CONSTITUTION (AMENDMENT) (DUAL CITIZENSHIP) ACT 2018

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Amendment) (Dual Citizenship) Act 2018.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day appointed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

3 Repeal of section 23

Section 23 of the Constitution is repealed.

4 Amendment of section 49

Section 49(1)(a) of the Constitution is amended by inserting the following after "state":

", including by holding citizenship of a country other than Solomon Islands:"
