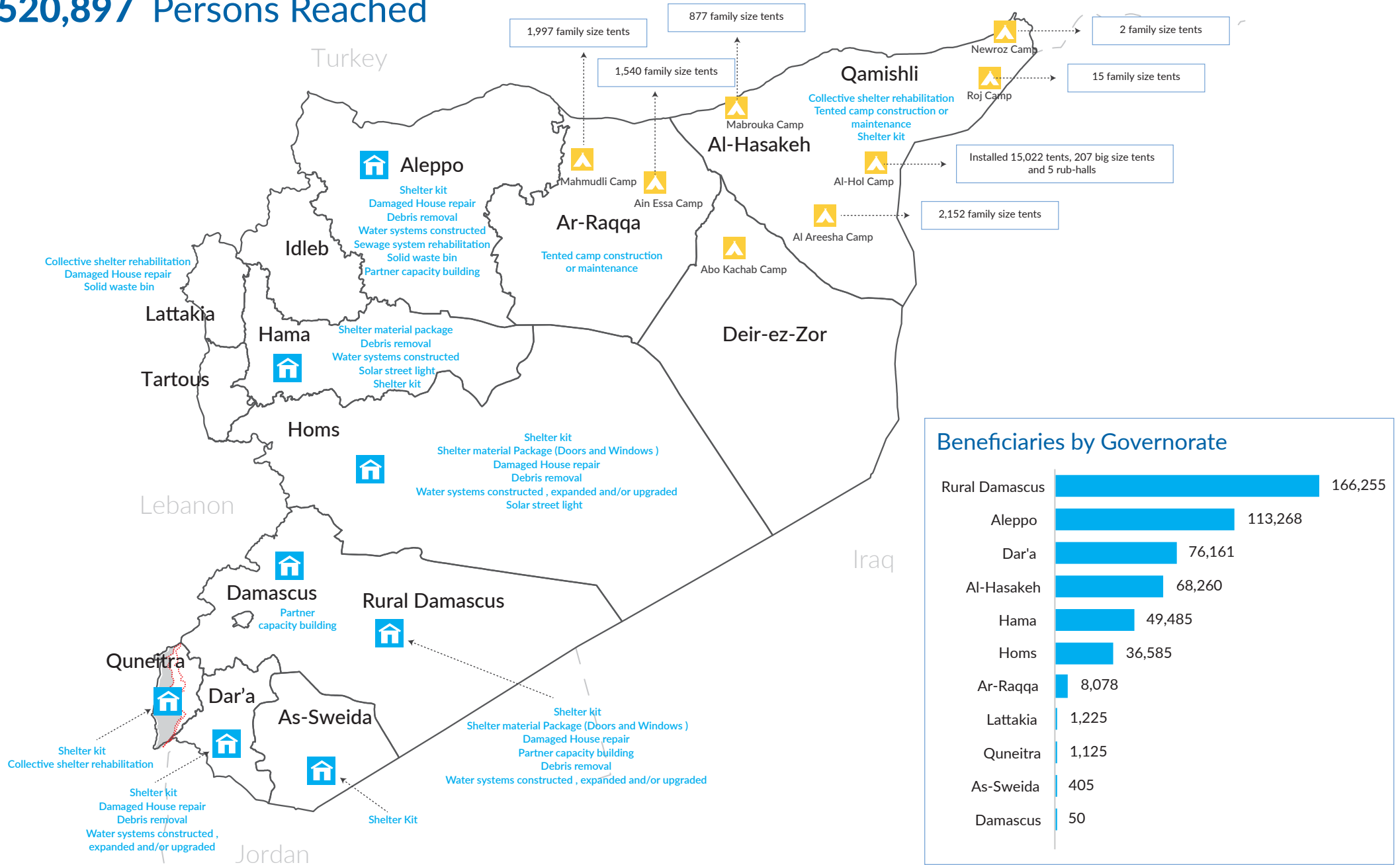

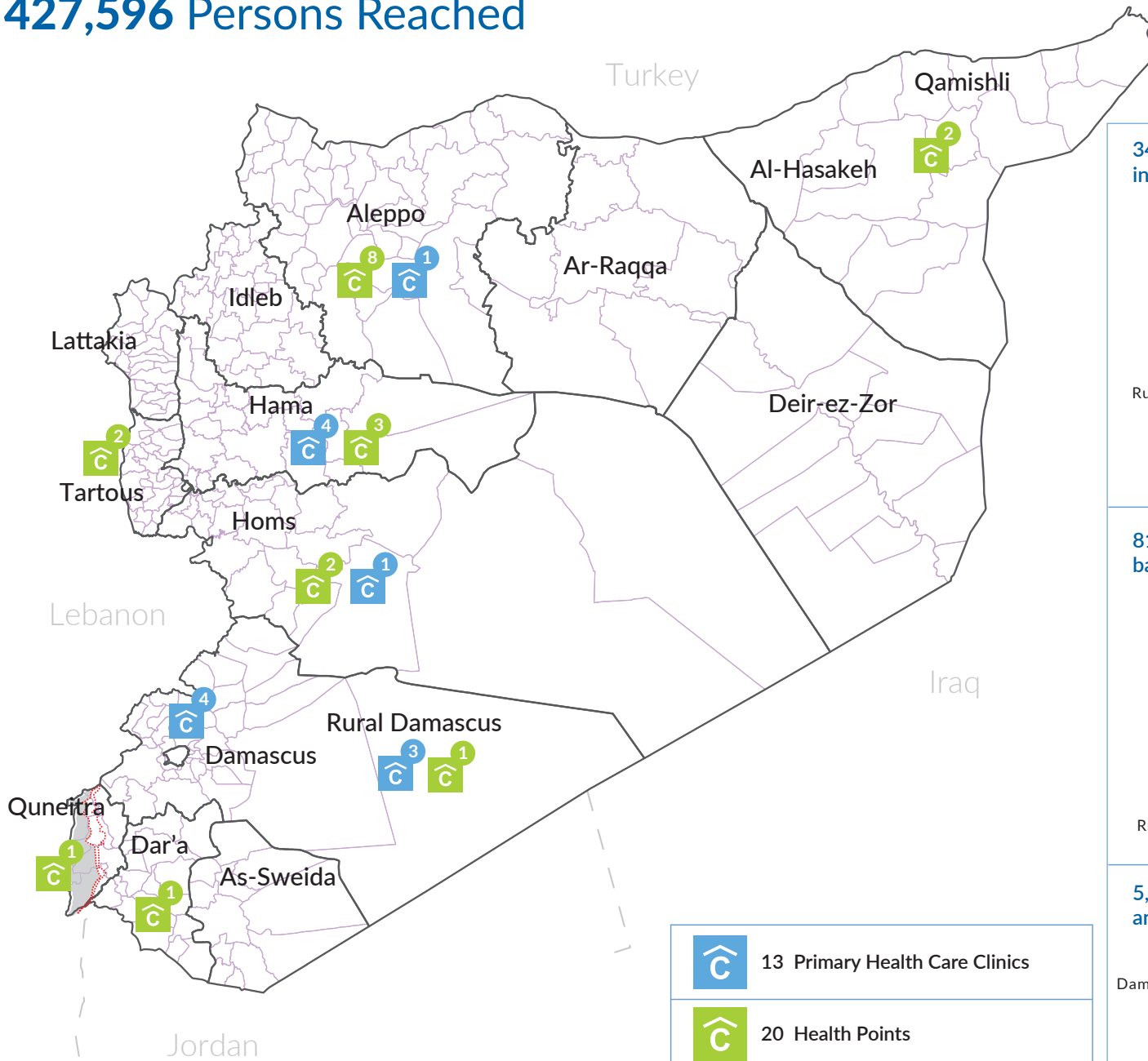

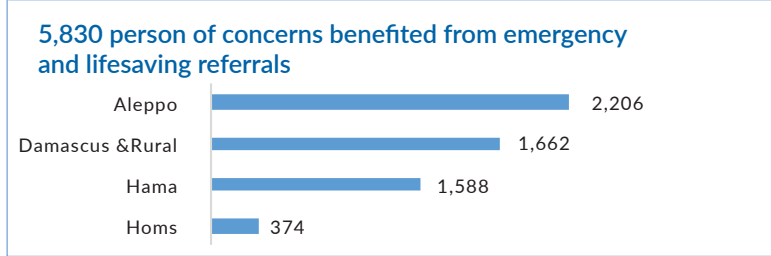
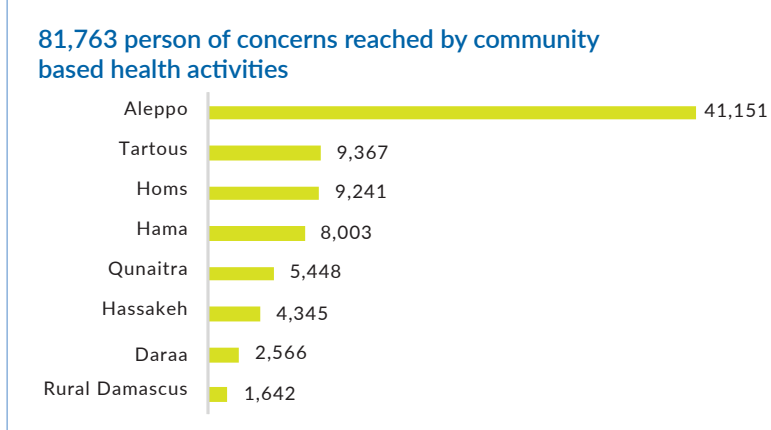
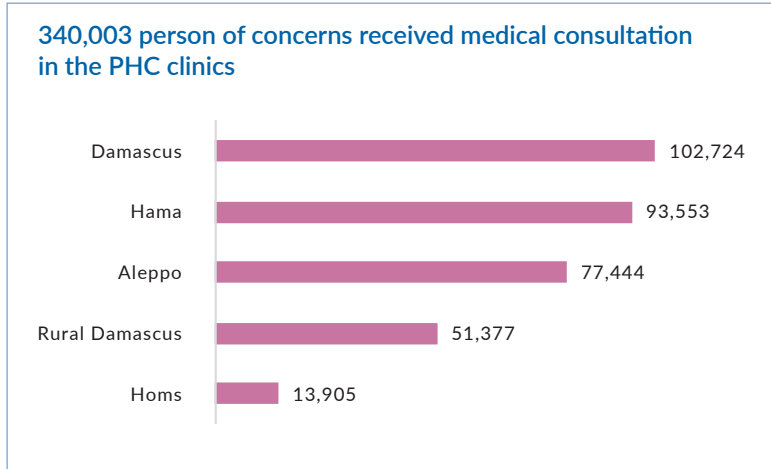
# UNHCR SYRIA HEALTH INTERVENTIONS

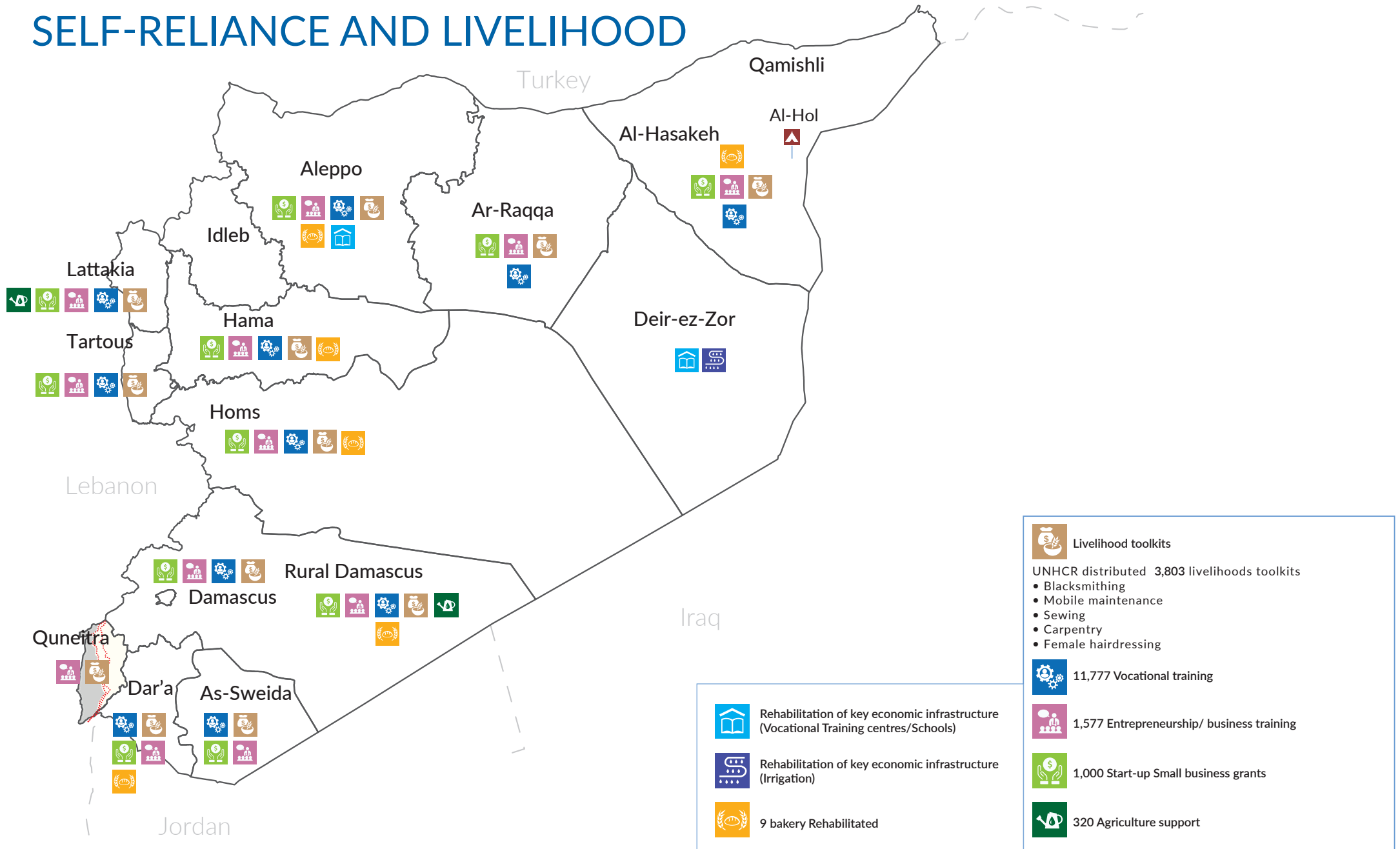

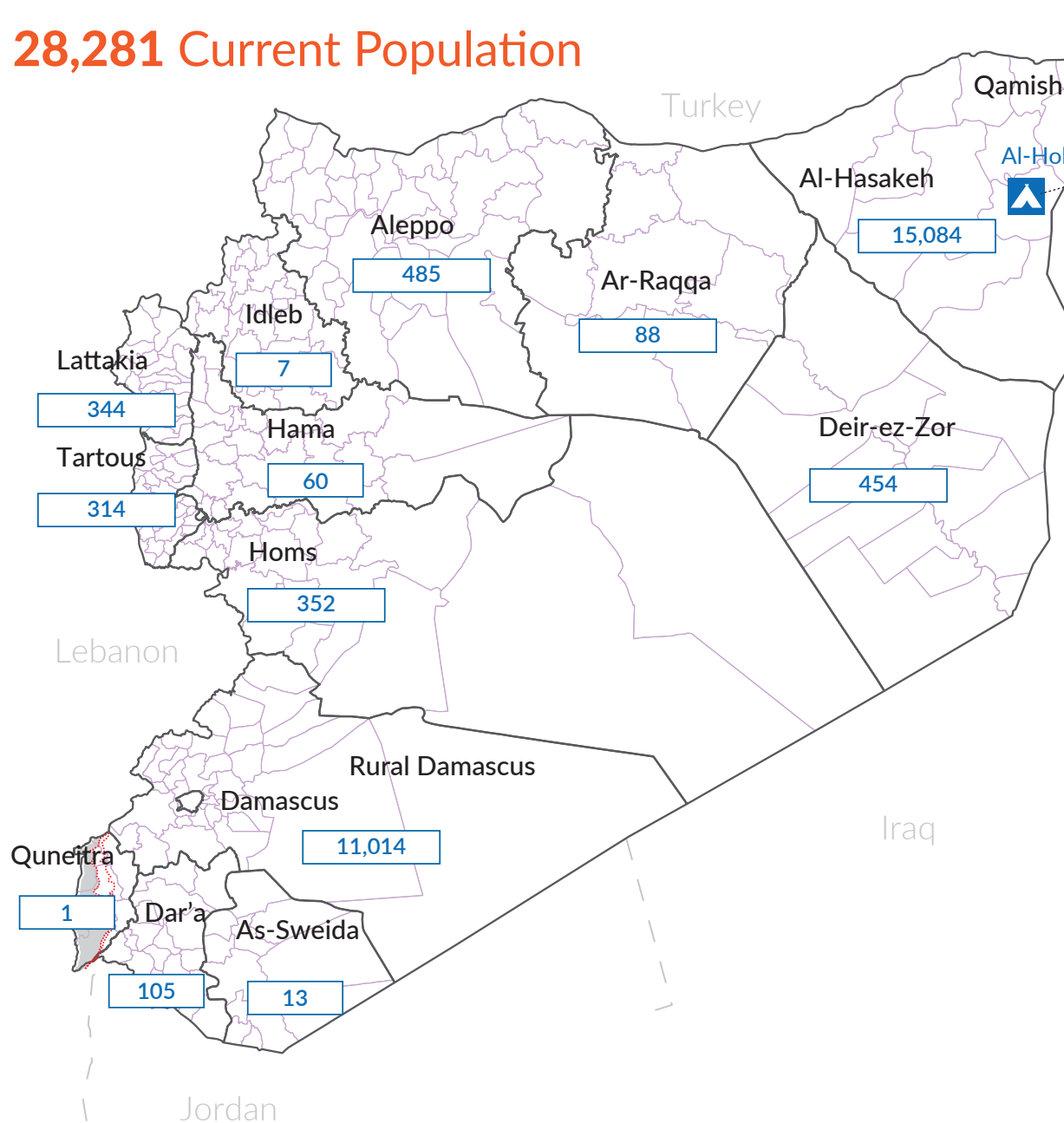

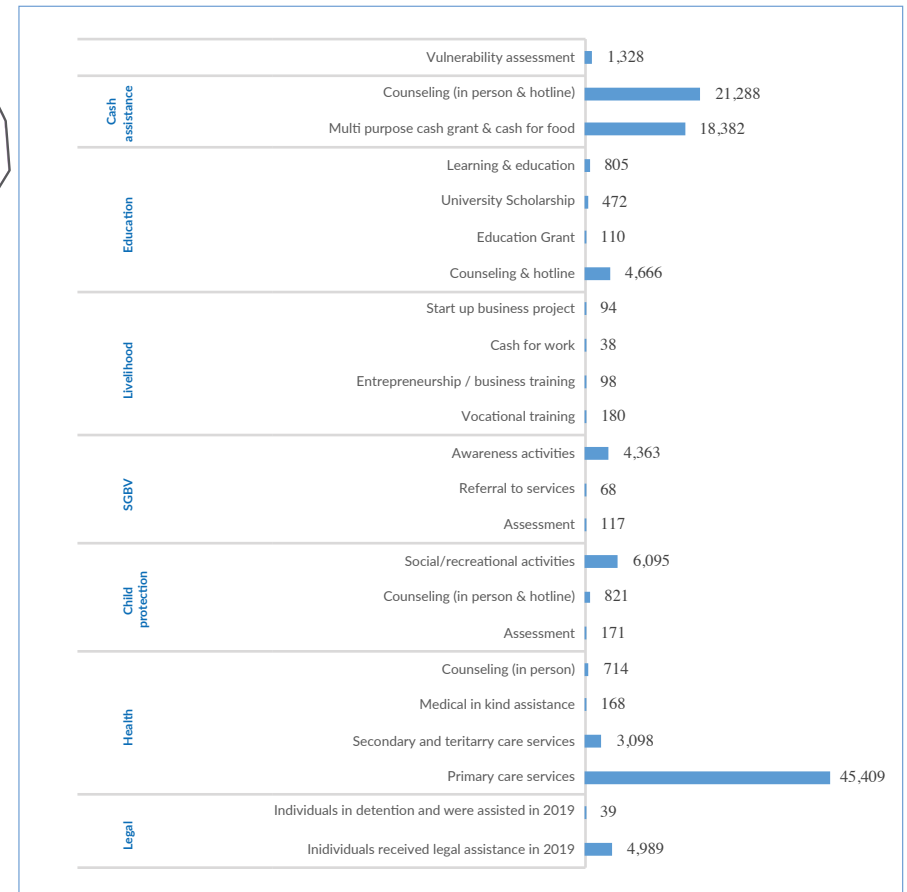

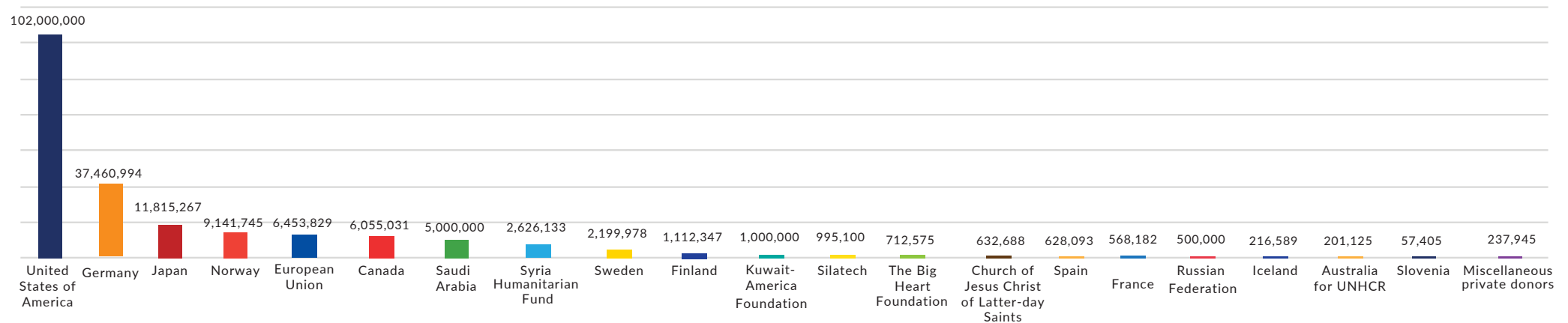
