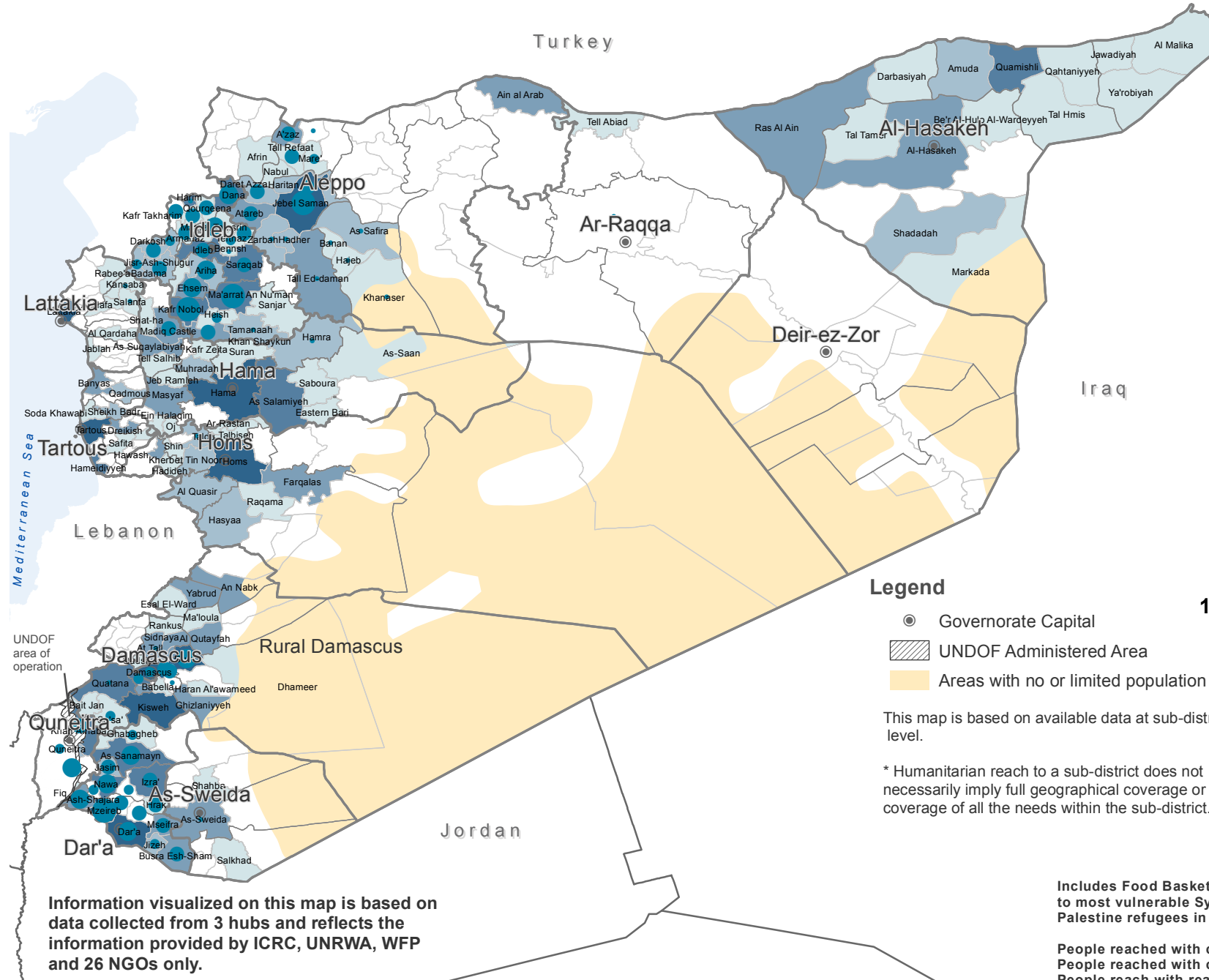


# Syrian Arab Republic: Whole of Syria Food Security - Sector Objective 1 (July 2015)
