### Notes

By 30 June, UN partners verified 8,174 individuals newly displaced in Darfur during 2017. This includes 7,680 individuals displaced from East Darfur to El Lait locality, North Darfur during February and March, and 494 individuals, displaced from Central Jebel Marra to Hassa Hissa camp, Central Darfur, in January. An estimated 3,997 people were reportedly displaced in Um Dukhun, Central Darfur following armed clashes reported between members of Salamat and Misseriya tribes in the area in mid May. There have been unconfirmed reports of civilian displacement in Ensiro, Kutum Locality, North Darfur following the clashes between RSF/SAF and SLA-MM/SLA-TC on 27 May. No displacement figures are available by far.
