COVID-19 - New regulations in Malta

- Bars and 'Kazini' will not be allowed to open as from 29th October.
- Snack bars and Kiosks will be allowed to open **but cannot serve alcoholic drinks**. They will need to **remain closed between 11pm and 5am.**
- Groups in public spaces will **be restricted to 6 people**. The measure will apply to public spaces including queues and bus stops, unless social distancing is respected.
- The fine for people found not observing social distancing and group gathering rules **will increase to €200**. If the fine is paid prior to a tribunal hearing, the fine will go down to €100.
