> Based on data from IOM, the total number of IDPs was estimated in May 2010 to stand at 26,600 families, or between 128,000 and 160,000 individuals.

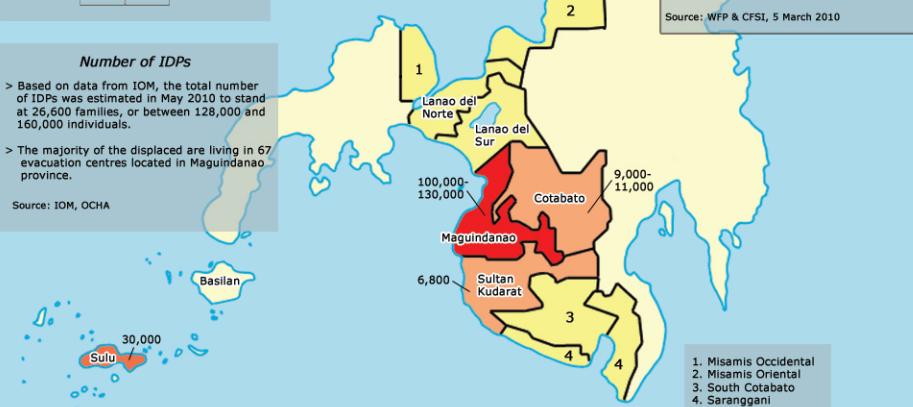
> The majority of the displaced are living in 67 evacuation centres located in Maguindanao province.
