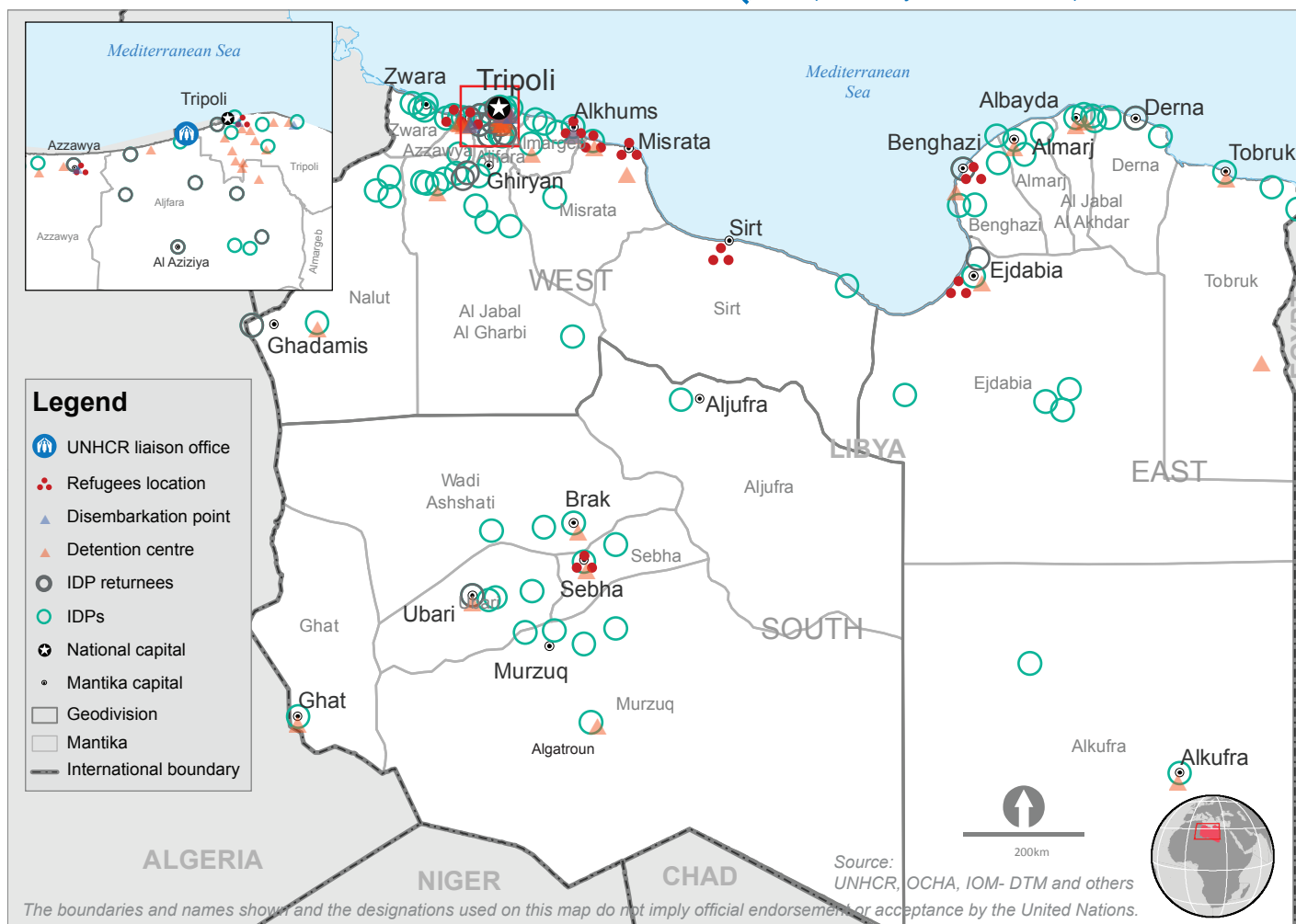

-  **13** capacity building events for stakeholders

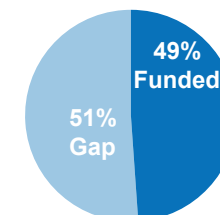


UNHCR Funding Requirements
