1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Criminal Code Amendment Regulations 2010 (No. 3)*.

4F Terrorist organisations — Al-Qa'ida in the Islamic Maghreb (AQIM)

- (1) For paragraph (b) of the definition of *terrorist organisation* in subsection 102.1 (1) of the Code, the organisation known as Al-Qa'ida in the Islamic Maghreb (AQIM) is specified.
- (2) For subregulation (1), Al-Qa'ida in the Islamic Maghreb (AQIM) is also known by the following names:
 - (a) Al-Qa'ida in the Lands of the Islamic Maghreb (AQLIM);
 - (b) Le Groupe Salafiste Pour La Predication et le Combat;
 - (c) Salafist Group for Call and Combat;
 - (d) Salafist Group for Preaching and Combat (GSPC);
 - (e) Tanzim al-Qa'ida fi bilad al-Maghreb al-Islamiya.
