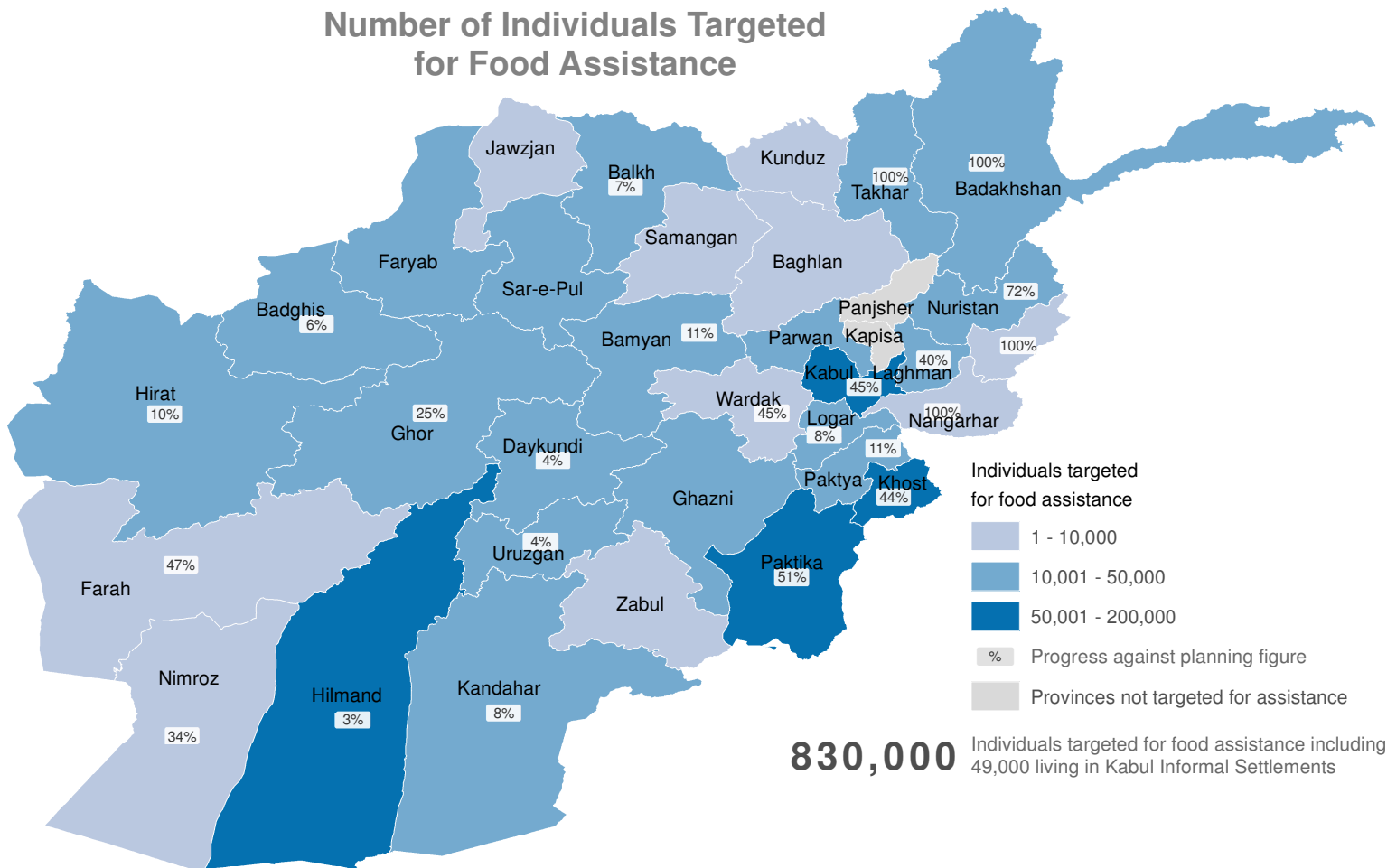
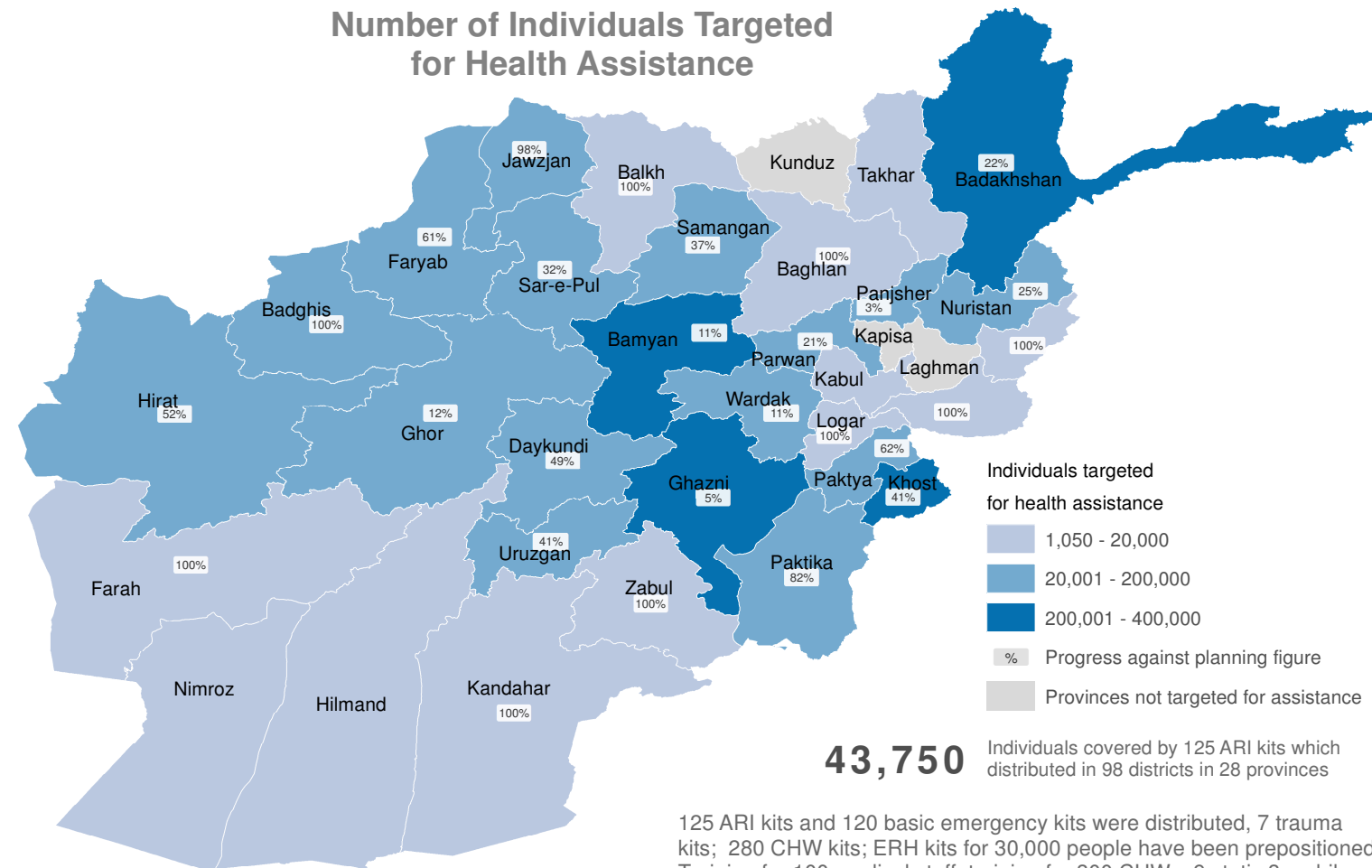


Number of Individuals Targeted for Food Assistance

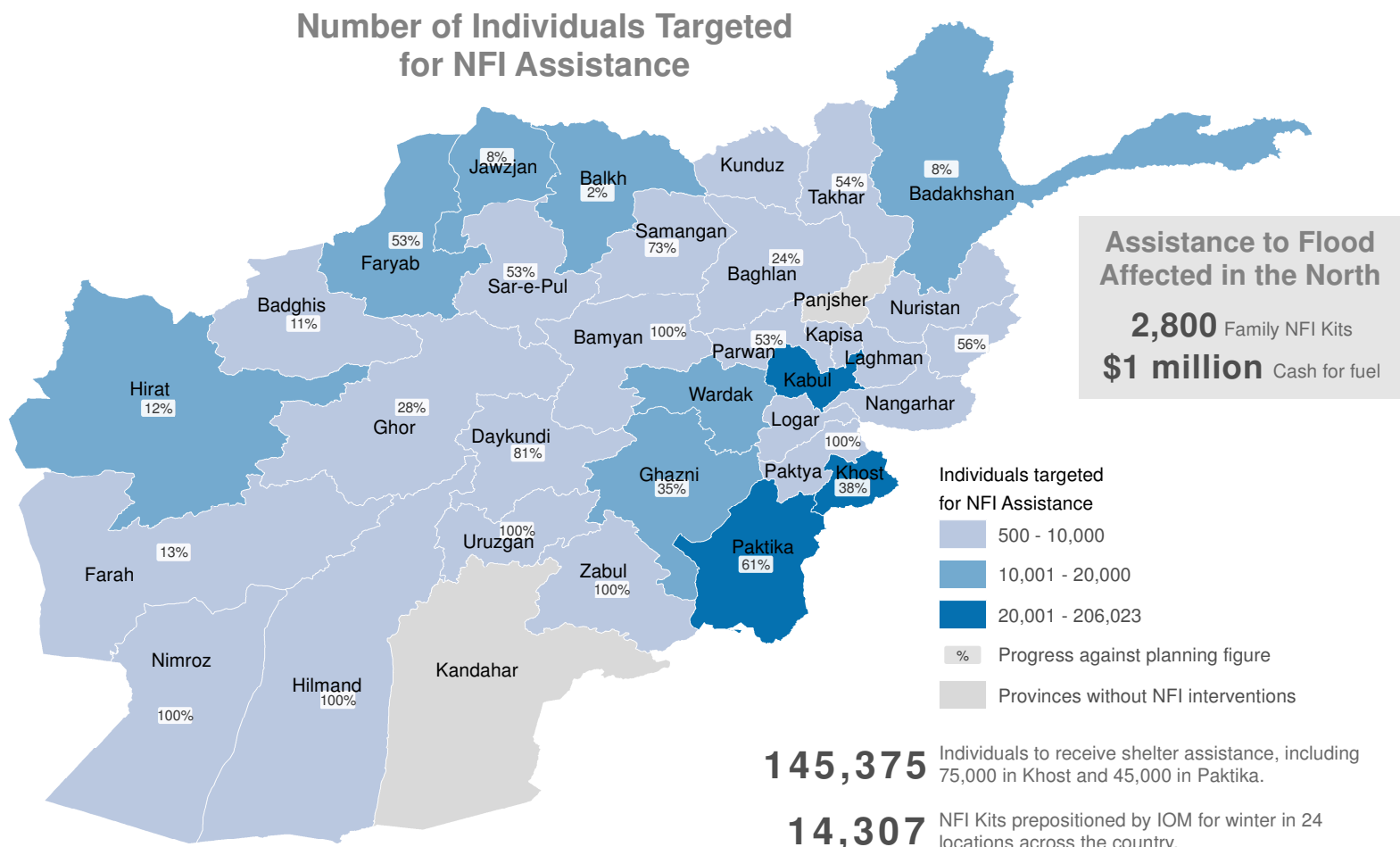


Number of Individuals Targeted for Health Assistance



125 ARI kits and 120 basic emergency kits were distributed, 7 trauma kits; 280 CHW kits; ERH kits for 30,000 people have been prepositioned. Training for 100 medical staff, training for 300 CHWs, 9 static 3 mobile health facilities (by health cluster) and 3 temporary clinics and 4 Mobile Health Teams will be established by partners.

Number of Individuals Targeted for NFI Assistance

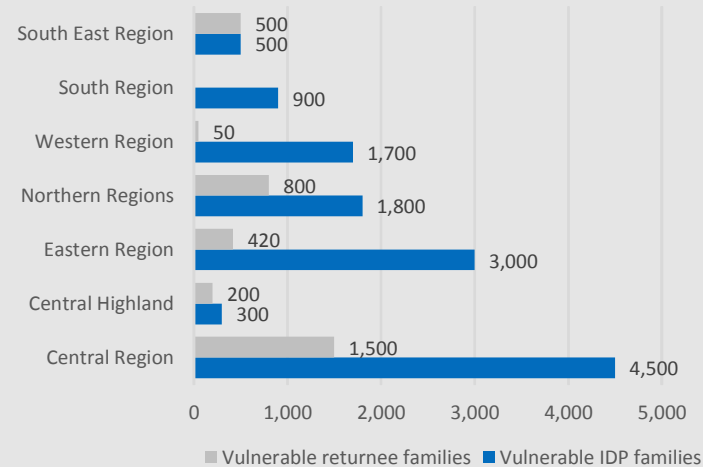


Assistance to Flood Affected in the North

Assistance to Vulnerable IDP Families and Vulnerable Returned Refugees

UNHCR estimates 12,700 vulnerable IDP families and 3,470 returned refugee families will be assisted through the winter months. Modalities of assistance and collective packages/relief items are currently under discussion.
