Preparation for Session 1:

II. Goals/outcomes

1. To review the training programme to develop an action plan on localization
2. To develop a localization dashboard
3. Undertake survey on partnerships and analyze findings

1. Review of training programme – date to be set by Global CPAoR

This will be done by Webinar and/or individual skype calls and will cover the following (75mins):

- a. The presentation: This will cover the concept of localization, the conceptual framework and some tips for how to facilitate a discussion with coordination groups (45mins)
- b. Q&A (30mins)

2. Developing a localization dashboard (expected to take around 1 day for preparation)

- a. The guidance for developing a dashboard is attached.
- b. Coordinators and IMOs should first attempt to develop a dashboard for their context.
- c. The Global CP AoR is available for follow up with individual skype calls (or during in-country visits) to support finalization of the dashboard.
- d. The Global CP AoR will also produce an annual aggregate analysis, based on all dashboards each year, in July/August to enable analyses to inform new HNO/HRP processes.
