In April 2013 the *United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq* reported that Baghdad was one of the areas most affected by violence in March 2013,

"UNAMI remains concerned at the rise in violence in Iraq and the increasing toll on lives of Iraqi civilians and its detrimental impact on civilian infrastructure. Iraqi continues to suffer from attacks perpetrated by a number of terrorist groups, among them Al-Qaeda in Iraq and the Islamic State of Iraq. The most affected areas remain Baghdad, and the governorates of Anbar, Salahuddin and the disputed areas of Ninewa and Kirkuk."

In May 2013 the *United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq* reported that Baghdad was the area worst affected by violence in April 2013, with 211 civilians killed,

"Baghdad was the worst affected Governorate with a total of 697 civilian casualties (211 killed, 486 injured), followed by Diyala, Salahuddin, Kirkuk, Ninewa and Anbar."²

In June 2013 the *United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq* reported that Baghdad was the area worst affected by violence in May 2013, with 532 civilians killed,

"Baghdad was the worst affected Governorate with 1,817 civilian casualties (532 killed, 1,285 injured), followed by Salahuddin, Ninewa, Anbar, Diyala and Kirkuk."³

In July 2013 the *United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq* reported that Baghdad was the area worst affected by violence in June 2013, with 258 civilians killed,

"Baghdad was the worst-affected Governorate with 950 civilian casualties (258 killed, 692 injured), followed by Salahuddin, Ninewa, Diyala and Anbar (tripledigit figures).

Kirkuk, Babil, Wasit, Basra and Najaf also reported casualties (double-digit figures)."4

In August 2013 the *United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq* reported that Baghdad was the worst affected by violence in July 2013 with 238 civilians killed,

"Baghdad was the worst-affected governorate in July with 957 civilian casualties (238 killed and 719 injured), followed by Salahuddin, Ninewa, Diyala, Kirkuk and Anbar (triple-digit figures).

Babil, Wasit and Basra also reported casualties (double-digit figures)."5

In September 2013 the *United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq* reported that Baghdad was the area worst affected by violence in August 2013, with 317 civilians killed,

"Baghdad was the worst-affected governorate in August with 1,272 civilian casualties (317 killed and 955 injured), followed by Salahuddin, Ninewa, Diyala, and Anbar (triple digit figures). Kirkuk, Babil, Wasit and Basra also reported casualties (double-digit figures)."

On 18 September 2013 the *United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq* reported that the Deputy Special Representative of the United Nations Secretary-General for Iraq, Mr Gyorgy Busztin, condemned the "senseless" attacks in Baghdad and described violence in Iraq as escalating

""Yesterday's wave of attacks adds to dozens of others recently and such violence has unfortunately become the everyday fare of too many Iraqi citizens, trying to go about their daily lives; this must stop immediately," Mr. Busztin said. "The recent escalation of violence all over Iraq is extremely worrying and jeopardizes efforts at political reconciliation. The authorities should do their utmost to ensure that measures are put in place to stop the bloodshed,""7

The United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq reported the following estimates for civilian casualties throughout Iraq in 2013;

January; 319 civilians were killed and 960 were injured February: 418 civilians were killed and 704 were injured March: 229 civilians were killed and 853 were injured April; 595 civilians were killed and 1481 were injured May; 963 civilians were killed and 2191 were injured June: 685 civilians were killed and 1610 were injured July; 928 civilians were killed and 2109 were injured

August; a minimum of 716 civilians were killed including 106 civilian police and 1936 were injured including 195 civilian police.8

The UK based NGO Irag Body Count reported the following casualties and incidents in Baghdad between 1 March - June 2013, listed here by area9,

Unspecified areas

1 April; 1 killed by gunfire in Baghdad¹⁰

5/6 April; 1 killed (policeman) near Baghdad¹¹

6 May: 0-7 killed (Sunni worshippers and civilians) by bombs and hand granades in Baghdad¹²

8 June; 0-8 killed by car bombs in different neighbourhoods in Baghdad¹³

On 28 August 2013 Reuters reported that 86 people were killed and 263 injured in a series of car bombings across Baghdad. Reuters reported that "After years of reduced violence, the intensity of attacks has dramatically risen since the start of 2013. Bombings have often targeted cafes and other places where families gather, as well as the usual military facilities and checkpoints." On 28 August 2013 Reuters reported that car bombs in north, south and western Baghdad targeted both Shi'ite and Sunni areas of the capital. 15

15 April; 2 killed by a car bomb during rush hour near Imam Ali Mosque in Al-Obaidi, Baghdad¹⁶

19 March; 3 killed in a car bomb near Sirwan restaurant, Karadat Maryam near the Green Zone, Baghdad¹⁸

27 May; 5 killed by a car bomb in Sidriya market in a predominantly Shiite neighbourhood in downtown Baghdad¹⁹

28 May; 2 killed by gunfire in Baghdad²⁰

6 April; 1 killed by a bomb in northwest of Baghdad²¹

7 March; 1 killed (Imam, in front of his mosque) by gunfire in north Baghdad²²

13 April; 1 killed (Al-Insaf Front electoral candidate) in gunfire, in Baiji, 200km north of Baghdad²⁷

Bani Saad

5 March; 2-3 killed in a car bomb in Bani Saad, 35 km north of Baghdad²⁸

Chukook

16 May; 1 killed by car bomb at a police patrol in Chukook, northwest Baghdad²⁹

Hurriya

27 May; 3-5 killed by a car bomb in a market in a predominantly Shiite area in Hurriya northwest Baghdad³⁰

Husseiniya

3 March; 2-3 killed in two or three roadside bombs in Shiite neighbourhood, Husseiniya, northeast Baghdad³¹

- 24 April; 1-8 killed near a bus stop by a car bomb in a prominent Shiite area, Husseiniya, east Baghdad³³
- 1 May, 3 killed by a car bomb in a Shiite neighbourhood Husseiniya Bridge, northeast Baghdad³⁴
- 6 May; 2-8 killed by two car bombs near a police checkpoint at the centre and corner of Husseiniya Bridge, entrance to Husseiniya, northwest Baghdad³⁵
- 15 May; 1-4 killed by a car bomb at a restaurant at the Husseiniya intersection in predominantly Shiite area in northeast Baghdad³⁶

19 April; 2 killed in a bomb attack at an army officer's home in Ishaqi, 90 km north of Baghdad³⁷

4 March; 1 killed (Sunni) in gunfire in Shiite dominated neighbourhood, Jurriya Baghdad³⁸

- 31 March; 1 killed (policeman) by a magnetic bomb, Baghdad Gate, Kadhimiya, north Baghdad³⁹
- 8 May; 2-3 killed in a minibus by a magnetic bomb near Dabbash bridge and the Faculty of Law of Al-Nahrain University, Kadhimiya, northwest Baghdad⁴⁰
- 11 May; 2 killed in a roadside bomb near a sandwich kiosk in Kadhimiya, north Baghdad⁴¹
- 15 May; 2 killed by one or two car bomb in Kadhimiya, a predominantly Shiite area in north Baghdad⁴²
- 27 May; 2-3 killed by a car bomb near a bus stop in Orouba Square, Kadhimiya, a predominantly Shiite area in north Baghdad⁴³
- 9 June; 2 killed (civilians) by suicide car bomb at security checkpoint near Al-Adala military headquarters or prison, Kadhimiyah, north Baghdad⁴⁴
- On 28 August 2013 *Reuters* reported that two roadside bombs and one car bomb killed five people and wounded nearly 30 in Kadhimiya in northwestern Baghdad.⁴⁵

26 May; 3 killed in a drive-buy shooting in Uroba Square, Kazimiyah, northwest Baghdad⁴⁷ **Kasra**

On 11 September 2013 *Al Jazeera* reported that at least 33 people were killed and up to 55 were injured in a suspected sectarian attack when a car bomb exploded near a Shia place of worship in Kasra district in northwestern Baghdad,⁴⁸

- 19 March; 4 killed in a car bomb near the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs, Qahira, north Baghdad⁵¹
- 23 March; 1 killed (official from the Ministry of Water Resources) in gunfire in Qahira, northeastern Baghdad⁵²

19 April; 1 killed (Sahwa leader was executed) by gunfire at his home in Al-Taji, north of Baghdad⁶⁹

30 April; 1 killed (employee at Nasr State Establishment, part of the Ministry of Industry) in gunfire in Taji, 30 km north of Baghdad⁷⁰

10 June; 7-8 killed in a fish market in a religiously mixed area in Taji, 20km north of Baghdad⁷¹
