INTRODUCTION

This Guide describes in detail how athletes and teams can qualify for the Bahrain 2021 Asian Youth Para Games in each of the 9 sports on the Games programme. It provides to the National Paralympic Committee (NPCs), to National Sport Federations, to sports administrators, coaches and to the athletes themselves the conditions that allow participation in the most important event for youth athletes in the Paralympic Movement of Asia.

The Guide presents:

- An overview of the Bahrain 2021 Asian Youth Para Games Sports Programme,
- The general Asian Paralympic Committee (APC) regulations on eligibility,
- The specific qualification criteria for each sport,

Qualification Methods

This Games is an OPEN ENTRY SYSTEM to help encourage more athletes to attend the competition so that no MQS or ranking point will be necessary for the Bahrain 2021 Asian Youth Para Games.

Official Language

The official language of the Asian Paralympic Committee is English. If an NPC translates this document for internal purposes the English version shall prevail in case of discrepancy.

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GENERAL APC REGULATIONS ON ELIGIBILITY

In addition to each International Federation's athlete eligibility criteria the APC has established a set of general conditions that apply to all participants in the Asian Youth Para Games. These general regulations are derived from the APC Handbook. They ensure that the fundamental rights and obligations of the APC and its membership are recognized and protected. The General APC Regulations on Eligibility are as follows:

- APC Membership
- Compliance with APC Athletes Nationality Code
- Age Requirement
- NPC Selection Standards
- Compliance with the Classification Rules

APC Membership

Only NPCs in good standing with the APC may enter eligible athletes in the Bahrain 2021 Asian Youth Para Games. NPCs are reminded that athletes must ensure their membership with their sport's respective International Federation is in good standing during the participation period and upon close of registration entry to the Asian Youth Para Games.

Compliance with APC Athletes Nationality Code

Any athlete in the Asian Youth Para Games must be a national of the country/territory of the NPC entering him/her and in compliance with the provisions of the Nationality Code as published in the APC Handbook.

Age Requirement

The minimum age to participate in the Games will be 13 years old on 31 December of the year of the Games. The Maximum age will be to participate in the games will be 21 years old on 31 December of the year of the Games. However, NPCs should note that an age limit is established by relevant International Federations through sport-specific athlete eligibility standards.

NPC Selection Standards

The APC recognizes and respects the right of NPCs to establish national selection standards for determining an athlete or team's qualification to compete in the Asian Youth Para Games. All athletes and teams are equally subject to their respective NPC selection standards when applied.

Sport Class Status:

Sport Class Status that the athlete needs to have in order to participate in the specific sport at the Bahrain 2021 Asian Youth Para Games.

N = New

R = Review

FRD = Fixed Review Date

C = Confirmed

Athletes with 'New' or 'Review' sport class status must undergo international classification on site. Athletes will need to present themselves for classification at the date and time designated by the sport. NPCs must present all relevant medical paperwork for their athletes with 'New' or 'Review' status to the respective IF, according to their classification rules. For every classification matter the NPC must contact the respective IF.

Viability Criteria

If the IF does not state its Viability Criteria, then it shall adhere to the Viability Criteria of the APC as follows:

- Individual Events

There should be a minimum of four (4) athletes from two (2) participating nations;

- Team Events

There should be a minimum of four (4) participating nations.

In exceptional cases where an event is already on the final programme and does not fulfil the Viability Criteria during the competition day, the following alternative steps can be taken:

- Technical Delegate's Decision

The Technical Delegate reserves the right and authority to move the athletes into another reasonable class, or combine different classes together

COMPETITION FORMAT

Sport Classes with similar nature of Impairment will be combined in both track and field events.

In track events there will be one round, regardless of the number of competitors of each event. Where there are more athletes than available lanes for a single final, the event shall be run as a “timed final”.

Where there are less than 4 entries for an event, Sport Classes may be further combined. Events in which more than one Sport Class compete, the World Para Athletics Performance Indicator will be used to determine placings.

All field events are held as finals only. Where more than one Sports Class compete together, the World Para Athletics Performance Indicator System shall be used to determine placings.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for entry, an athlete must:

- hold an active World Para Athletics Licence for the 2021 season;
- be aged between 14 and 19 years old on 31 December 2021 (age categories detailed above);
- Have a sport class status “New” (N), “Review” or “Confirmed” (C).
- Comply with the APC Nationality Rules and Regulations of the respective IF.
- Guide-runners must hold an active World Para Athletics Licence for the 2021 season.

MAXIMUM ENTRY per NPC

- An NPC may enter a maximum of three (3) eligible athletes per Individual medal event.

VIABILITY OF EVENTS

Minimum Entries

- **Singles Events:**
There should be a minimum of four (4) athletes from two (2) nations
- **Doubles and Mixed Doubles Events:**
There should be a minimum of four (4) pairs and two (2) nations
- If the entries are less than as stipulated, the events may be combined in accordance to Section 5.5 - BWF Para-Badminton General Competition Regulation (PBGCR) 9 - <https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/statutes/>

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

- Any athlete who complies with the APC Nationality Rules and the Rules and Regulations of the respective IF of the sports.
- Any athlete who has a sport class status "New" (N), "Review" (R), Fixed Review Date (FRD) or "Confirmed" (C).

MAXIMUM ENTRY per NPC

- Singles
 - An NPC can enter a maximum of four (4) athletes for each singles event
- Doubles or Mixed Doubles
 - An NPC can enter a maximum of three (3) pairs for each doubles or mixed doubles event

- Any athletes who have a sport class status “New” (N), “Review” or “Confirmed” (c).

MAXIMUM ENTRY per NPC

An NPC can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per category in individual event and one (1) entry for team/pair event. A pair consist of 4 athletes (2 male and 2 female athlete and a team consist of 5 athletes (at least 2 male, 2 female and at least 1 of them need to be a BC1).

- Any athletes who comply with the APC Nationality Rules and the Rules and Regulations of the respective IF of the sports.
- Any athletes who have a sport class status “New” (N), “Review” or “Confirmed” (c).

MAXIMUM ENTRY per NPC

An NPC can be allocated no more than one (1) male’s team qualification slot and one (1) female’s team qualification slot. An NPC can enter a maximum of nine (9) members per team, six (6) athletes and three (3) staff members.

The minimum age is 15 years of age by 31 December of the year of the competition, and the maximum age is no older than 20 years of age by 31 December of the year of the competition.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Powerlifting competition will be conducted according to the current World Para Powerlifting Rules and Regulations and, therefore, results will be decided by using any of the following competition formats:

- In designated single bodyweight categories for men and women.
- The minus one rule.
- With the Coefficient formula in which the categories are not viable and combined groups are formed.



- With the Coefficient formula in Mixed Team event: Mixed teams consist of three (3) athletes from the same nation, and there must be a minimum of one (1) female athlete. Each of the three (3) athletes that comprise a team may be from different bodyweight categories. Each “good lift” is given the corresponding Coefficient points and the athletes’ points are summed to make the Mixed Team Event score.

In the Mixed team events men and women compete together.

- Separate event on last competition day in which athletes complete a maximum of 3 additional lifts (1 lift per athlete per phase; maximum of 3 lifts total if team advances to Final or Third Place Match).
- Results calculated using the Coefficient formula by the sum of the Coefficient points of each athlete.
- Teams consist of three (3) athletes from the same nation, and there must be a minimum of one (1) female athlete. Each of the three (3) athletes that comprise a team may be from different bodyweight categories.

Competition:

The bench press is the sport in which competitors must lower the bar to the chest, hold it motionless on the chest and then press it upwards to arm’s length with locked elbows.

The bar must be loaded progressively for each round on the principle of arising bar whereby each lifter takes their first attempt in the first round, their second attempt in the second round and their third attempt in the third round.

If unsuccessful with an attempt, the lifter must wait until the next round before he/she can attempt.

VIABILITY OF EVENTS

An event can be considered viable in any of the following two (2) criteria’s, when the below minimum athlete numbers apply per bodyweight category:

1: Single bodyweight categories:

In designated single body weight categories for Men and Women:

- a) 3 Athletes: when there is a minimum of 3 athletes in order to have all medals viable (gold, silver, bronze)
- b) 1 Athlete: MQS rule when there is one (1) athlete in a single bodyweight category, and they lift equal to or more than the respective level MQS for that bodyweight category as published in the competition information package (Gold).
- c) 2 Athletes: MQS rule when there are two (2) athletes in a single bodyweight category, and they lift equal to or more than the respective level MQS for that bodyweight category as published in the competition information package (Gold and Silver).

2. Multiple Combined Bodyweight Categories:

Where there can be multiple combined viable bodyweight categories in any one session, WPPO can adopt use any one or more of the following options at any given time:

- a) 2 or more events (with minimum 3 athletes each event)
- b) 1 Athlete: MQS rule when there is one (1) athlete in a single bodyweight category, and they lift equal to or more than the respective level MQS for that bodyweight category as published in the competition information package (Gold).
- c) 2 Athletes: MQS rule when there are two (2) athletes in a single bodyweight category, and they lift equal to or more than the respective level MQS for that bodyweight category as published in the competition information package (Gold and Silver).

The viable events will be discussed with the Technical Delegate and approved by World Para Powerlifting after the technical meeting of each competition.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to be entered by an NPC to participate (compete) in Bahrain 2021 Asian Youth Para Games must:

- have held an active World Para Powerlifting license for the 2021 season;
- be internationally classified with a “Confirmed”, “Review” or “New” sport class status with a review date set after Bahrain 2021AYPG.
- No Minimal Qualification Standard (MQS) is required.

Note: Athletes who have never been classified and or have a designated sport class status of “R” (Review) will be required to go through International Classification.

MAXIMUM ENTRY per NPC

For individual medal events:

- Each NPC is allowed to enter a maximum of thirty (30) Junior male and thirty (30) Youth male and thirty (30) Junior female and thirty (30) Youth female competitors spread throughout the range of the ten (10) male and ten (10) female bodyweight categories.
- Maximum three (3) Junior and three (3) Youth from the same country per each body weight category is allowed.

For Mixed Team medal event:

- Each NPC is allowed to enter a maximum of three (3) Mixed Teams
- Each NPC is allowed to enter a maximum of nine (9) athletes (Juniors + Youth) athletes to the Mixed team events and there must be a minimum of one (1) female athlete per teams.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The competition will be run as Multi-class Direct Finals. The 3 impairment types will be swum separately where possible.

Only events that meet the Event Viability Criteria outlined below after the Entry by Name will be included in the Final Event Programme. Sport classes without a viable event will be able to “swim up” to the nearest single class event included in the Programme. These sport classes will be considered Eligible Classes for the respective single class event, and medals will not be allocated separately for these Eligible Classes.

Events that are still not viable after combining classes will be swum out of the programme for performances only. These events may be swum at the same time as that event in the other age category if there are empty lanes.

VIABILITY OF EVENTS

Individual events will be considered viable if they have a minimum of four (4) eligible swimmers from two (2) NPCs entered through the Entry by Name. Relay events will be considered viable if they have a minimum of four (4) eligible NPCs entered through the Entry by Name.

After final entries the programme will be final. Any class changes after Classification will not affect the programme. However, the “minus one rule” may be applied for medal purposes.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for selection by an NPC for Youth Games swimmers must:

- Hold an active World Para Swimming license for 2021 season
- Have a sport class status “New” (N), “Review” (R) or “Confirmed” (C).
- Comply with the APC Nationality Rules and the Rules and Regulations of the respective IF of the sports.
- No Minimal Qualification Standard (MQS) is required.

MAXIMUM ENTRY per NPC
