Pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph A of Article 42 of the Constitution, the

Revolutionary Command Council has decreed the following:

First – Palestinians permanently residing in Iraqi shall be treated as Iraqis in

respect of all rights and duties, with the exception of the right to the Iraqi

nationality.

Second – The members of the Revolutionary Command Council and Deputies of

the Prime Minister shall have the power to detain every employee who acts in

contradiction with the provisions of this Resolution. The employee's matter shall

be submitted to the Prime Minister six months after his commitment to prison.

Third – Any provision in contradiction with the provisions of this Resolution shall

not be enforced.

Fourth – This Resolution shall come into effect on the date of publication in the

Official Gazette.
