48/155. <u>Situation of human rights in Estonia and Latvia</u>

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 47/115 of 16 December 1992,

 $\underline{\text{Taking into account}}$ the provisions of the Declaration on the Human Rights of Individuals Who are not Nationals of the Country in which They Live, 1/

<u>Having considered</u> the report of the Secretary-General, 2/

- 1. <u>Takes note</u> of the report of the Secretary-General and of the conclusions and recommendations therein of the United Nations fact-finding missions to Estonia and Latvia; 2/
- 2. <u>Welcomes</u> the cooperation that the Governments of Estonia and Latvia have extended to various international fact-finding missions;
- 3. <u>Notes</u> the existence of unresolved issues that involve large groups of population of different ethnic origin;
