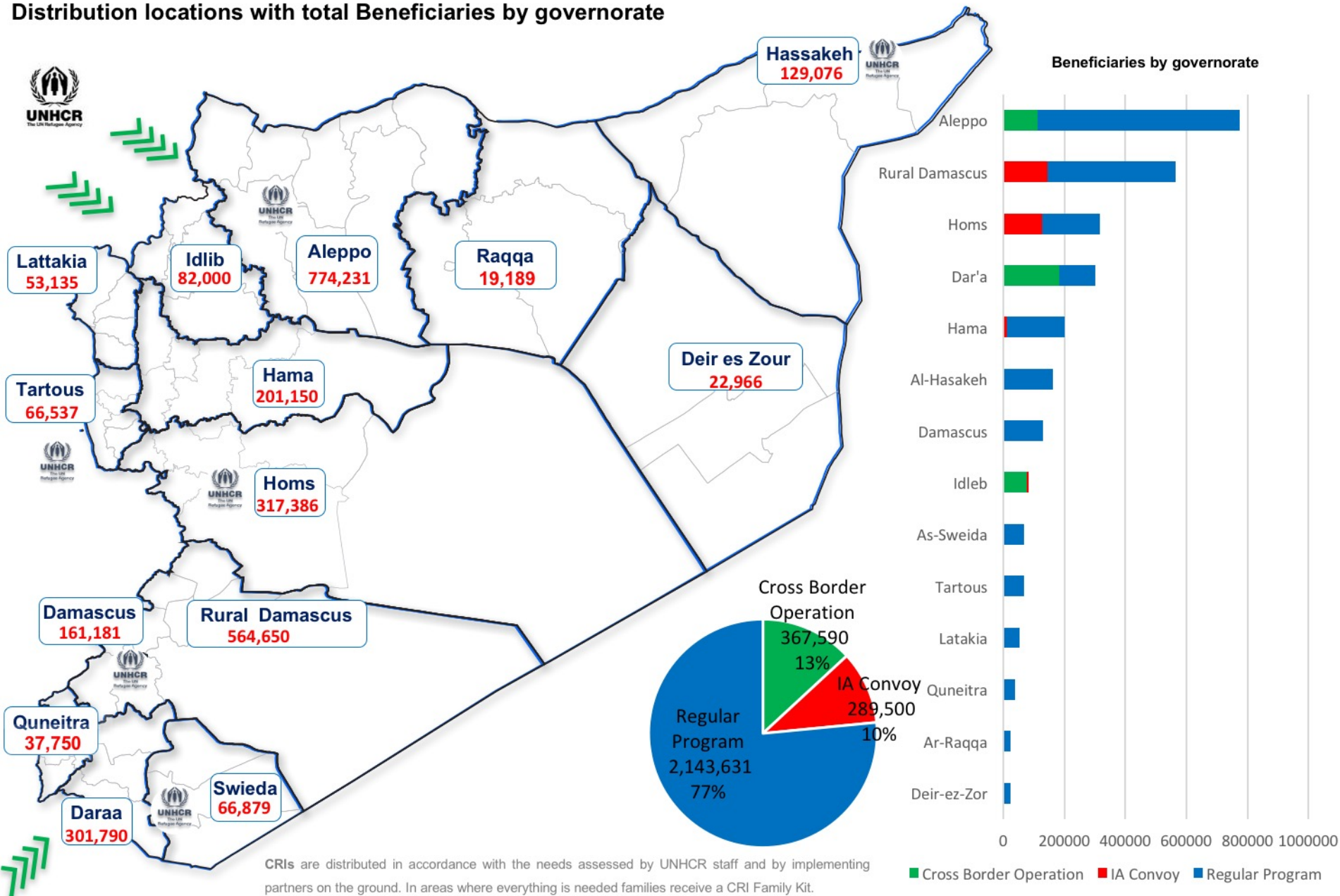

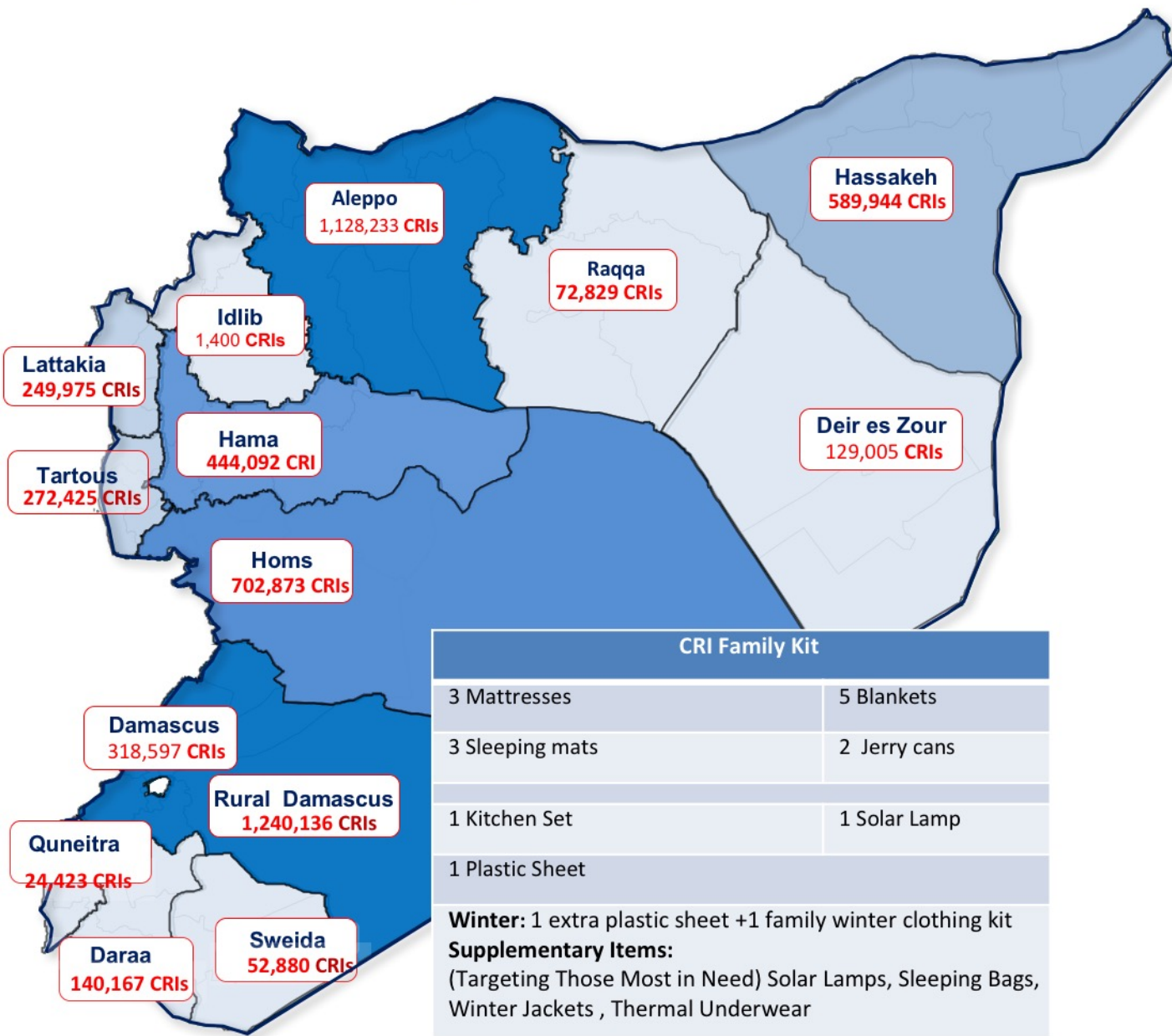
Distribution locations with total Beneficiaries by governorate

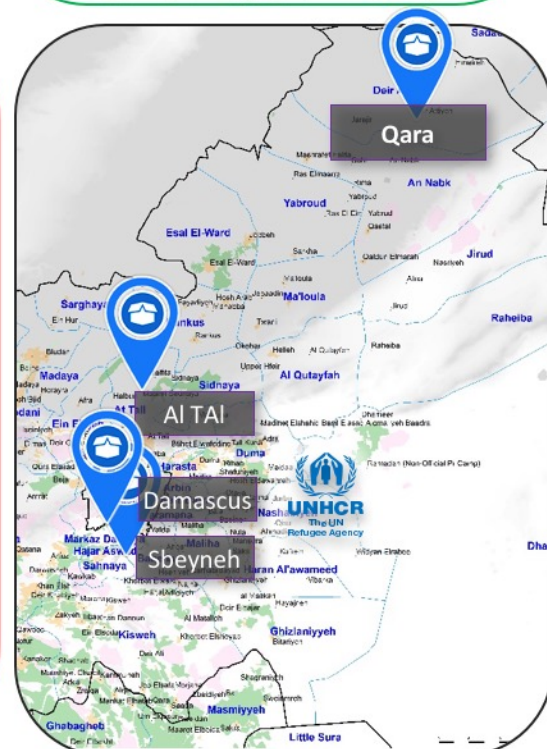
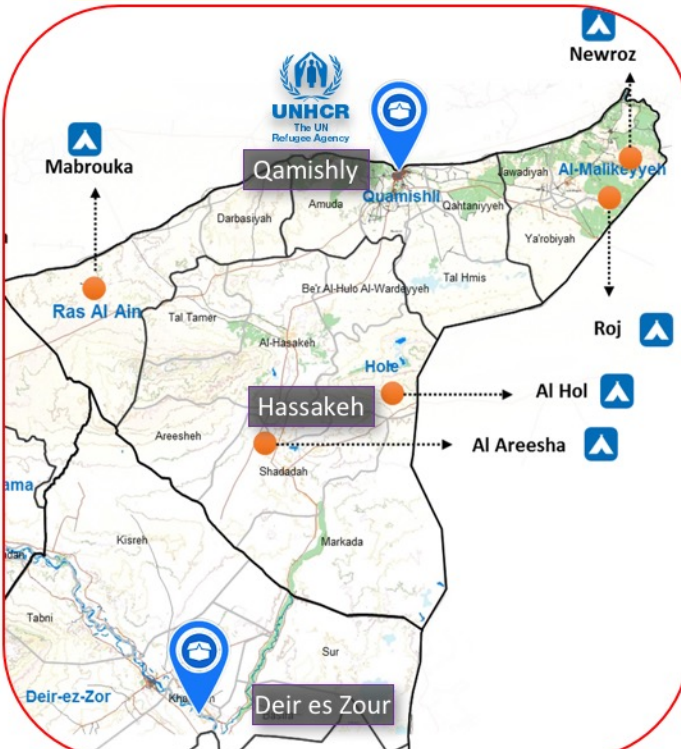
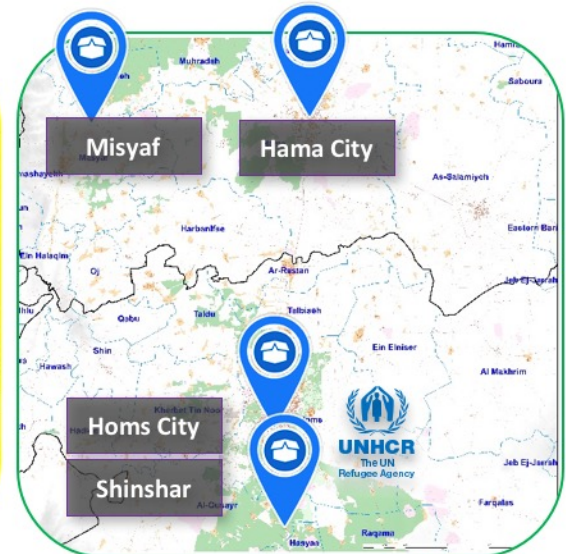
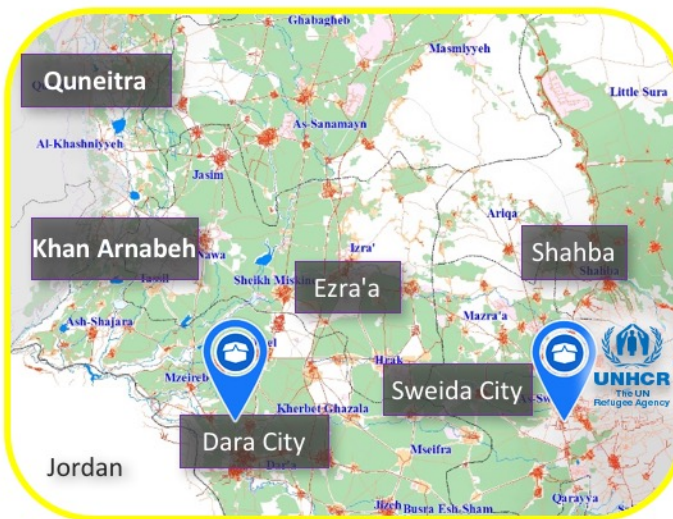
So far in 2017 UNHCR Dispatched 5,366,979 CRIs to the 14 Governorates as of 20/11/2017
