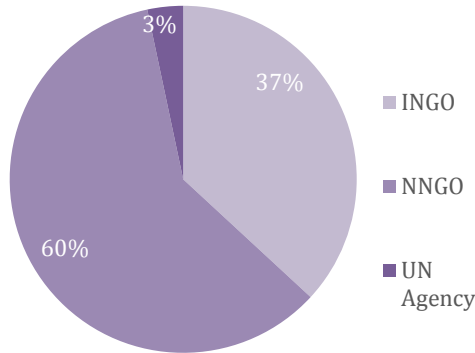

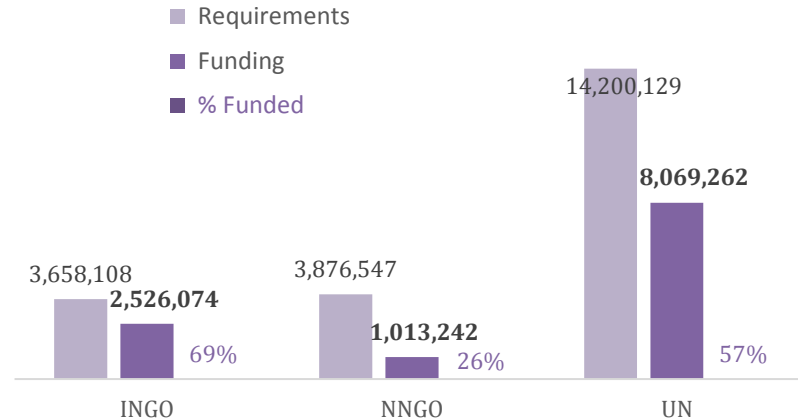

30 Partners implemented Child Protection in Emergency (CPIE) activities in 2016. Out of these, 60% (18) were National NGOs, 37% (11) were International NGOs, and 3% (1) was by one UN Agency.

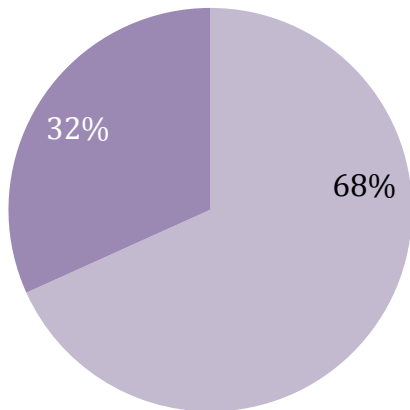


Funding Requested and Received in 2016, by type of organisation

11 organizations submitted their CPSC asks in the 2016 HRP for South Sudan – composed of 3 INGOs, 7 NNGOs and 1 UN Agency.



CPWG Request as a % of Total Protection Cluster HRP Request



The Protection Cluster in South Sudan requested for \$88,237,249 in 2016. Out of these CP asked for \$28,009,923, accounting for 32% of the total request made by the Cluster. Children account for 61% of the 1.47 million people targeted.

■ PC Request without CP ■ CP Request

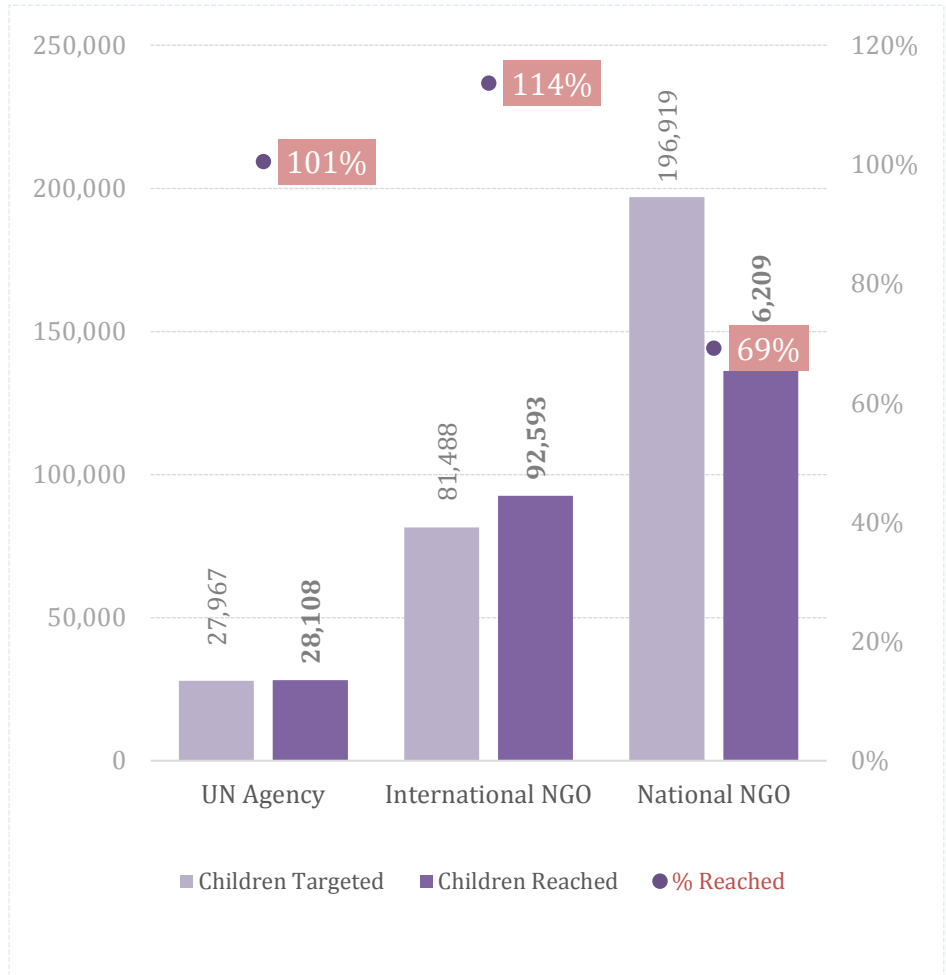

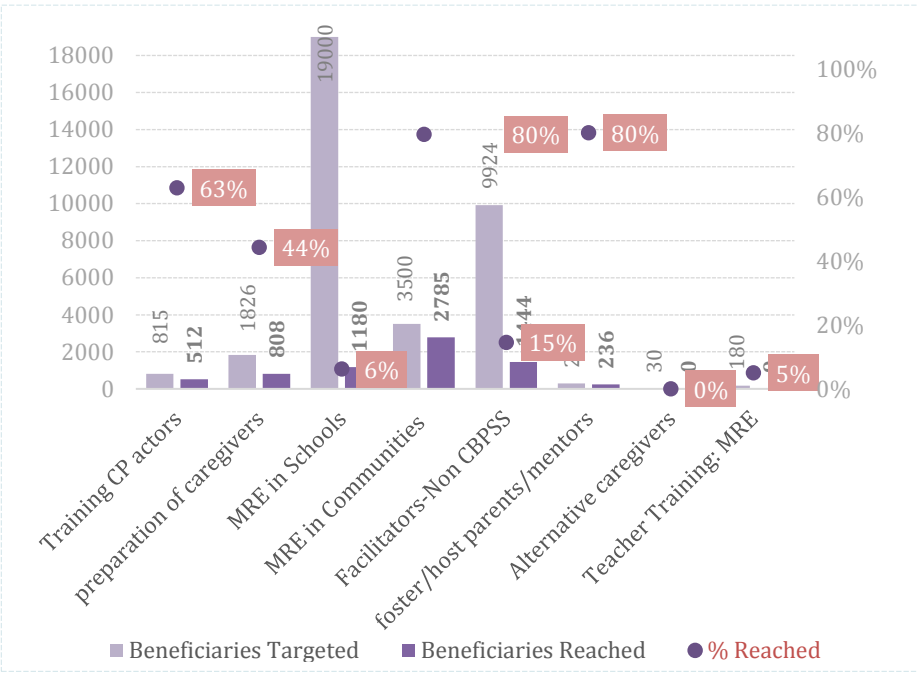
