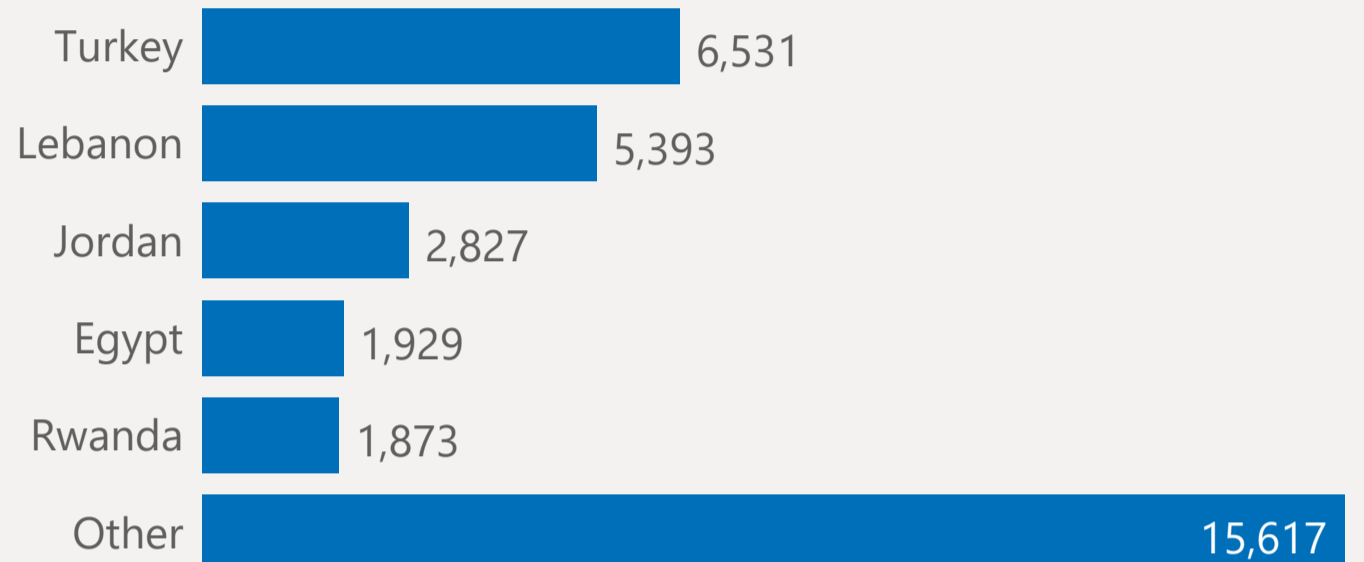

Projected global resettlement needs by region of asylum (including multi-year planning)

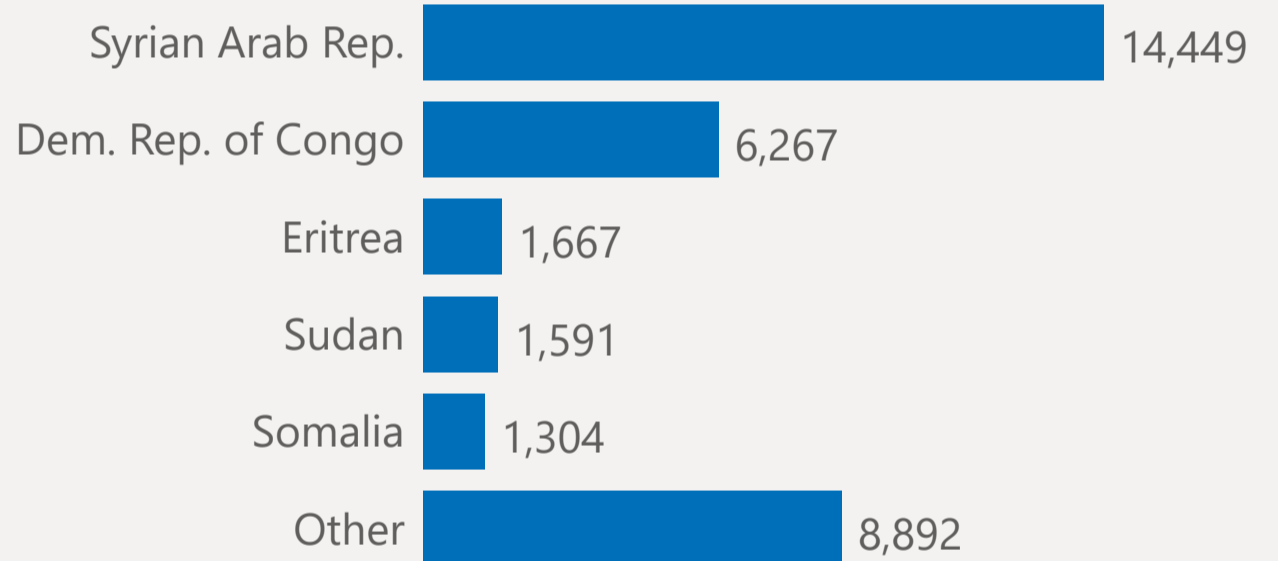

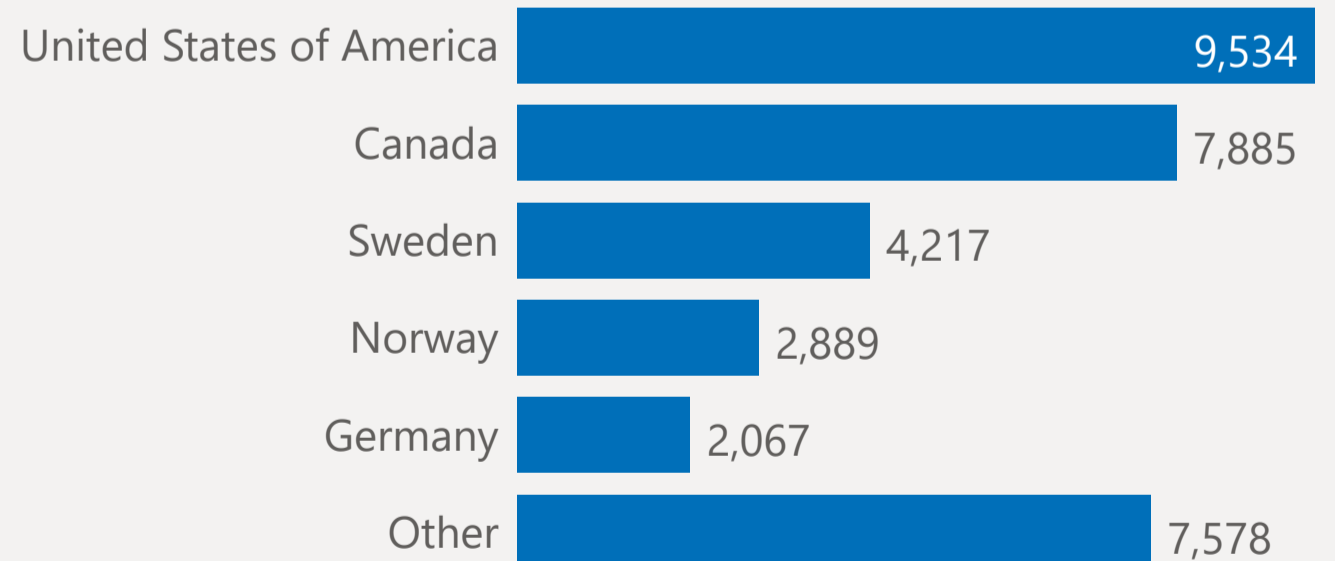
Submissions by country of asylum



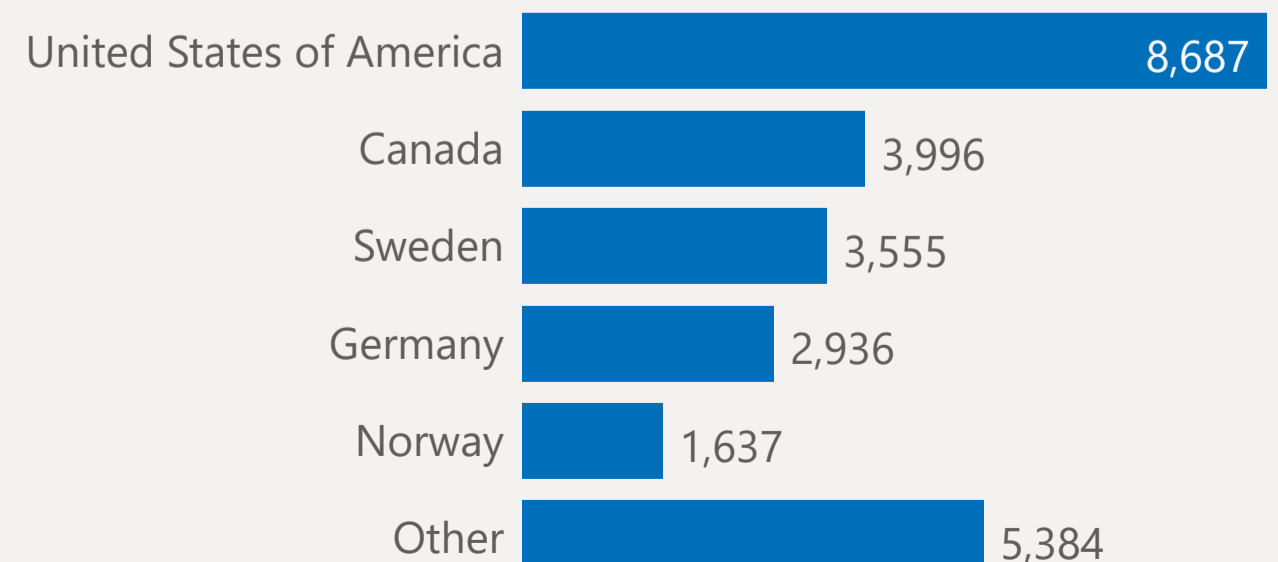
Submissions by country of origin



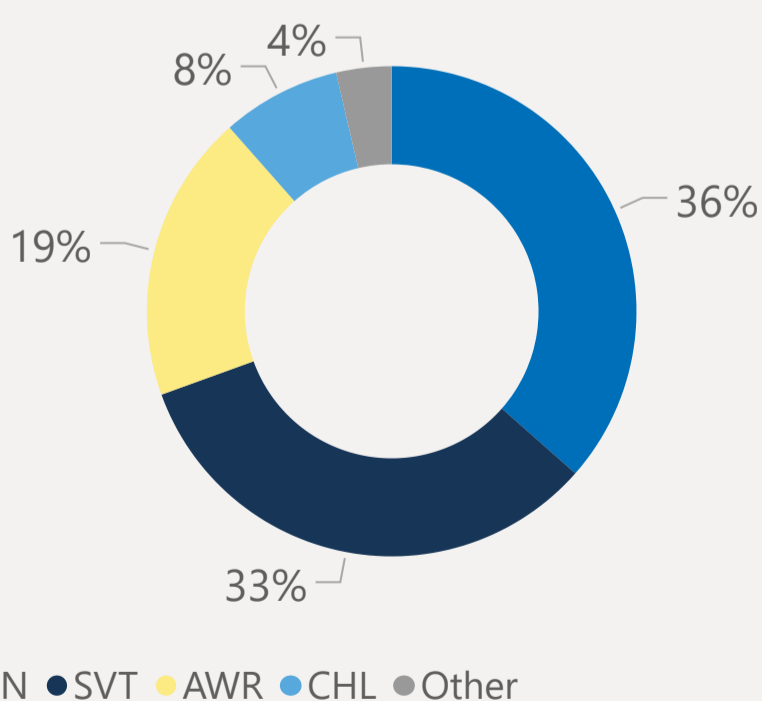
Submissions by destination
