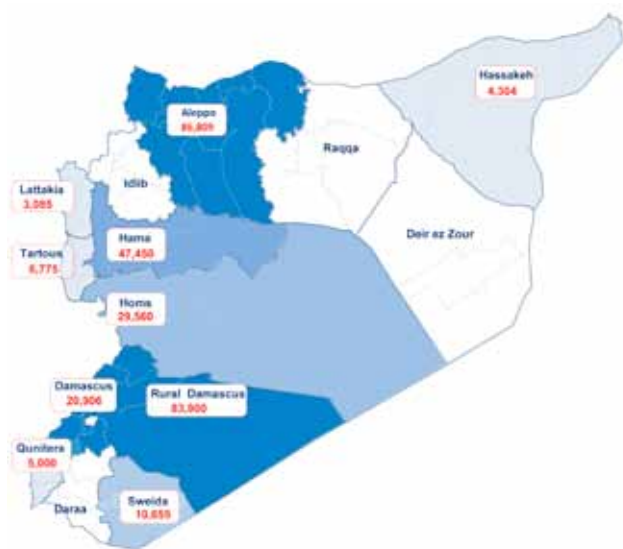
WORKING WITH PARTNERS

In 2016, UNHCR Syria had partnership agreements with 17 national NGOs, five international NGOs, one UN agency and government departments ministries such as the Ministry of Local Administration and the Ministry of Higher Education. UNHCR also worked closely with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of Social Affairs, the Ministry of Interior, the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Health. 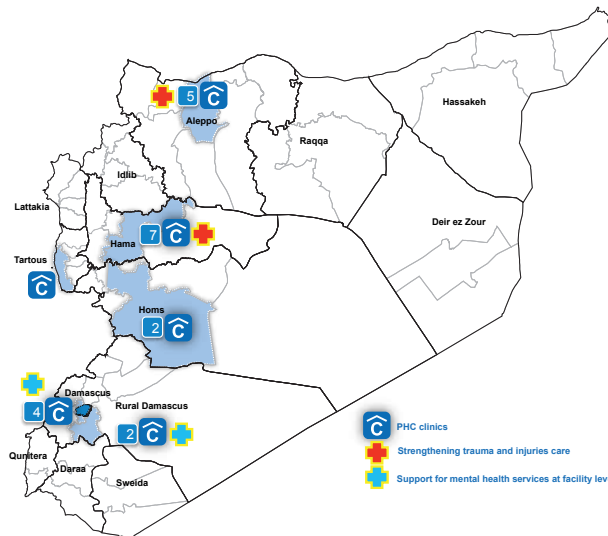

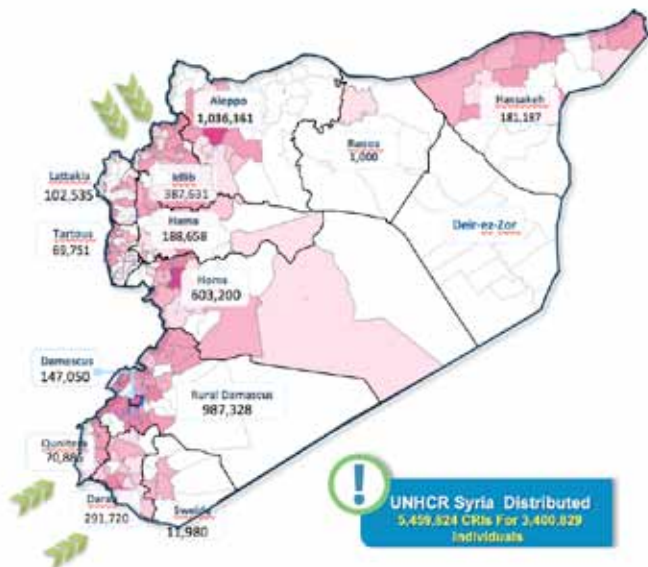


UNHCR concluded its 2016/2017 winterization programme on 28 February smashing target by 24%

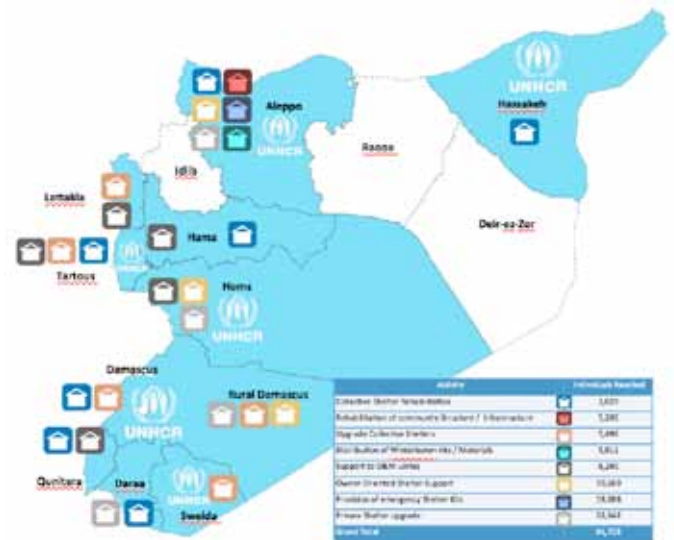

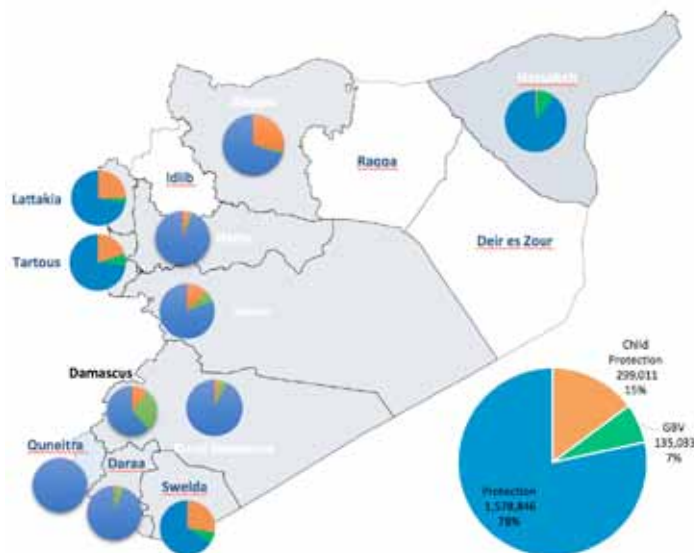
