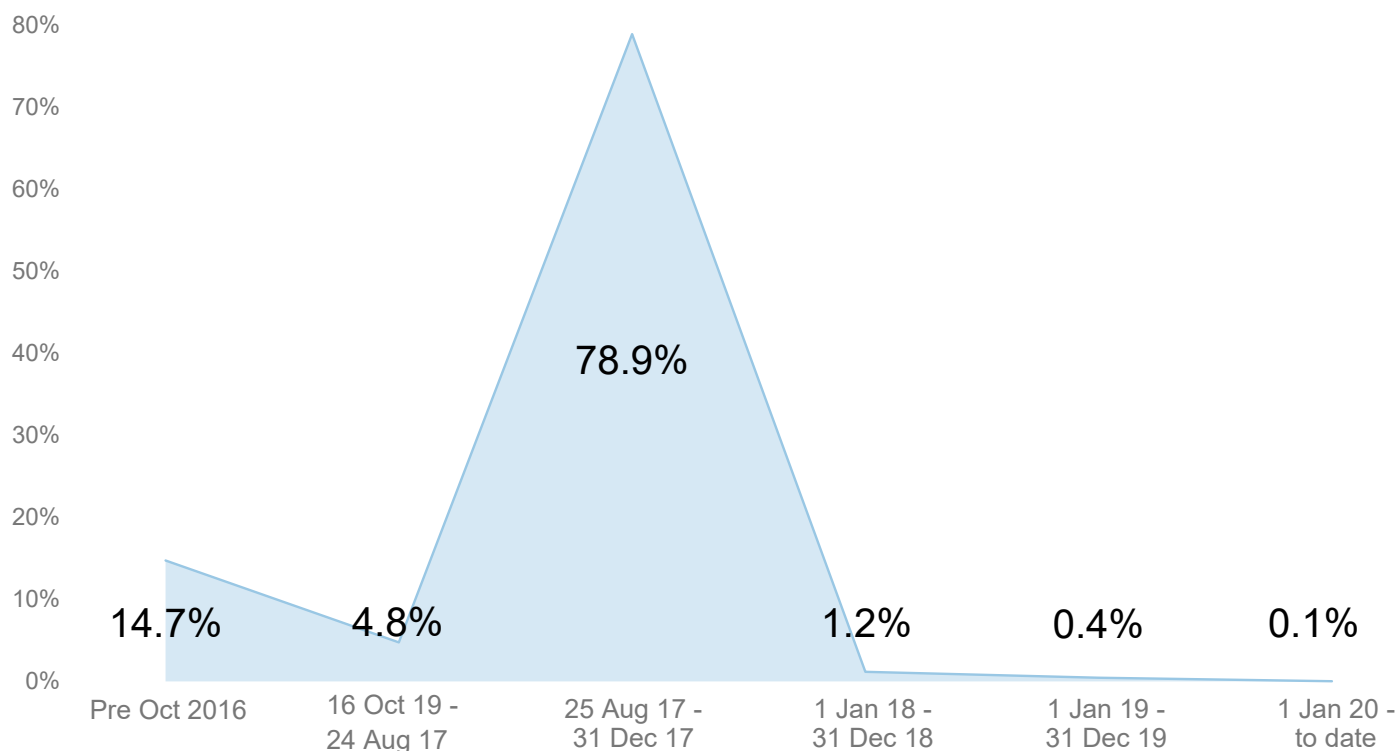

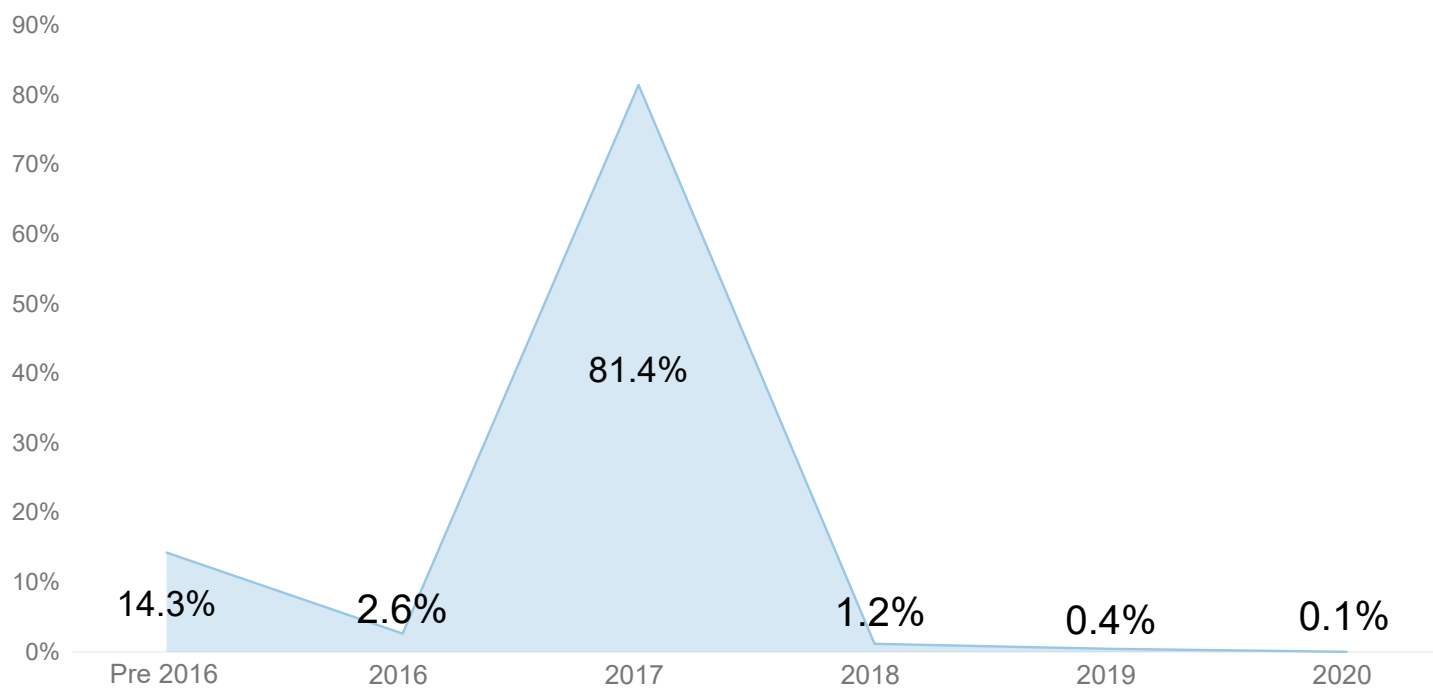
### Families by period of arrival \*
