## The Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) (Amendment) Order 2013

Made - - - - 20th March 2013

Laid before Parliament 22nd March 2013

Coming into force - - 27th March 2013

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the power conferred by section 8B(5) of the Immigration Act 1971(a).

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) (Amendment) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 27th March 2013.
- **2.**—(1) Part 2 of the Schedule to the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2000(**b**) is amended as follows.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Schedule to the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2000.

It amends Part 2 of that Schedule to list: Council Implementing Decision 2012/809/CFSP of 20 December 2012 (Afghanistan) and Council Implementing Decision 2013/73/CFSP of 31 January 2013 (Afghanistan); Council Decision 2012/811/CFSP of 20 December 2012 (Democratic Republic of the Congo) and Council Implementing Decision 2013/46/CFSP of 22 January 2013 (Democratic Republic of the Congo); Council Decision 2012/829/CFSP of 21 December 2012 (Iran) and Council Decision 2013/124/CFSP of 11 March 2013 (Iran); Council Decision 2013/88/CFSP of 18 February 2013 (Democratic People's Republic of Korea); Council Decision 2013/109/CFSP of 28 February 2013 (Syria); Council Decision 2013/89/CFSP of 18 February 2013 (Zimbabwe);

Any person named by or under an instrument listed in the Schedule (as amended) or falling within a description specified in such an instrument will be excluded from the United Kingdom (subject to the exceptions specified in article 3 of the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2000).

A full impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no impact on the private or voluntary sector is foreseen.
