Re: Opinion on Malta :

by the Advisory Committee on the Framework Convention for the Protection of National Minorities

The Maltese authorities welcome the Opinion on Malta by the Advisory Committee for the Protection of National Minorities, adopted on 30 November 2000. The authorities consider that the draft recommendation and conclusions, included in the Opinion, further help establish a spirit of constructive dialogue while envisaging a follow-up procedure to the national report, presented in July 1999.

Data on the ethnic and religious composition of minorities in Malta

While noting the Opinion of the Advisory Committee, the Maltese authorities would like to forward the attached additional information, originally requested for inclusion in the national report. This data throws more light on the ethnic and religious composition of minorities in Malta, namely:

1. the Enumerated Population of the Maltese Islands by citizenship, dated 26 November 1995.
2. list of persons (by nationality) who hold employment licences to work in Malta.
3. list of persons (by nationality) who hold a permit to reside permanently in Malta.
4. separate sheets with the number of arrivals of ethnic groups of refugees, classified by nationalities, in the last four years, and the number of refugees in Malta as on 31.01.2001.
5. list of persons who had an extension of stay valid to remain in Malta, as on 22 March 2001.

Emigrants' Commission

The Emigrants' Commission in Malta comprises various bodies which provide spiritual and material assistance to migrants and tourists. The Commission has forwarded its comments on the linguistic or ethnic groups of refugees and their religion.

As for the linguistic groups, the Emigrants' Commission would classify refugees in three sectors:

- those who can communicate in English (Yugoslavs, Sierra Leonians, Sudanese),
- those who speak Arabic (Iraqis, Algerians, Moroccans, Syrians, Lebanese) and
- those who possess no language other than their own, like some Somalis and Sri Lankans. The Commission informs that it never had difficulties to converse through an interpreter.

As regards religion, the Emigrants' Commission groups refugees as follows:

- Christians (Catholics, Anglicans, Evangelists, Chaldeans, Assyrians, Orthodox, Coptic) and
- Islamic.

Christian non-European refugees used to have their prayers and mass in Arabic. Europeans normally attend one of the churches on the island. Greek Orthodox bring a minister for Christmas and Easter. Coptics are discussing the possibility of using one of the Catholic chapels. Moslems have their mosque.

Malta has recently enacted the Refugees Act which ensures that refugees receive proper treatment, in accordance with international standards, especially the 1951 Geneva Convention on Refugees, ratified by Malta in 1971. The structure will include the establishment of a Refugees Commissioner to examine applications by asylum seekers, and an Appeals Board to consider appeals from any decision by the Commissioner. The Act also provides all the safeguards relative to refugees with regard to full protection under the law, free education, free medical assistance and free movement of the refugee and his family.

The Emigrants' Commission hopes that the Refugees Act will entitle refugees to work and social benefits. Experience has taught the Emigrants' Commission that refugees who are refused resettlement by receiving countries tend to be most difficult. They are the people who talk most of discrimination.
