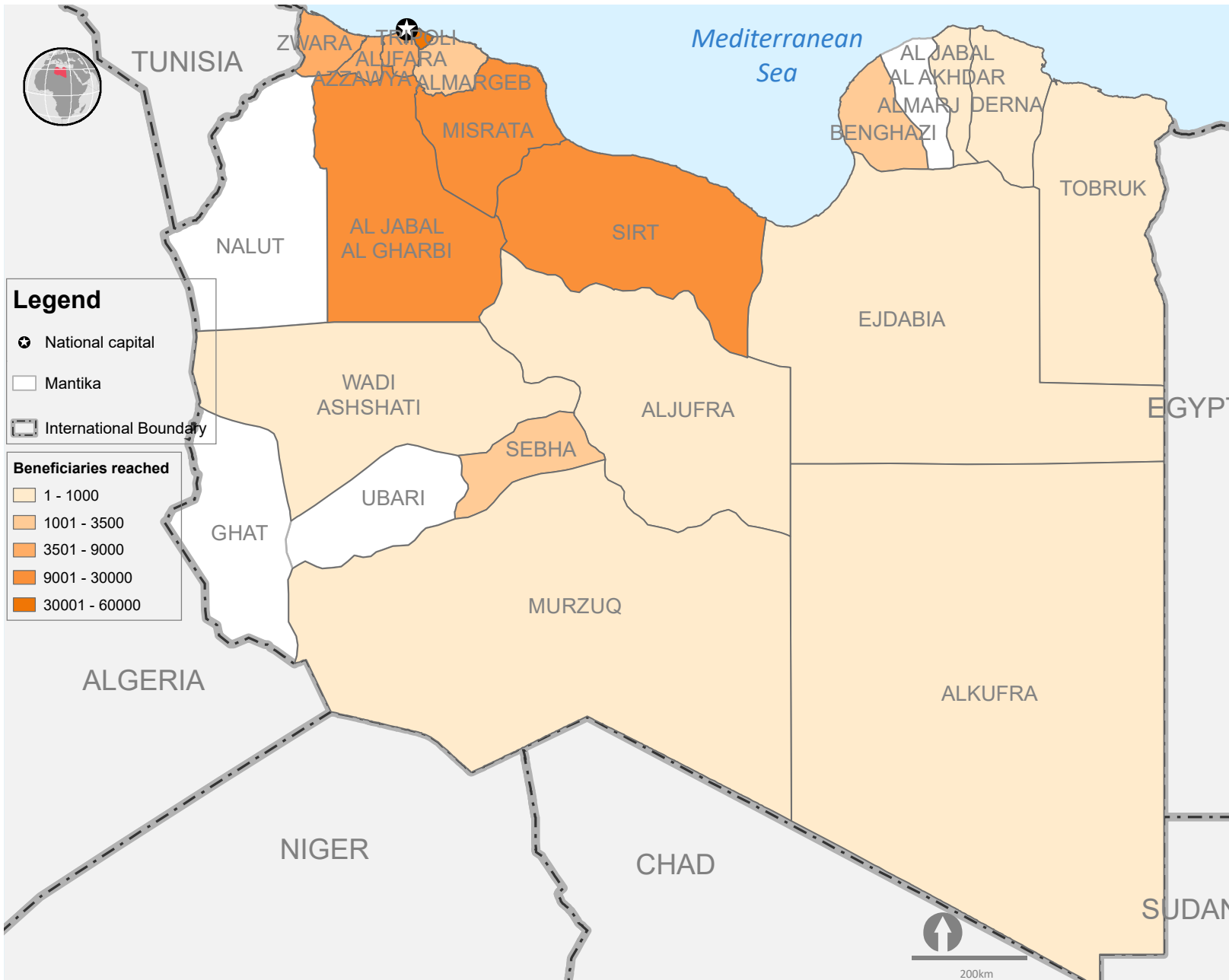


# LIBYA: Protection sector response snapshot as of July 2019

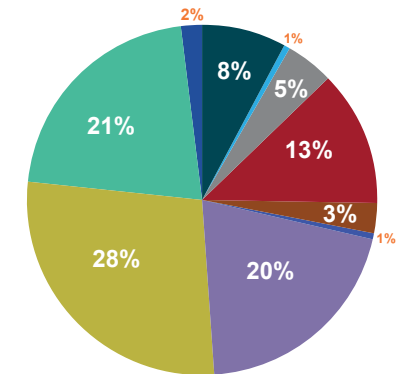

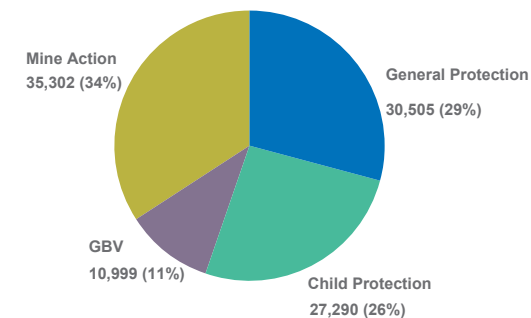

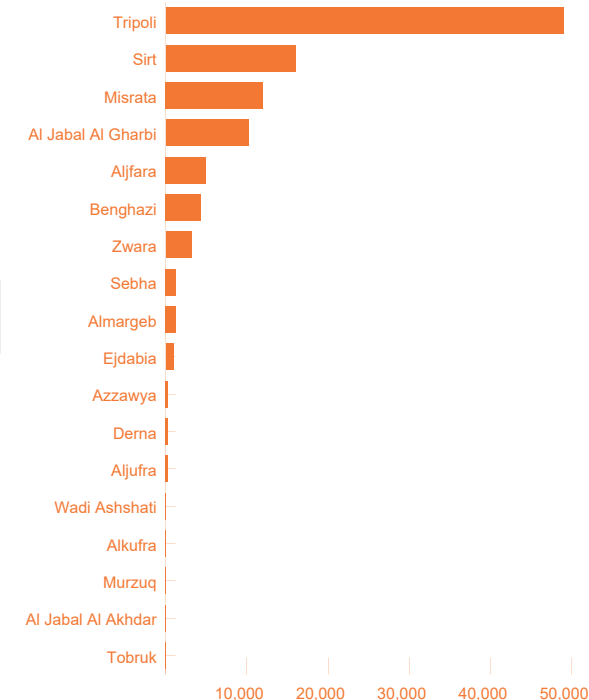

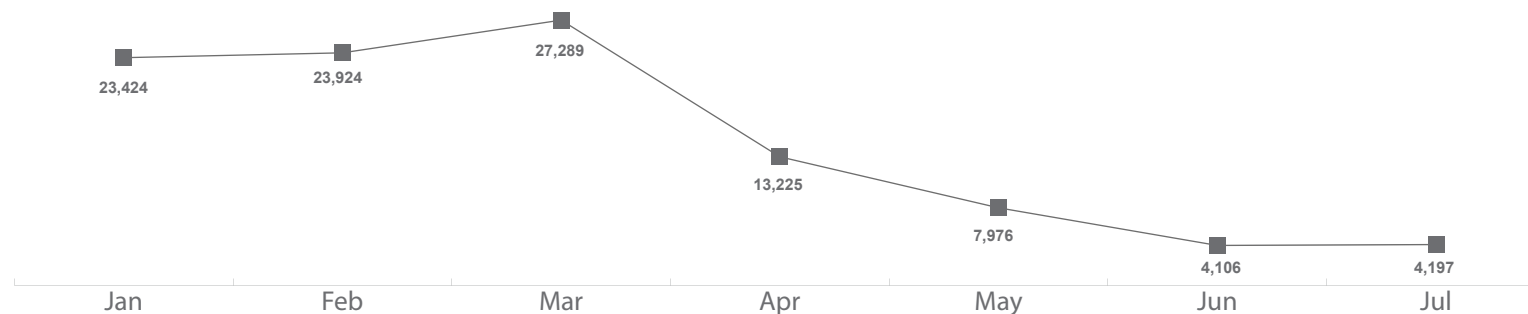
## Interventions per sub-sector
