

Update on assisted voluntary repatriation to Afghanistan


2,639 refugee returnees were assisted upon their arrival in Afghanistan from 8th to 14th July.

Majority of refugees are coming from **Pakistan (36,914)** and smaller numbers from **Iran (376)** and **other countries (94)**. 26.9% of returnees intended to return to Kabul Province while 20% plan to return to Nangarhar Province, followed by Logar Province with 10.5% destination of return.




Reasons to return to Afghanistan

From 8th to 15th July, through random selection, 361 persons were interviewed at Voluntary Repatriation Centres (VRCs) before departure from Pakistan and from 120 persons in Encashment Centres (ECs) upon return in Afghanistan.
