

Access to services:

- 1 | Sociological aid for depression management.
- 2 | Attention routes and comprehensive services for gender-based violence survivors, particularly those from domestic violence.
- 3 | Training on early motherhood/fatherhood.
- 4 | Dissemination of available services with focus on youth.
- 5 | Access to national systems, especially regarding health without discrimination for migratory status and with priority for single mothers with disabled children.
- 6 | Support in the integration to higher education and the culmination of secondary education.
- 7 | Family planning workshops.
- 8 | Strengthening of leadership and participation in the development of life projects and integration alternatives.
- 9 | Training in the management of processes regarding public policy with the objective of elevating the advocacy capacities before national authorities and key actors.

- 1 | Mapping of risks faced by youth in transit, also including migration benefits and risks.
- 2 | Characterization of protection needs for youth in host countries, especially those that are homeless.

Legal advice/representation

- Information about labor exploitation risks. | 1
- Familiar reunification. | 2
- Access to regularization processes. | 3
- Custody processes in the case of refugee and migrant mothers/fathers from Venezuela, people married to nationals and without access to regularization. | 4

- Dissemination of information through adequate channels for youth (Facebook, WhatsApp, Zoom) | 1
- Sensitization and no stigmatization campaigns. | 2
- Shared spaces for youth for the exchange of experiences and design of regional strategies. | 3
- Activation of regional advocacy spaces regarding the situation of youth with key actors (donors, follow up mechanisms for human rights, international cooperation) | 4
- Strategies that include employability alternatives over the interests/abilities of youth and not only within humanitarian aid. | 5

Regional articulation of the existing organization processes at a national level for the participation of young refugees and migrants, to know their proposals and promote their participation. | 6

Training of teachers in processes of school insertion of youth. | 7

Ensure the inclusion/participation of youth in the cycles of planning, consulting, proposals, and strategies at a national and regional level. | 8
