Access to services:

- 1 | Sociological aid for depression management.
- Attention routes and comprehensive services for gender-based violence survivors, particularly those from domestic violence.
- 3 | Training on early motherhood/fatherhood.
- Dissemination of available services with focus on youth.
- Access to national systems, especially regarding health without discrimination for migratory status and with priority for single mothers with disabled children.
- 6 | Support in the integration to higher education and the culmination of secondary education.
- 7 Family planning workshops.
- Strengthening of leadership and participation in the development of life projects and integration alternatives.
- Training in the management of processes regarding public policy with the objective of elevating the advocacy capacities before national authorities and key actors.

- Mapping of risks faced by youth in transit, also including migration benefits and risks.
- Characterization of protection needs for youth in host countries, especially those that are homeless.
