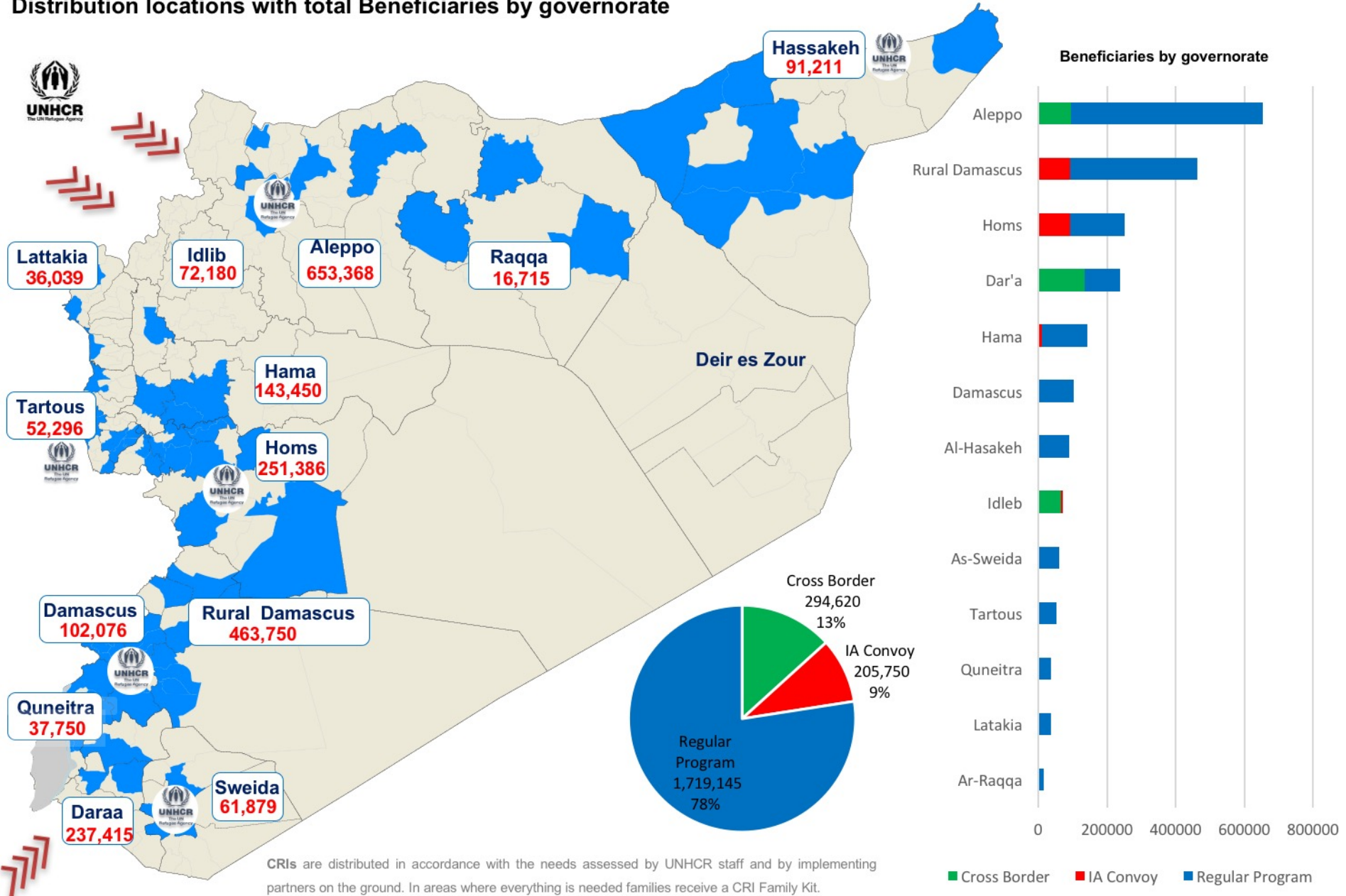

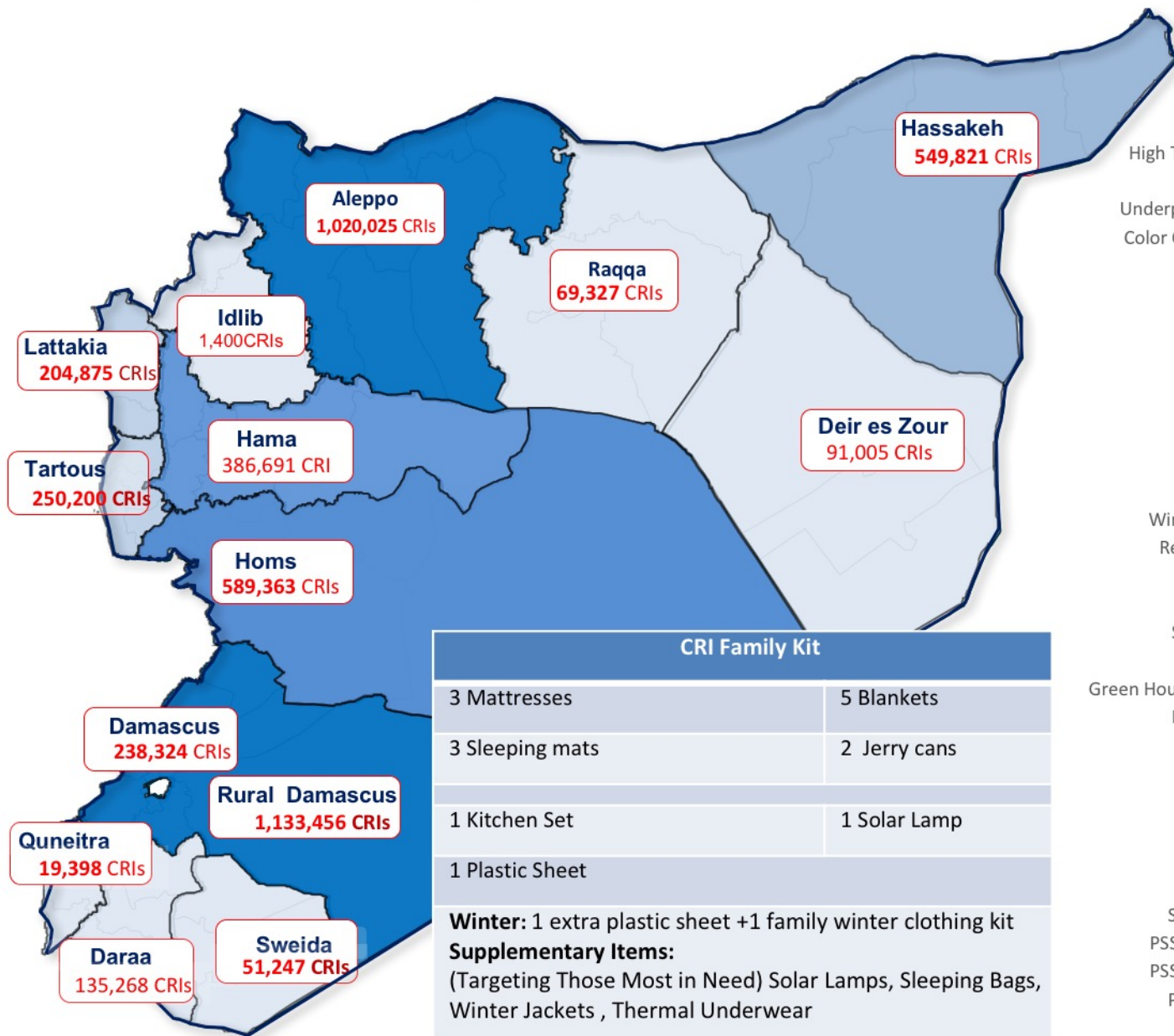
Distribution locations with total Beneficiaries by governorate



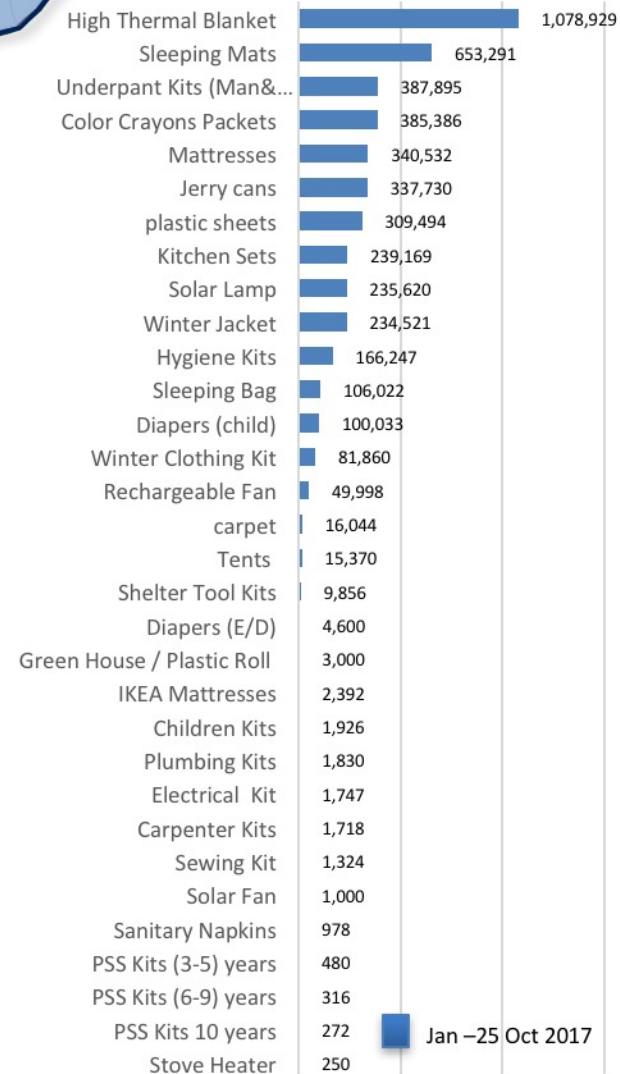

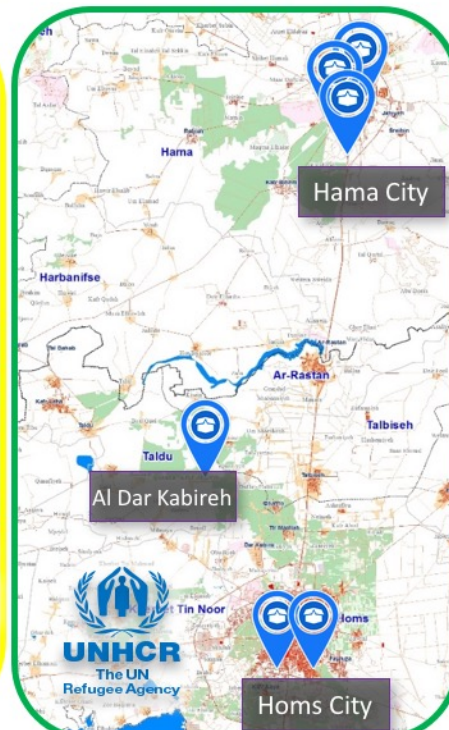
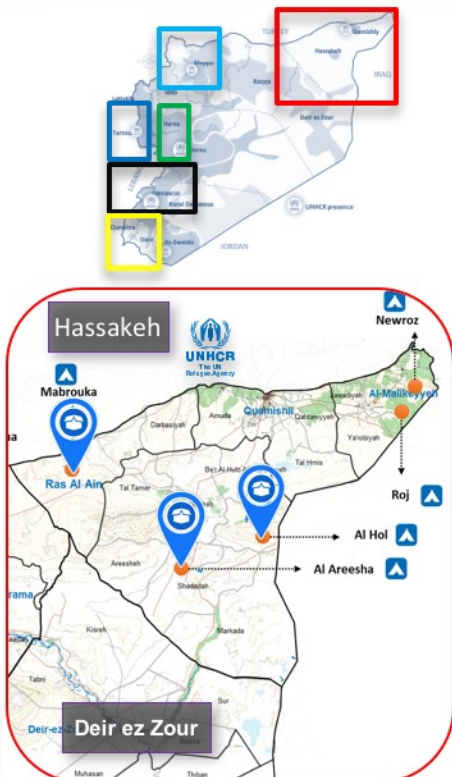
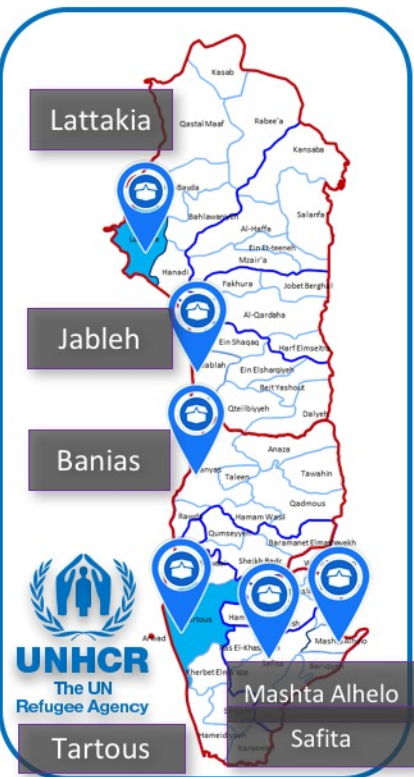
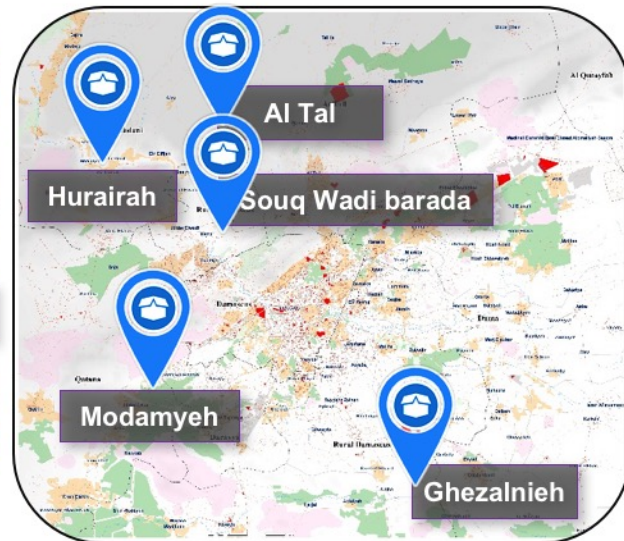
So far in 2017 UNHCR Dispatched 7,770,030 CRIs to the 14 Governorates as of 25/10/2017

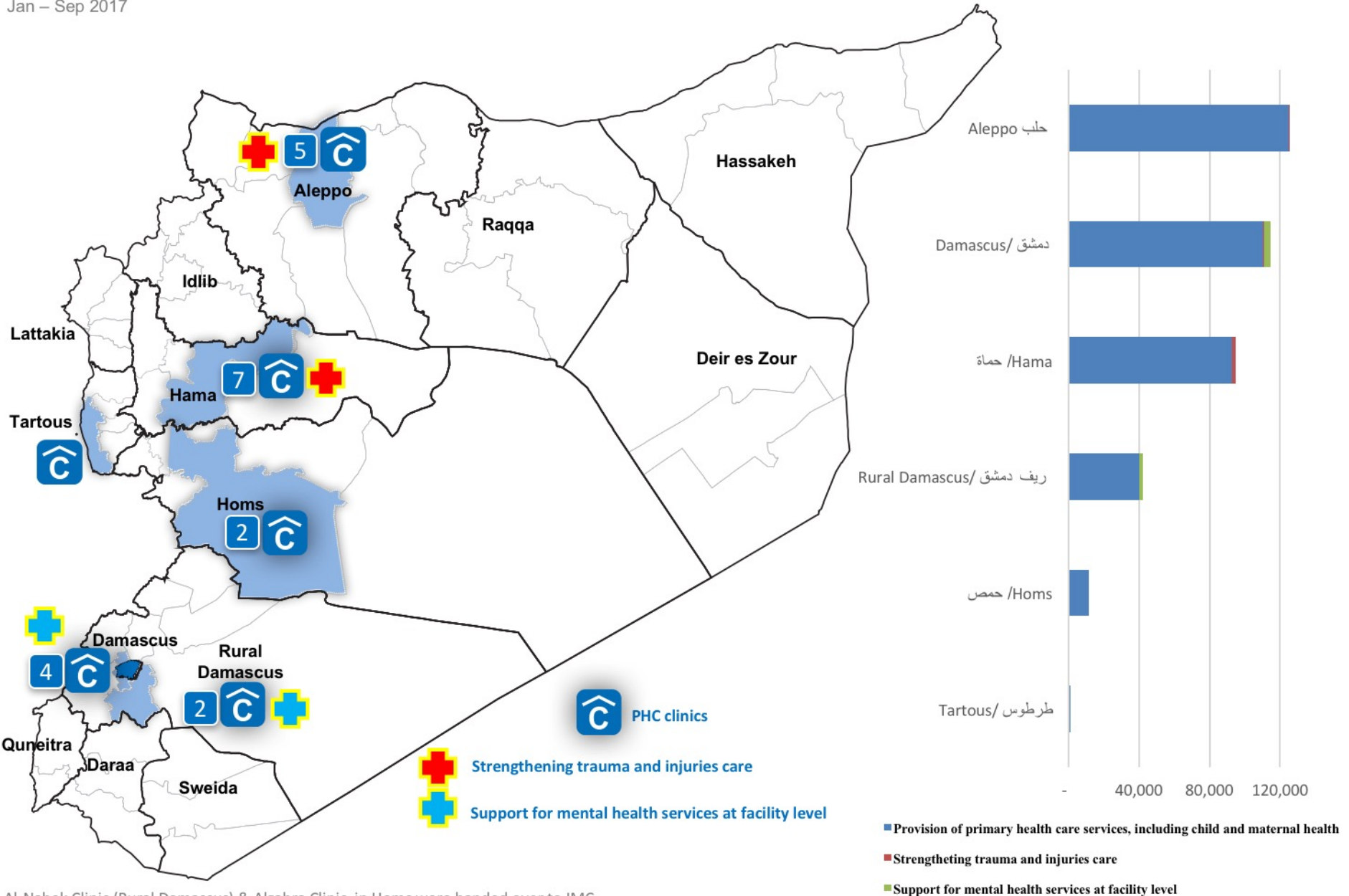
