
CROSS-BORDER OPERATIONS


FROM TÜRKIYE TO SYRIA*

Since 2014, in order to support partners to access vulnerable populations and preposition relief supplies, the Logistics Cluster has been facilitating the transhipment of UN agencies' humanitarian cargo being transported into Syria through UNSC-authorised border crossings.

To efficiently do so and in an effort to address common logistics gaps, minimise duplication of efforts, and enhance operational decision-making, the Logistics Cluster holds regular coordination meetings in Gaziantep, Türkiye, and supports with timely and reliable information management.

Transhipment operations are supervised by the United nations Monitoring Mechanism (UNMM). Since 2014, 100% of transhipment requests have been fulfilled.

BREAKDOWN OF TRANSHIPPED CARGO








