Over 118,000 families have returned to FATA since March 2015, including both registered and unregistered families. Returns were halted from 24-27 September for the Eid holiday. Humanitarian activities were resumed in Bara on 22 September, after they were suspended due to curfew and search operations following the militants attack on the Air Force camp in Budhaber. The authorities will return families of Tehsil Sararogha from 29-30 September, Tehsil Serwakai from 1-3 October, and families of all Tehsils from 4-10 October. FDMA has planned returns to Orakzai and Kurram agencies tentatively from 29 September as per their return plan.


