




Total Population: 13,497 Individuals with 7,956 Cases








Monthly Statistical Report March 2021

Children Registered with UNHCR

At the end of March some 3,655 children were registered with UNHCR, including 3,545 children in families, 73 children who are unaccompanied by a parent or other adult relative, and 37 children who are separated from their parents but living with an adult caregiver. Together with our partners, UNHCR is working to ensure all refugee children have access to an education, and as of March some 731 refugees were enrolled in accredited national schools.

Persons Registered with UNHCR in Detention and Alternatives to Detention

Some 8 persons registered with UNHCR, or less than 1 percent of the population were in immigration detention at the end of March, none are children and woman. UNHCR continues to advocate to end the detention of refugees in Indonesia and for those being detained to be released to alternative arrangements including placement in community accommodation, periodic reporting mechanisms, or community supervision. As of end-March, alternative accommodations were being provided for some 7,801 individuals (of whom 69 were unaccompanied or separated children).
