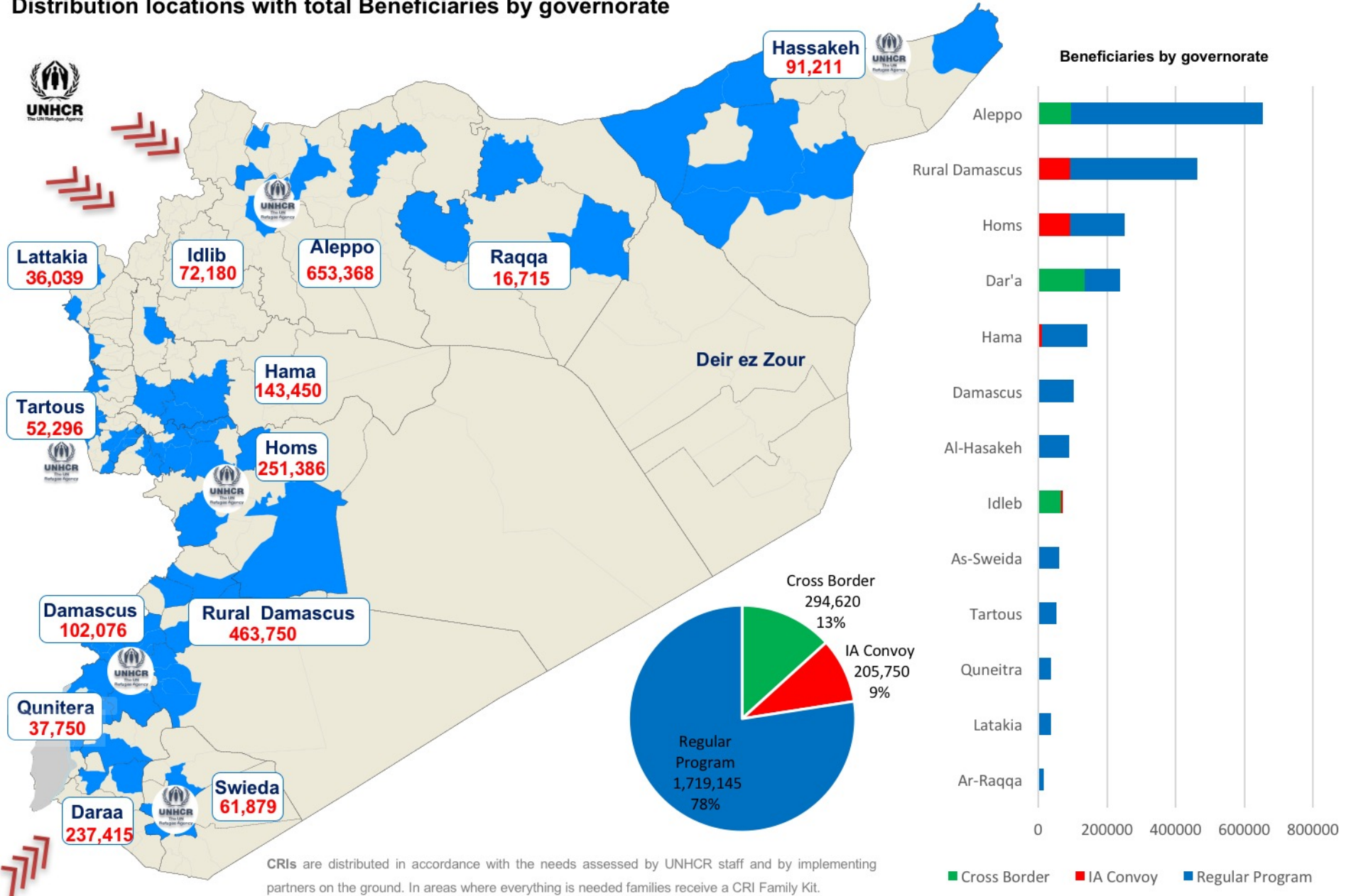

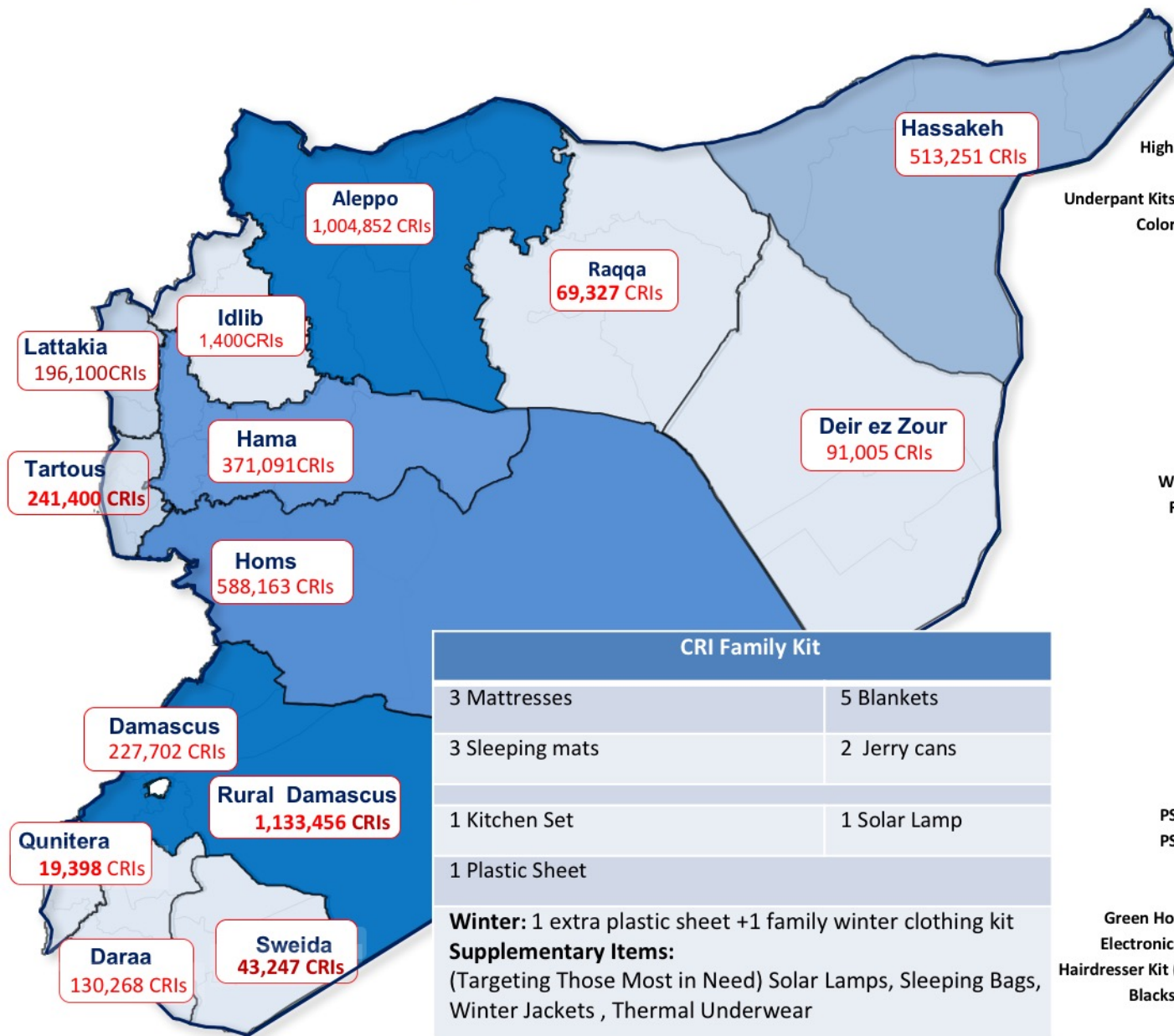
## Distribution locations with total Beneficiaries by governorate



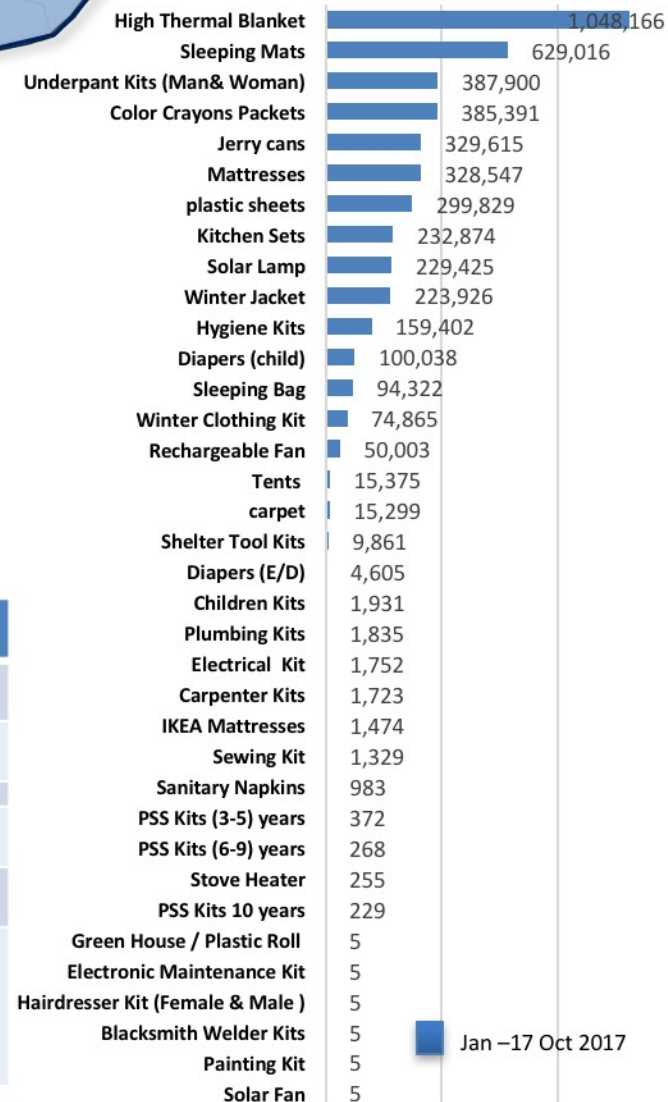

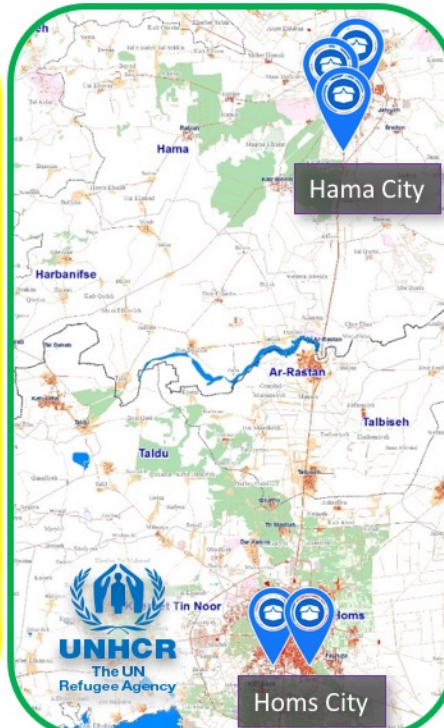
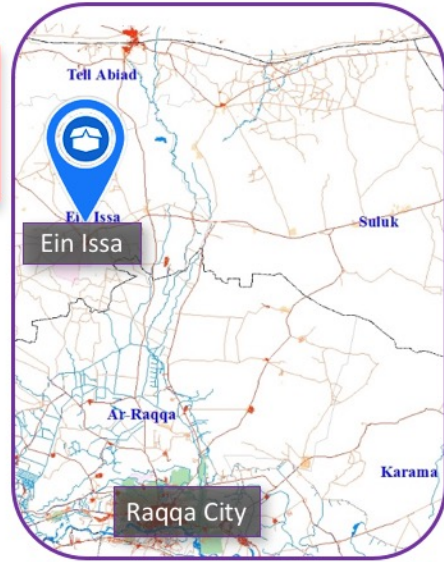
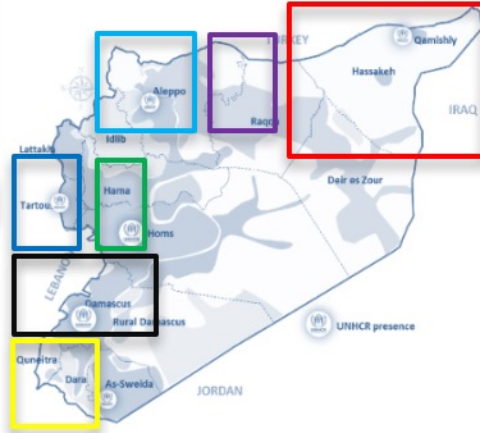
# So far in 2017 UNHCR Dispatched 4,630,640 CRIs to the 14 Governorates as of 16/10/2017

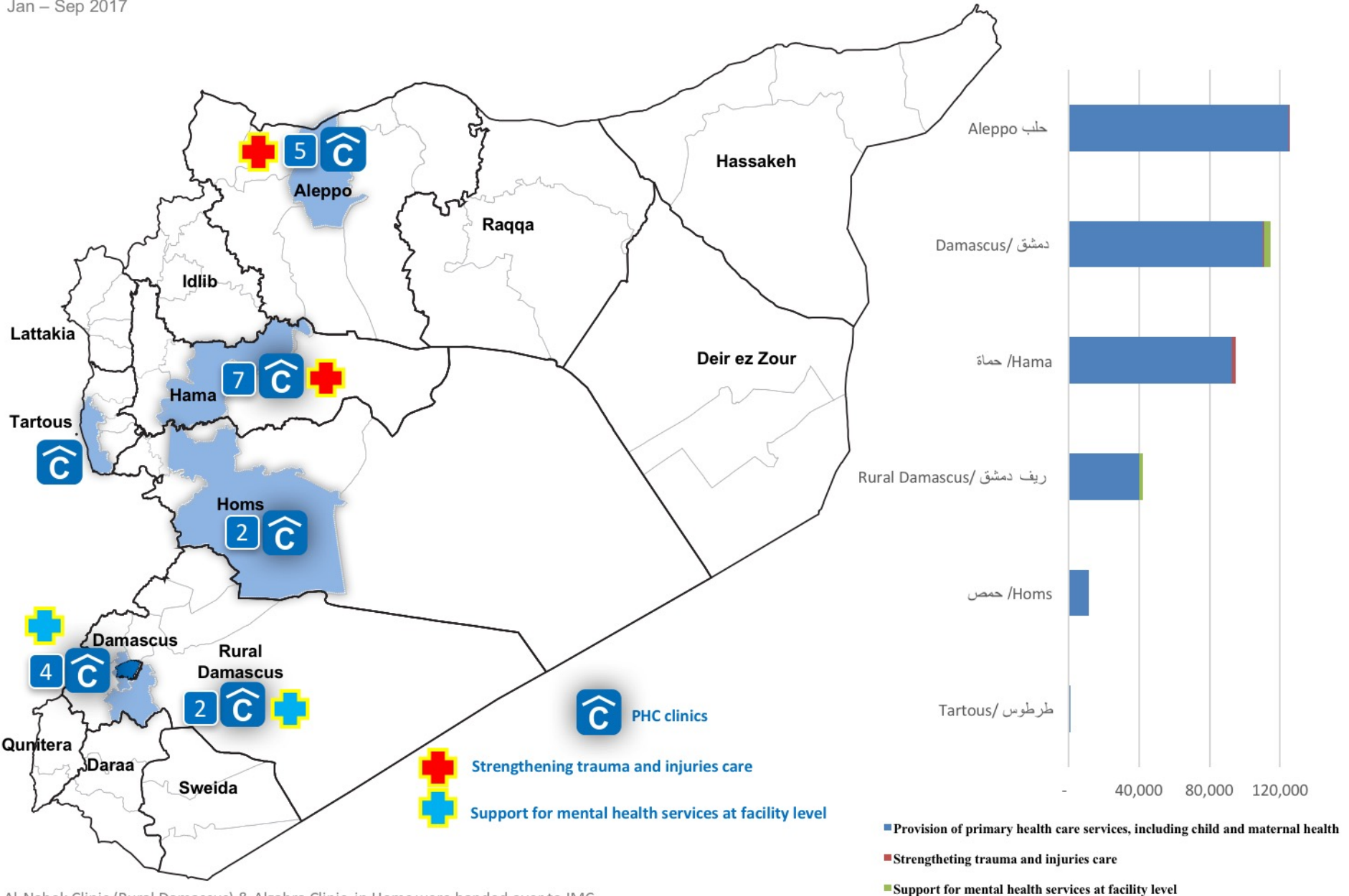
