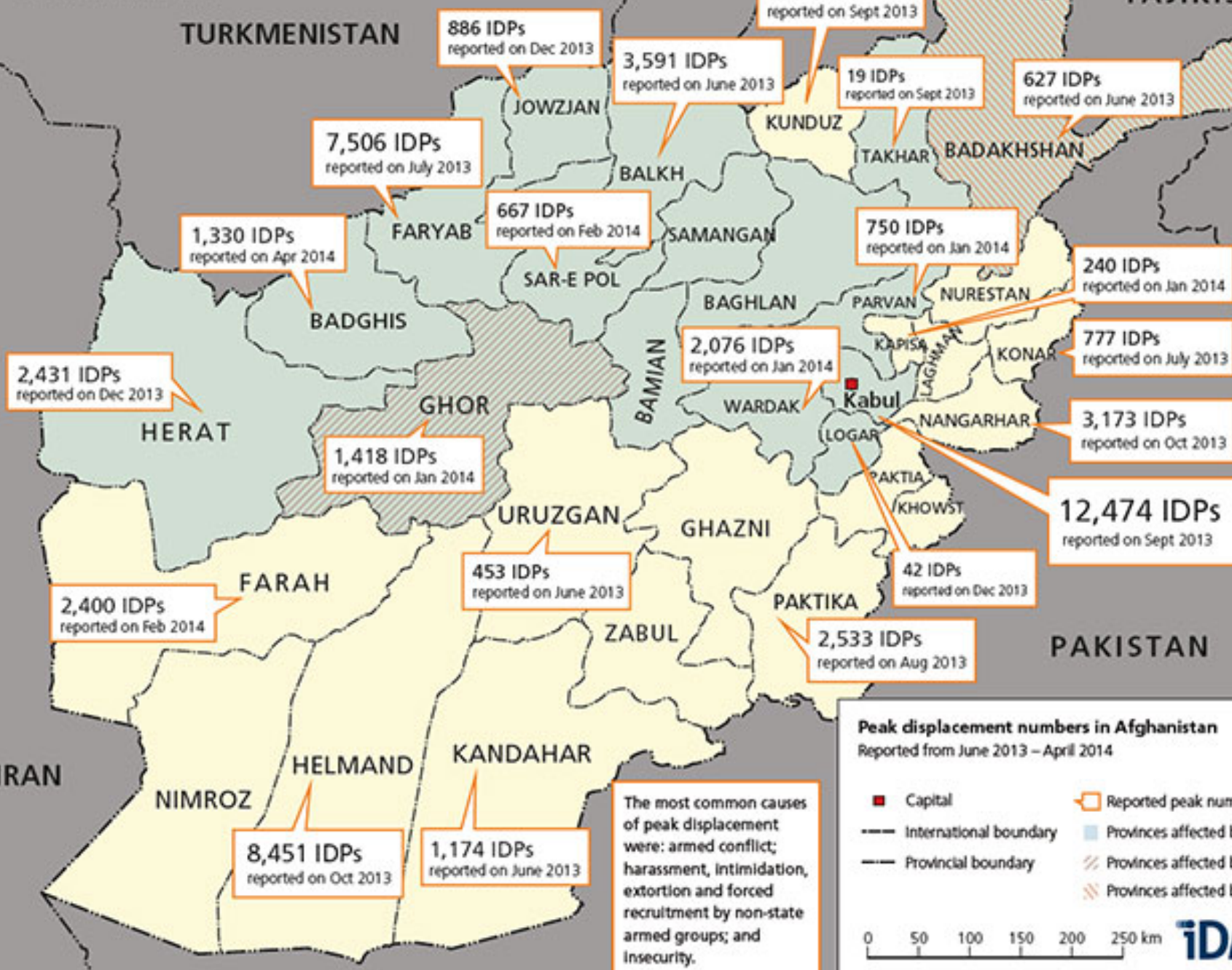

The most common causes of peak displacement were: armed conflict; harassment, intimidation, extortion and forced recruitment by non-state armed groups; and insecurity.
