This letter is to inform our membership about important information in relation to the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games. Below this letter you will find:

In this unique Paralympic Games, we cannot stress to you enough the importance of following the Tokyo 2020 Playbooks to keep everyone safe. You must stay within the 'bubble' between the athlete village and shooting range and anyone found outside of this 'bubble' **will be sent home immediately.** The playbooks can be found [here](#).

Here are some updates and reminders regarding competition procedures:

- Athletes will be called to the line 30 minutes in advance instead of 15 minutes.
- Due to the COVID restrictions, we will have 3 relays of P3.
- Please be mindful of the schedules such as equipment control and transportation, it is very important that you respect these timelines.
- Carefully review the Victory Ceremony information at the end of this document. This will be strictly followed and enforced. Please review this (for example: no flags, no phones, no cap, etc.) to avoid any disciplinary actions.

VICTORY CEREMONY ATHLETES INFO

TOKYO 2020 PARALYMPIC GAMES





PODIUM ETIQUETTE

- Medallists must always wear their masks covering mouth and nose
- Medallists and NPC support staff should only wear their official and approved NPC tracksuit for Victory Ceremonies - no competition attire is allowed (only exception for Equestrian)
- Medallists and NPC support staff should wear the official NPC track shoes – no sandals or barefoot
- Flags, cell phones, electronic devices, bottles, political statements/signage are **NOT** allowed on the podium
- Medallists and NPC support staff must **NOT** wear their accreditation or wear it inside their jacket so it is not visible while on the podium





VICTORY CEREMONIES

- Medallists need to proceed to the Victory Ceremony Preparation Area at the communicated time
- Medallists will be briefed and introduced to the presenters
- Due to Covid-19 countermeasure adaptations, there will only be two presenters for each event (individual, relay or team events)
- Presenters will carry the trays with medals and gifts.
- Tray bearers will escort the presenters who are unable to carry the tray themselves.

VICTORY CEREMONIES INDIVIDUAL / RELAY EVENTS

The presenters will already be positioned in the Victory Ceremony Area before the start of the ceremony.

1. Medallists should follow the athletes' escorts who will guide them to the podium and wait at their spike mark
2. Medallists step forward on the podium when their country and name are being announced to receive the medal and gift and then remain at the front of the podium
3. Medallists should turn to the flags when the anthem of the Gold medalist is played. In the case of athletes with a vision impairment the guides should support them with the correct positioning
4. At the end of the ceremony, there will be a photo option on the podium before all medallists are being escorted to the Mixed Zone



COVID-19 COUNTERMEASURES

INDIVIDUAL / RELAY EVENTS

Medallists are expected to **collect their medal and gift from the tray** when offered by the presenter or assigned tray bearer

The following options apply for medallists, who require support to take the medal and gift from the tray:

1. Athlete Competition Partner (Ab) entitled to receive a medal and gift:

- Guide (athletics), director (Boccia), pilot (cycling) or coxswain (rowing)
- The Ab should first take the medal and present it to the Paralympian and then take his/her own medal from the tray to hang around the neck. Same process for the gift.
- Then both should remain on the front of the podium.

2. Own NPC support staff:

- Coach, training partner or Team Official
- The NPC support staff would accompany the medallist to the podium and assist with the adapted process
- The NPC support staff should stand slightly behind the medallist
- Once the medal is placed around the medallist's neck and the gift handed over, the NPC support staff need to step backwards from the podium, leaving only the medallist in front of the podium.

Social distancing of 1 metre needs to be ensured between the podiums during the Victory Ceremony and masks are to be kept on at all times. The only exception allowed to take off the masks for a certain period of time, will be for the official photo opportunity moment on the podium while medallists are keeping their 1 metre of social distancing. Medalists on the podium will receive clear instructions and signage from the respective Tokyo 2020 Photo Manager and/or escort.



PODIUM PHOTO OPPORTUNITY

At the Paralympic Games, medalists will have one official photo opportunity on the podium. Please ensure that your athletes are aware of these protocols and Covid-19 countermeasures for the photo moment:

- 1) After all medalists have received their medals and gifts and the national anthem of the Gold medalist has been played, medalists should remain on their podium keeping the 1 metre physical distancing
- 2) The sign “mask off” (green image) will be shown to the medalists who will then be allowed to remove the masks for a maximum of 30 seconds
- 3) The sign “mask on” (red image) will indicate for medalists to put their masks back on
- 4) Medalists will then be allowed to break their social distancing rule and get together on the Gold medal podium for another photo opportunity
- 5) The escort and/or Tokyo 2020 photo manager will indicate the end of the photo session and medalists will get off the podium and leave the field of play to be escorted to the Mixed Zone

When medalists walk off from the podium after their Victory Ceremony, they often get asked by photographers to remove their masks for extra photos. **Please communicated to all your athletes, that they should always wear their masks and disregard any individual requests to take their masks off.** That is only allowed at the official photo opportunity on the podium, with supervision and clear instructions coming from the Tokyo 2020 Photo Manager and/or escort

The safety of our Paralympians and all Games participants should always come first!



VICTORY CEREMONIES TEAM SPORTS



Generally, the Victory Ceremony process and Covid-19 adaptations will be the same as for individual/relay event Victory Ceremonies.

Additional points are:

- Medallists should stay in the same order in which they are lined-up backstage, as their name will be announced according to the team list when they receive their medals and gifts
- Ab for Football – goalkeeper
- For other team events and if required, one NPC support staff should be assigned to assist with the medal and gift collection process

Social distancing of 1 metre needs to be ensured between the podiums and masks are kept on at all times. Unless at the photo opportunity moment which will be indicated to medallists after anthem is played.



FINAL REMARKS

*The official podium photo opportunity is the only exception when masks can be removed under supervision and clear instructions from the Tokyo 2020 Photo Manager and/or escort

Be reminded that the Victory Ceremony is a “protest free zone”. Please refer to the [IPC's measures on athlete's protests for the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games](#).

COVID-19 COUNTERMEASURES

Masks must be worn properly covering mouth and nose by everyone at all times*

Athletes should refrain from physical contact with other competitors and keep 1 metre social distance on the podium between bronze, silver and gold positions*
