“Approval of the 2012-2014 Action Plan for the Implementation of the State Strategy on IDPs “amendment to the decree N1162 June 13, 2012 of Government of Georgia

“Approval of the 2012-2014 Action Plan for the Implementation of the State Strategy on IDPs “approved by the decree N1162 June 13, 2012 of Government of Georgia, in “2012-2014 Action Plan for the Implementation of the State Strategy on IDPs “ (herein “the action plan or AP) amended as follows:

- a) Action Plan 2.2.2. subparagraph shall be amended and edited as follows:

Other alternative DHS including: rehabilitation of idle buildings, construction of new apartment blocks and other IDP accommodation and transfer of accommodation units to the ownership of IDPs, also allocation of individual houses purchased or constructed in rural areas to IDPs. These solutions will be offered to IDPs living in CCs not subject to rehabilitation and/or privatization and extremely vulnerable privately accommodated as well as homeless IDPs.

- b) Action Plan 5.1 Paragraph shall be amended and edited as follows:

5.1 Overall coordination of the AP is the responsibility of the steering Committee. The Steering Committee is MRA chaired decision making body formed to coordinate joint effort by the Government of Georgia and international organizations in operationalizing and implementing the State Strategy for IDPs and its Action Plan. Members of Steering Committee consist of: MRA, MoLHSA, Ministry of Justice, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development, Ministry of Regional Development and Infrastructure, Ministry of Agriculture, LEPL Municipal Development Fund of Georgia, Office of Public Defender of Georgia, EC, EUMM, SDC UNHCR, UNCT, USAID, WB, SIDA, KFW; Two representative from NGO community, with advisory vote, (1 native and 1 international) are also members of Steering Committee.

Representatives of other organizations can be invited by the Steering Committee to its meetings in order to provide input on specific issue. The members of the Steering Committee are nominated by the above mentioned organizations and approved by MRA Ministerial decree. Each organization has one vote to approve the decision of the Steering Committee. Minutes are taken which the chairman and Secretary of the steering Committee sign. In cases where any SC members do not agree with a decision, he/she has the right to share his/ her position in the meeting minutes.
