LAW ON CHANGING AND AMENDING THE LAW ON IDENTITY CARD

Article 1

In the Law on Identity Card ("Official gazette of the Republic of Macedonia" number 8/95), in the Article 5 paragraph 1, words such as: "with affixed" and "label of the series and the serial number" are erased.

Paragraph 2 is changed and it reads:

"In the form of the identity card the following data are inscribed: given name and family name of the citizen; date of birth; sex; citizenship; domicile and address of the apartment; personal registration number of the citizen; registry number; period of validity of the identity card and signature of the holder of the identity card."

Following paragraph 2, three new paragraphs 3,4 and 5 are added which read:

"The form of the identity card is printed in the Macedonian language and its Cyrillic alphabet and in the English language and its Latin alphabet.

The data in the form of the identity card are inscribed in the Macedonian language and its Cyrillic alphabet, while the data for the given name and the family name of the citizen, sex and citizenship are inscribed in the English language and its Latin alphabet as well.

To the citizens who speak an official language other than the Macedonian language, the form of the identity card is printed and the data are inscribed in it in the official language and alphabet used by the citizen as well."

Article 2

This law enters into force on the eighth day from the day of its publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia.
