## PREFACE

The information and statistics which feature in this publication were compiled by the Secretariat of the Söderköping Process based on inputs provided by the Governments of Belarus, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, Poland, Romania, Slovakia and Ukraine, as well as UNHCR and IOM.

This publication may serve as a useful point of reference and a source of official asylum statistics. The first section provides an overview of asylum statistics for 2007 in all ten countries, while the second section features country specific data covering the period of 2003-2007.

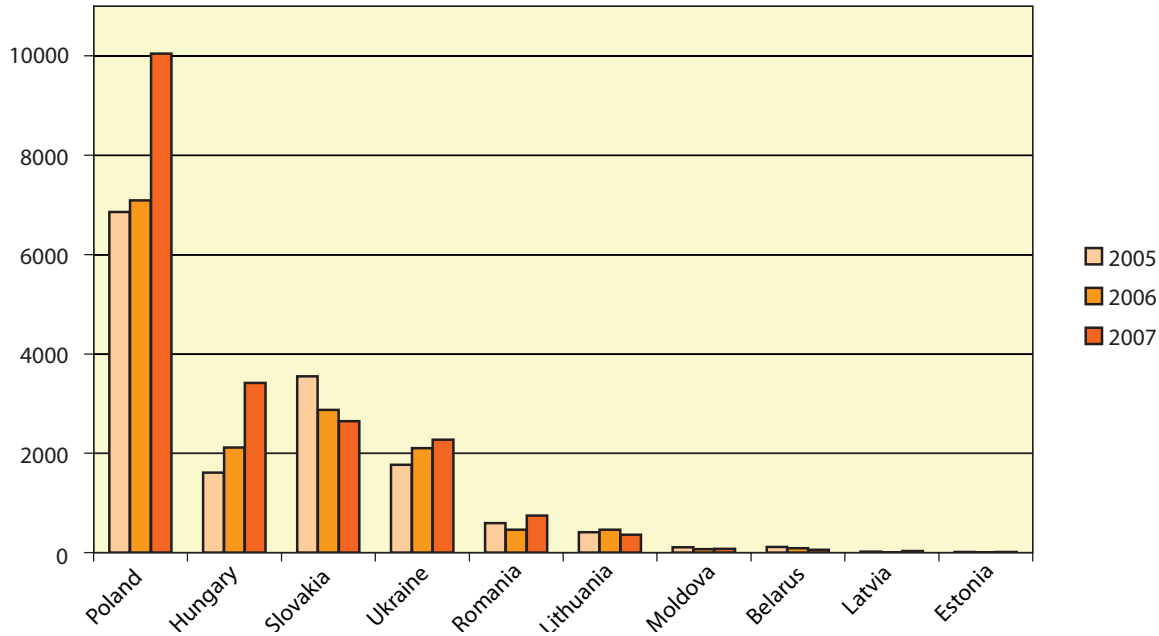

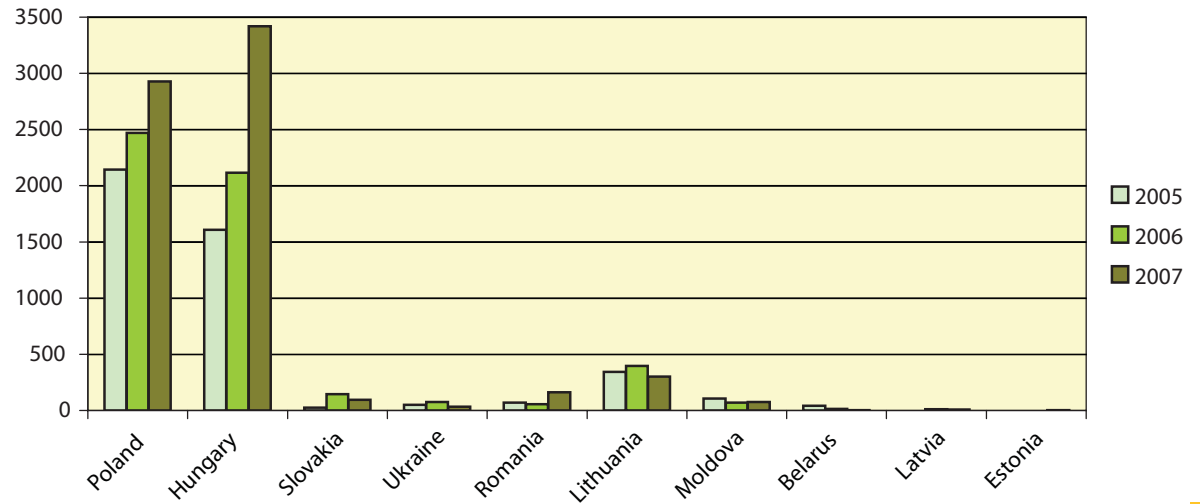

**Refugee and subsidiary status received, 2005-2007**



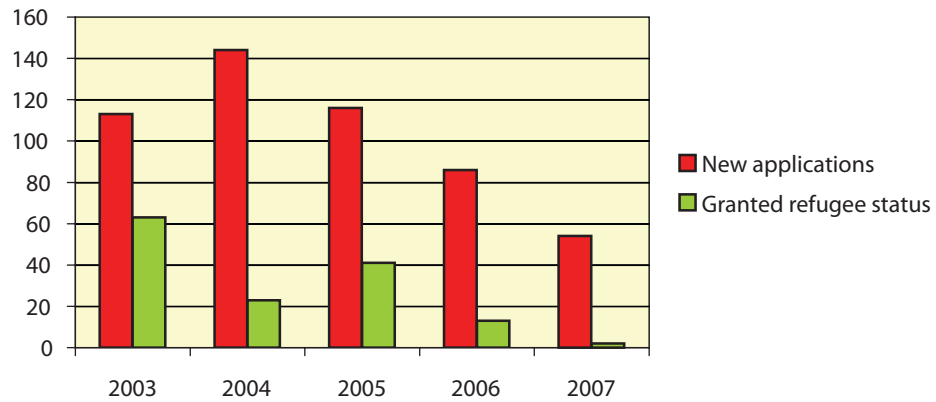

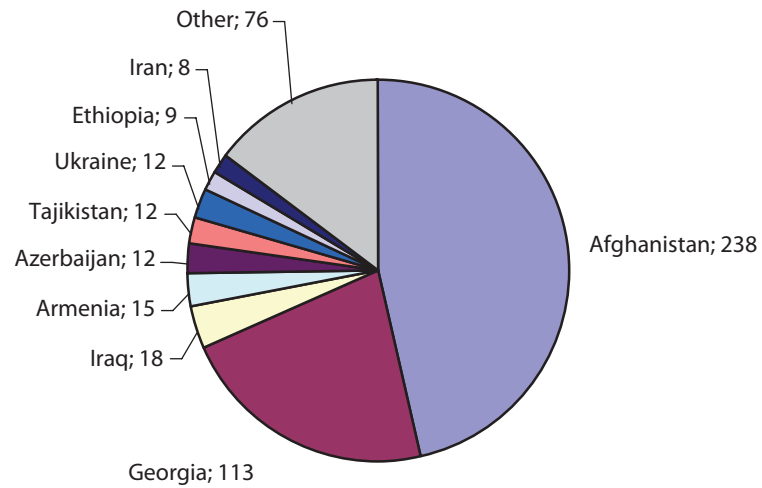

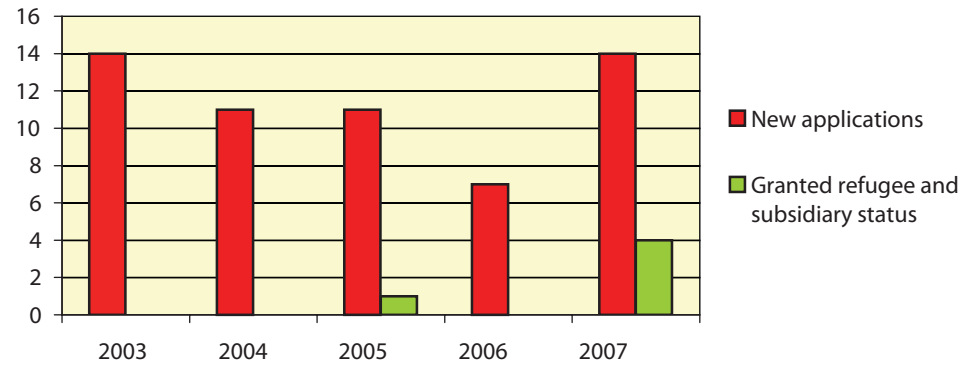

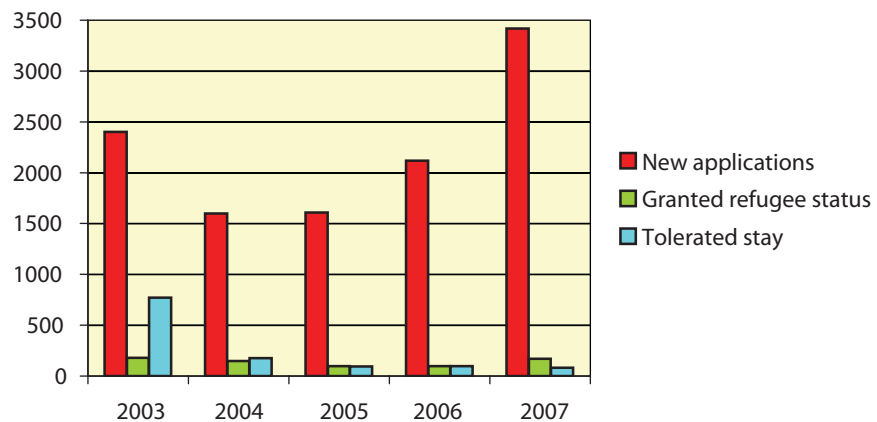

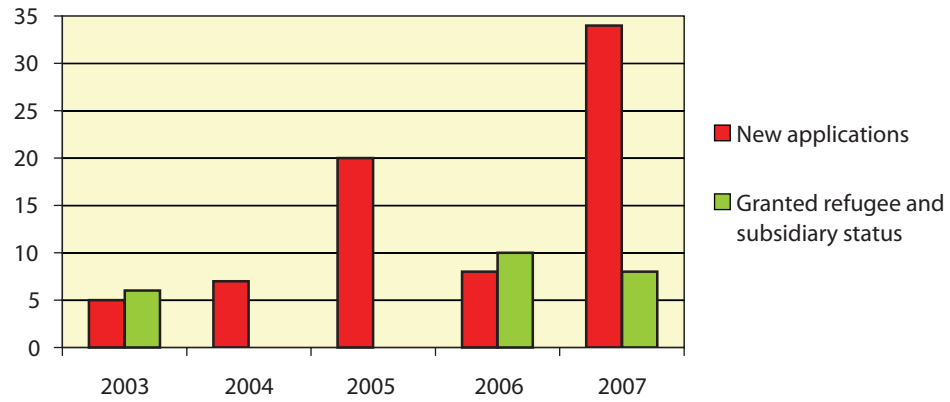

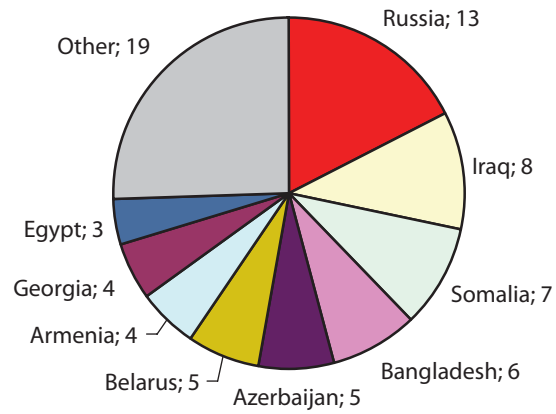

### Main countries of application, 2003–2007



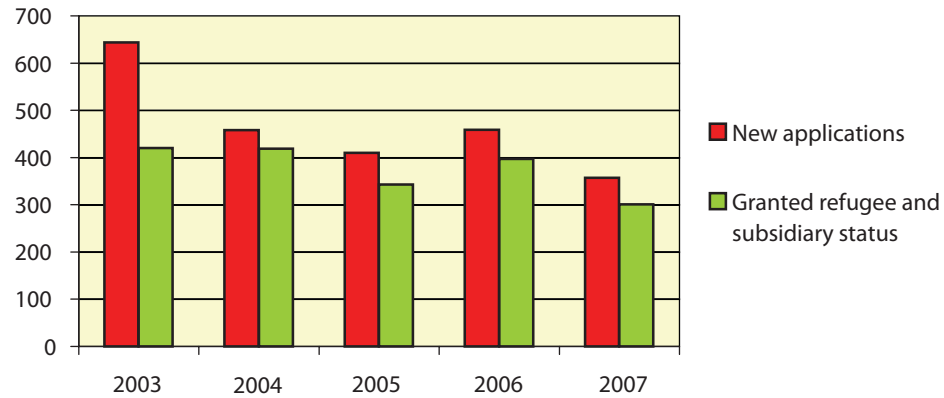

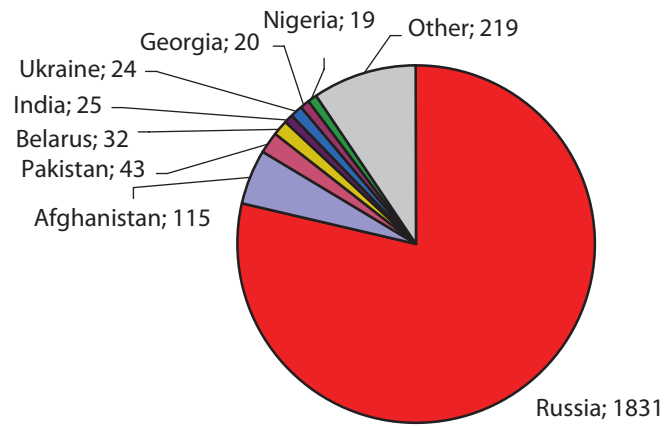

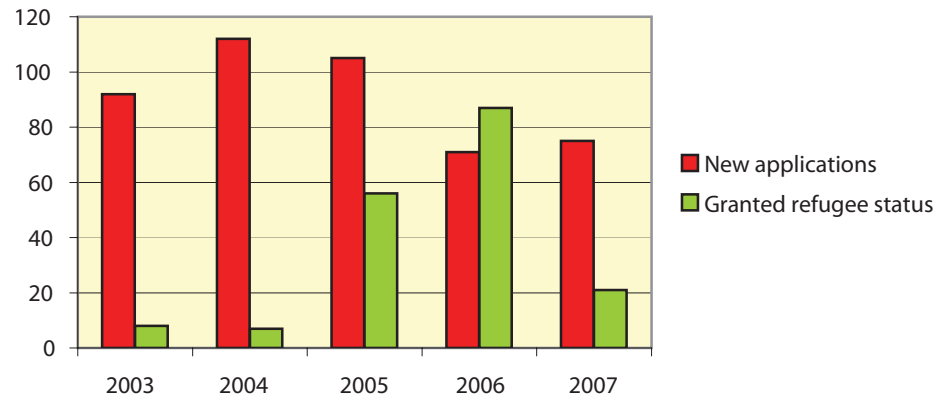




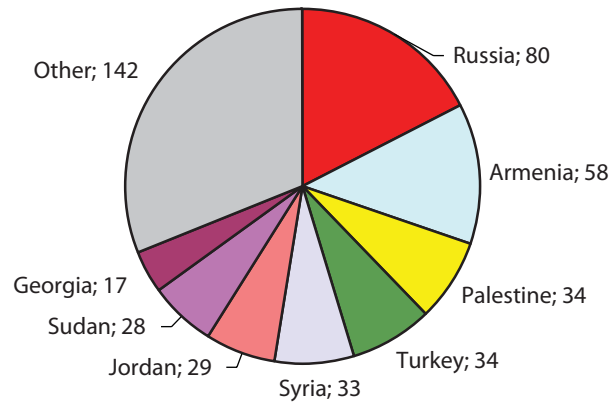

### Main countries of application, 2003–2007



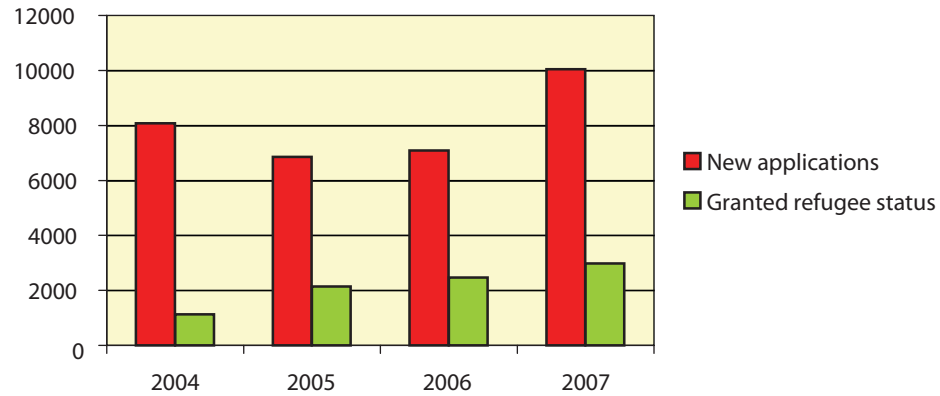

### Main countries of application, 2003–2007



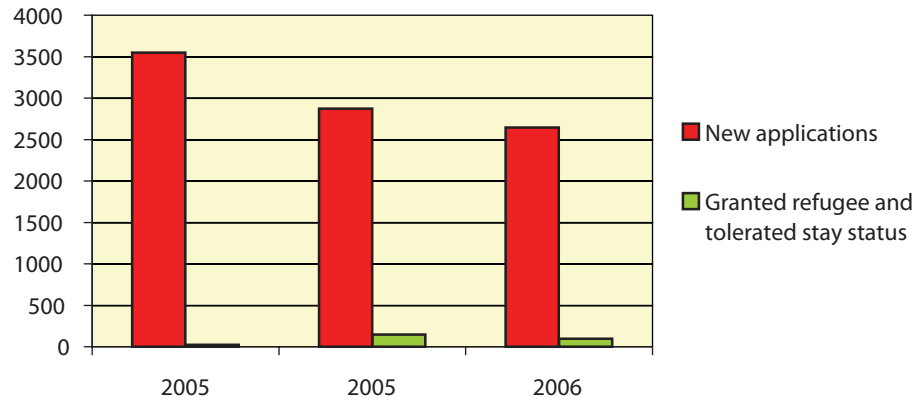

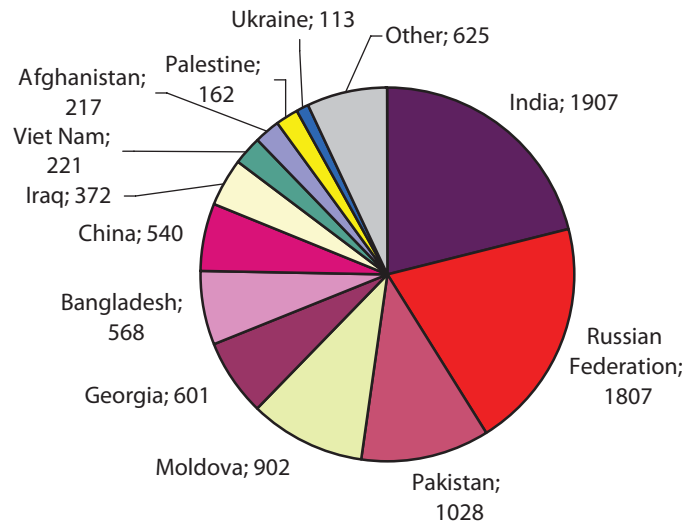

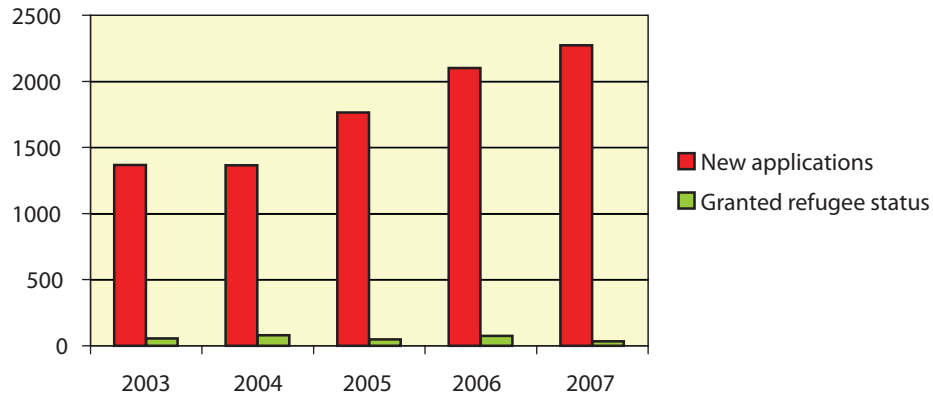
