


## Prevalence of Female Genital Mutilation/Cutting (FGM/C) among Women Aged 15-49




**Inequalities**: Human rights violations affect women and girls differently. Girls who are the least educated are at the greatest risk of FGM/C.




Levels: currently, 89% of women aged 15-49 in Mali have undergone some form of FGM/C

**Trends:** prevalence of FGM/C has increased by 4% between 2006 and 2010; FGM/C is less common among girls 15-19 than women 45-49




#### **Projections**

To meet the target of reducing the FGM/C rate by half, more intensive interventions and resources are needed




If present trends continue, 1,255,000 girls born between 2010-2015 will experience FGM/C by 2030  $\,$



More than **two thirds** of the women who have undergone FGM/C were cut before age 5










