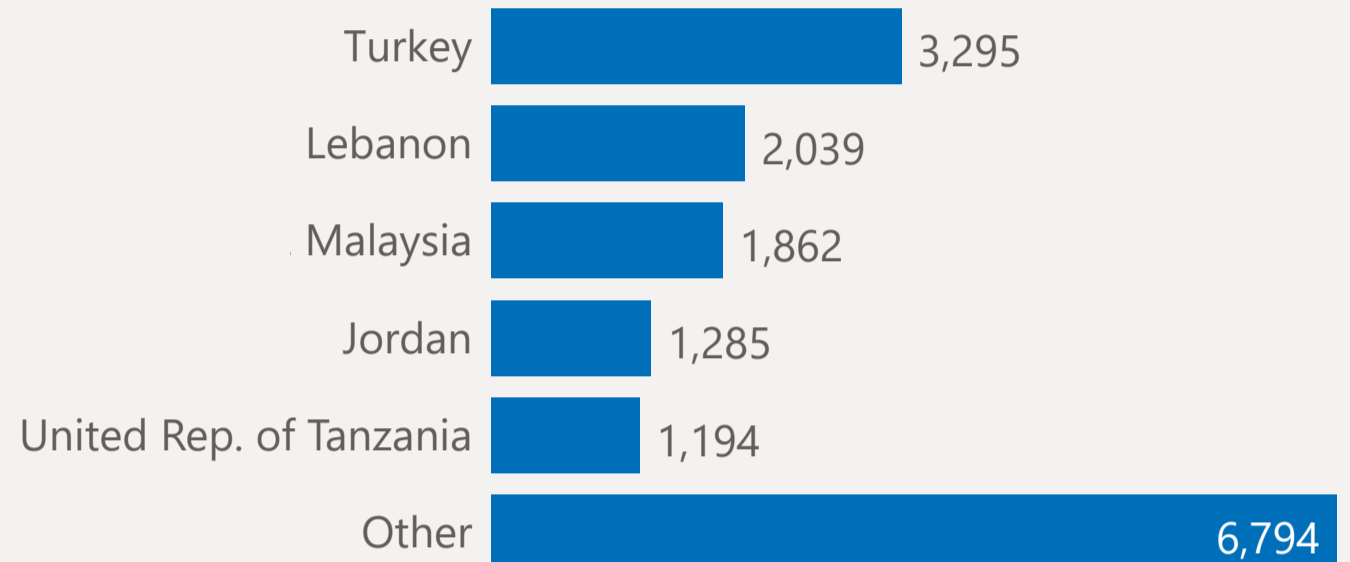

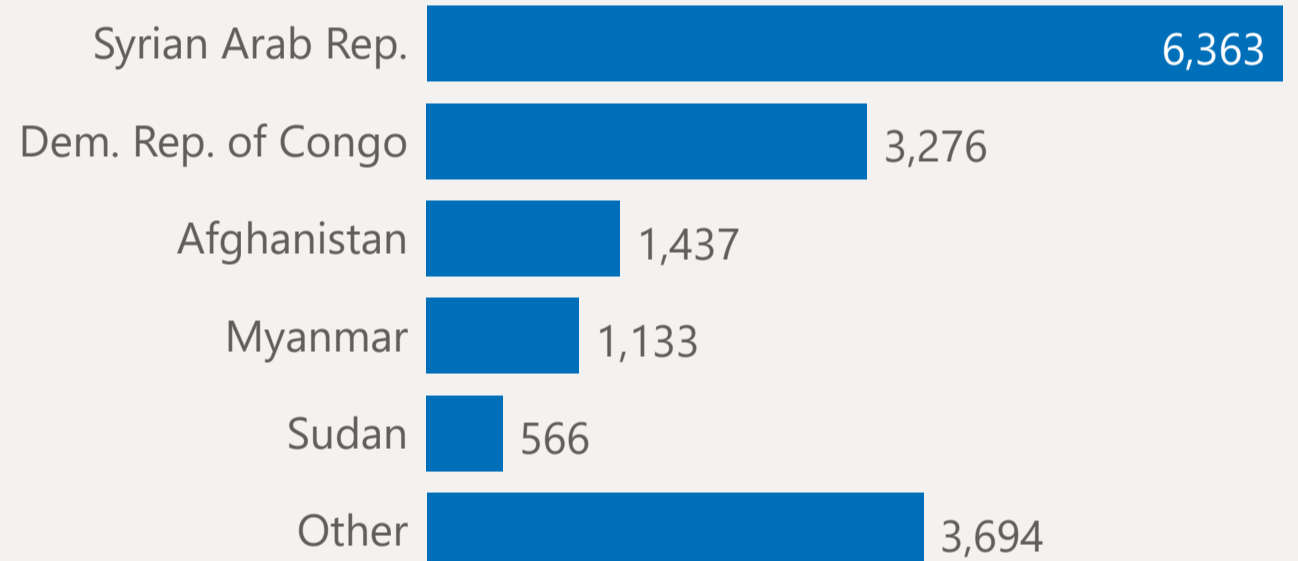

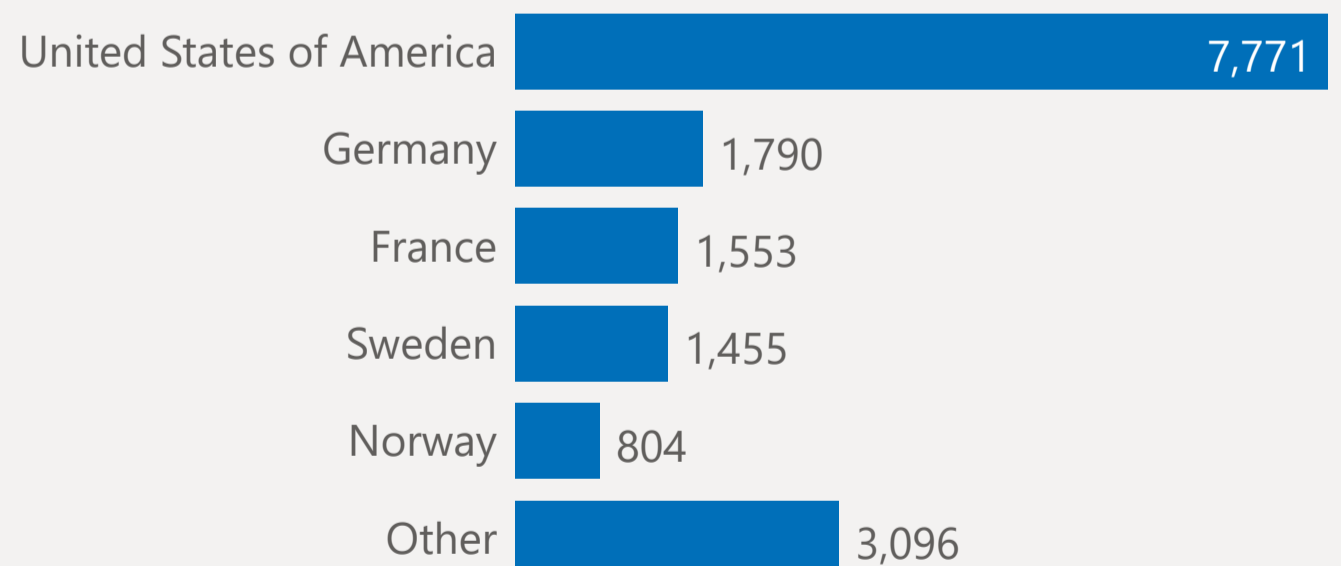
## Submissions by country of asylum



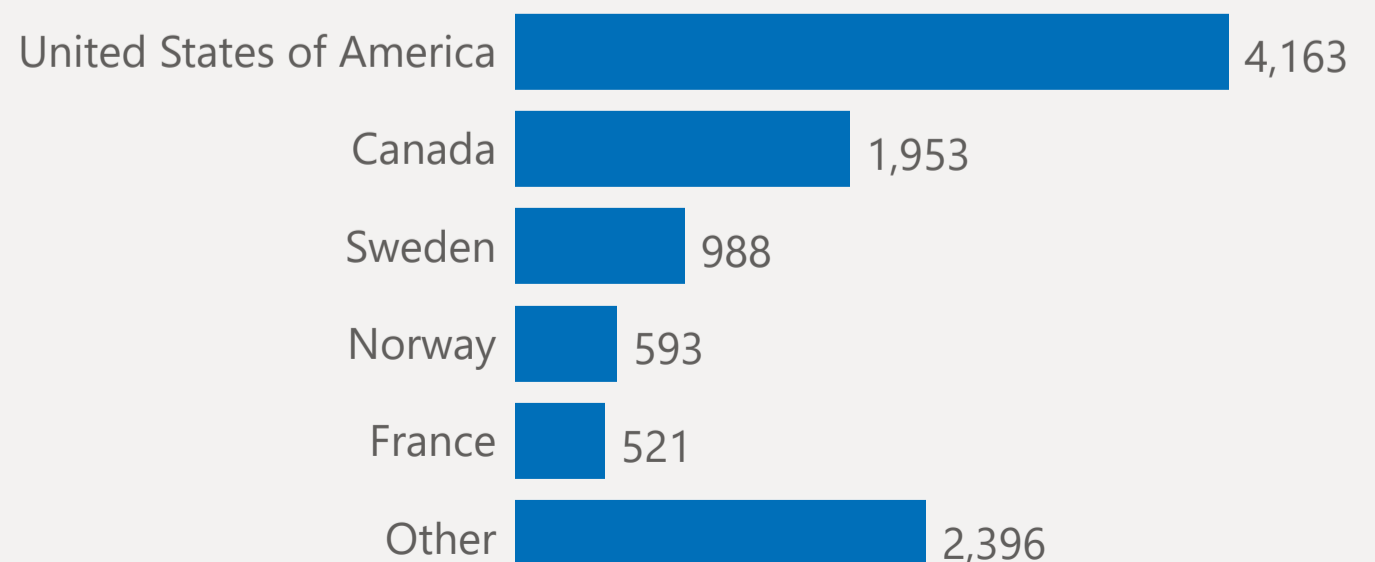
## Submissions by country of origin



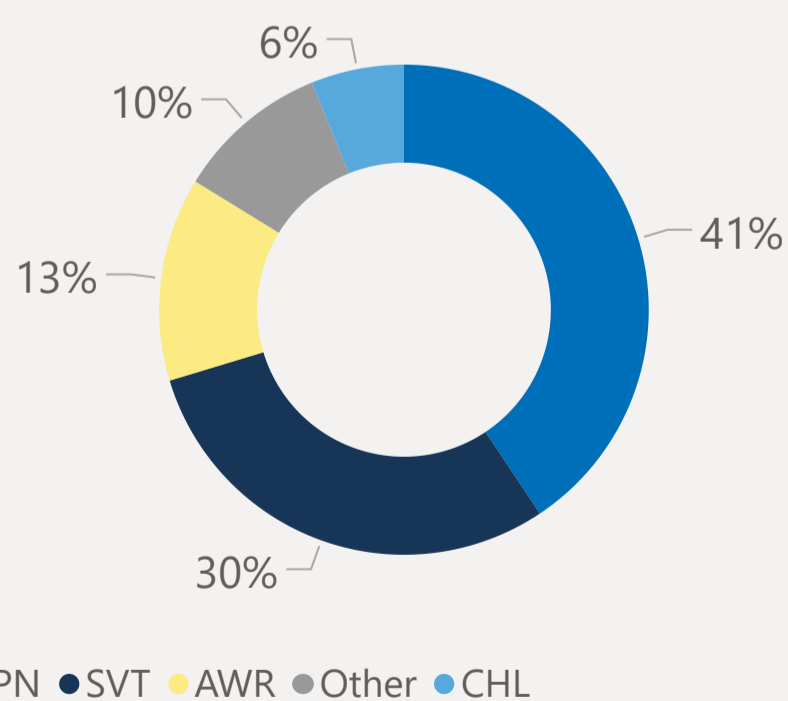
## Submissions by destination
