

Victory Ceremony protocol order

- 1. At World Cup competitions prizes, titles or diplomas, provided by LOC, will be awarded to the top three competitors in each event
- 2. If two or more competitors finish with the same rank or receive same points, they shall be given the same placing. They will be awarded same prizes, titles or diplomas.
- 3. For VI categories, if the athlete skied with a guide, the guide will also be awarded same prize, title or diploma awarded to the athlete.
- 4. The winners and presenters must remain on the podium until the Victory Ceremony is completed. The protocol order of the Victory Ceremony must be followed according to the bellow criteria:
 - Winners and presenters are led and pre-set by hostesses or host onto the Victory Ceremony Field of Play. No national flags, banners or other merchandise should be allowed on the ceremony platform
 - The winners and gift presenters will be introduced by the MC (name and title)
 - The winner's names are announced in the following order: the third place finisher is announced first, followed by the second-place holder, leading up to the announcement of the first-place athlete, the World Cup winner.
 - As their names are announced, the competitors take their places on a podium. The athletes move on to the podium individually or, in case of team event, together team by team.
