Prevalence of Female Genital Mutilation/Cutting (FGM/C) among Women Aged 15-49


Inequalities: Human rights violations affect women and girls differently. Girls living in rural areas are at the greatest risk of FGM/C.


## Opposition to FGM/C

About 28 percent of women believe FGM/C should be discontinued


Levels: currently, 76\% of women aged 15-49 in Gambia have undergone some form of FGM/C
Trends: prevalence of FGM/C has decreased by 3\%
between 2005 and 2010


## Projections

To meet the target of reducing the FGM/C rate by half, more intensive interventions and resources are needed


If present trends continue, 129,000 girls born between 2010-2015 will experience FGM/C by 2030

## FGM/C among Young Girls

42\% daughters aged 0-14 in Gambia have undergone some form of FGM/C, prevalence among girls of the Sarahuleh ethnic groups are extremely high - more than 70\%
Indicator captures a certain point in time and not an eternal truth, as these young girls might be cut at a later stage in their lives


## Age at FGM/C

More than half of the women who have undergone FGM/C were cut before age 5

## Type of FGM/C and Performers of FGM/C

Almost 90\% of girls and women who have undergone FGM/C have had their genitalia cut, with some flesh removed


FGM/C is essentially performed by traditional circumcisers (more than 95\%)
