# CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC: Situation in Bangui following unrest from 26 to 30 Sep 2015 (as of 1 October 2015)



## SITUATION OVERVIEW

Inter-community violence that erupted on 26 September has caused more than 40 deaths and more than 260 injured in the Central African capital. More than 42,000 people have taken refuge in sites, bringing the number of displaced persons in Bangui to a total of almost 70,000. As of 1 October, 30,000 people are sheltered at the Mpoko site near the airport which was already hosting some 11,000 people. After the latest violence, some 421,000 people are internally displaced in CAR.

The violence has caused panic in the capital, where a curfew has been imposed. The looting of several NGOs and international organisations offices and residences has taken place during the violence.



### **HUMANITARIAN SITUATION**

Fighting and the numerous roadblocks erected have worsened an already dire humanitarian situation, impeding the ability of aid partners to gain access to thousands of internally displaced people and assess needs. Moreover, this undermines efforts undertaken to implement the return plan for internally displaced persons set-up by the Humanitarian Country Team.

There are immediate needs for emergency shelter, health care and basic aid. Should the situation persist there will be a need for food supplies and hygiene and sanitation facilities. Displaced people are reported to be in a state of shock and extreme fear and may require psychosocial support.
