

## FGM PREVALENCE RATE

The estimated prevalence of FGM in girls and women (15-49 years) is $72.5 \%$ (MICS 2006). This appears to have decreased by $4.1 \%$ from $76.6 \%$ in 2003 (DHS 2003).

The prevalence of FGM in girls and women within the 15-19 age group is estimated at $59.7 \%$, which appears to be $20.1 \%$ less than FGM prevalence in the $35-39$ age group which is estimated at $79.8 \%$ (MICS 2006). There seems to have been a $5.3 \%$ reduction in prevalence for girls and women in the age group of 15-19 when compared with figures from 2003 (DHS 2003), which estimated FGM prevalence to be at $65 \%$. Figures suggest a slight decrease (1.8\%) in prevalence for women in the age group of 35-39 from 81.6\% 2003 (DHS 2003).

Figures also suggest a $4.8 \%$ difference in FGM prevalence between girls and women (15-49 years) who live in urban and rural areas, with estimated FGM prevalence at $76 \%$ and $71.2 \%$ respectively (MICS 2006).

The most prevalent type of FGM practised in Burkina Faso is 'flesh removed' (Types I and II) (89.5\%), with 3.8\% having Type III (MICS 2006).

The government of Burkina Faso has passed legislation that specifically prohibits the practice of FGM (MICS 2006).
