1	<p>Introduction</p> <p>Monthly open meeting for all SNFI partners, stakeholders and interested parties. Focus, as always on three pillars of coordination:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Avoid duplication • Fill the gaps • Harmonise the response <p>Spotlight on DRC’s shelter project, as a reminder that we are more than simply NFI – partners are also involved in providing adequate housing and improving and rehabilitating key infrastructure.</p>		
2	<p>Updates from Partners</p> <p>UNHCR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Shelter rehab activities implemented through NRC; technical assessments completed and the tender was released for 24 houses and 30 shelter units in IDP settlements in Benghazi as well as 		



	<p>infrastructure works in 2 settlements. Works expected to start in 4 weeks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Infrastructure solutions in urban settings intervention in Abu Salim implemented through NRC. Plans to undertake 3 infrastructure projects mainly looking at water, sewage or power connections. Technical assessments and selection of sites ongoing- NFI distribution ongoing in AJdabia, Kufra, Gamfouda.- Planned NFI distribution in AL Mabani and Abu Salim.- No planned NFI distributions in Al Qarya Al Seyaheya or the health institute in Benghazi <p>DRC</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- SDC project started 1 Feb 202 and will run till 31 May 2022. The program will provide holistic shelter assistance including NFI's and shelter repairs to migrants and IDP's. <p>IOM</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Monthly distributions of hygiene kits ongoing in the east and the west for migrants.- Planned NFI distributions in Tarhouna and Tawergha for IDP's. Tawergha plans needs to be discussed separately with the sector to avoid duplication. <p>CESVI</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Cash for rent and hygiene kits distributions in Misrata. Assistance target different groups including IDP's and migrants <p>INTERSOS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Started a new UNHCR funded quick impact project with 13 projects planned for this year. 3 of the 13 sites are identified; women empowerment center, Libyan Korean center, azzawiya vocational center- Assessments for remaining 10 locations ongoing.- started installation of Prefabs in the women empowerment center <p>UN Habitat</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Currently doing an assessment on HLP rights to identify key challenges and actions for short and long term. Results will be shared with the sector
