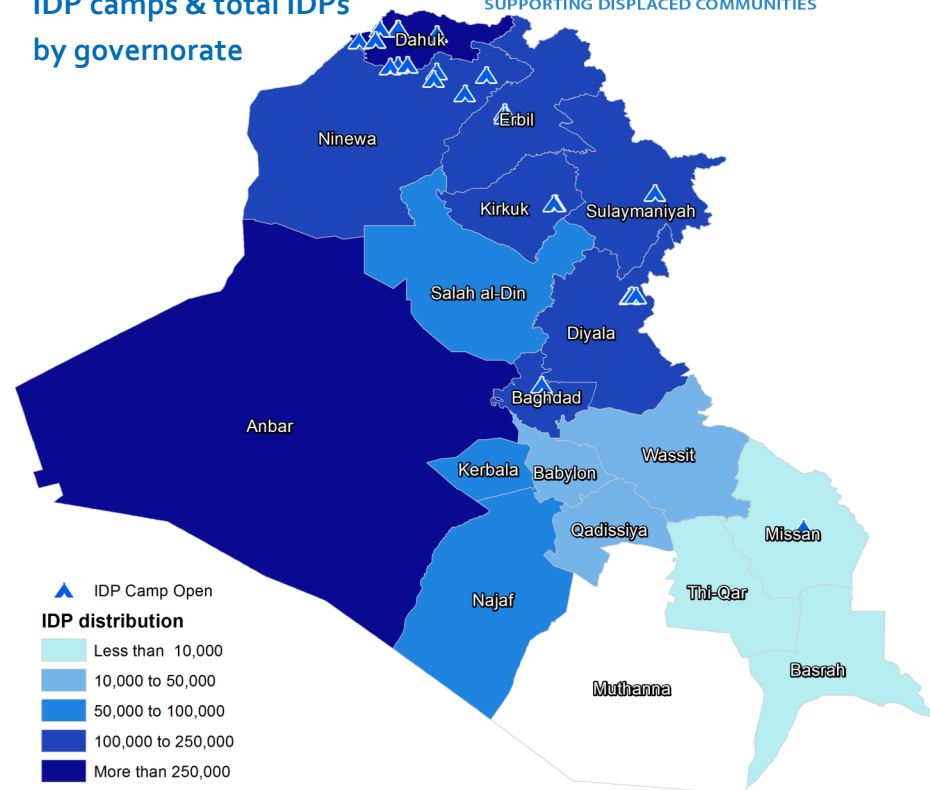

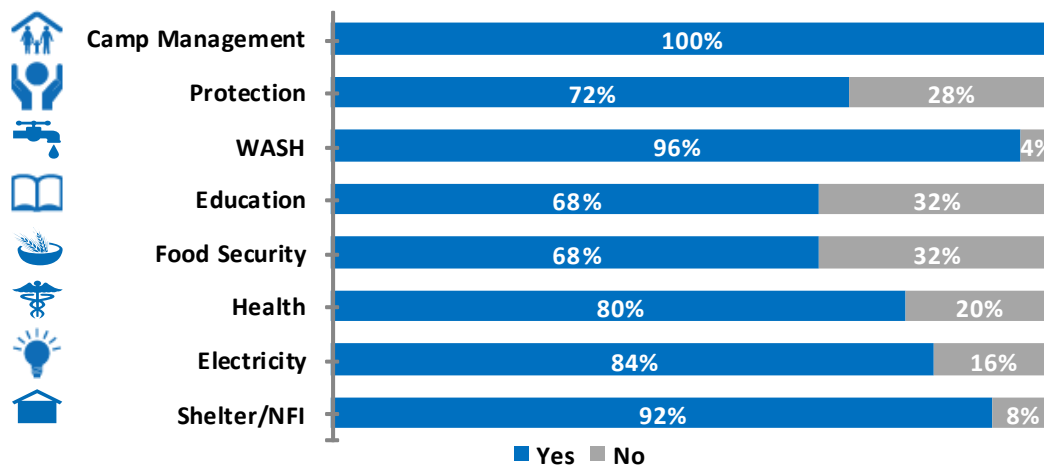

IDP camps & total IDPs by governorate

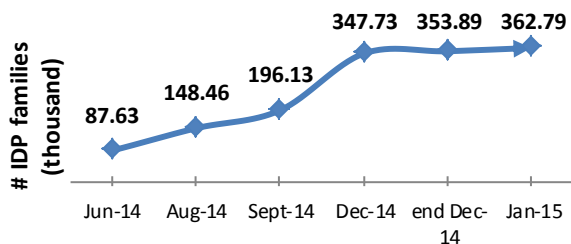

Operational presence of partners, reported by sectors, in the IDP camps:



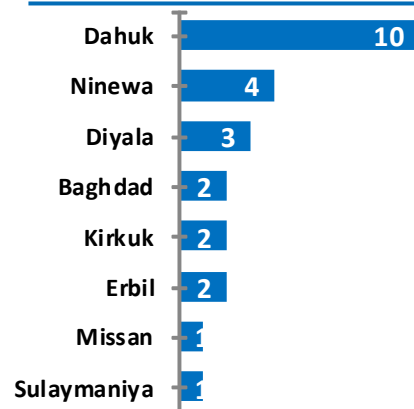
IDP displacement timeline



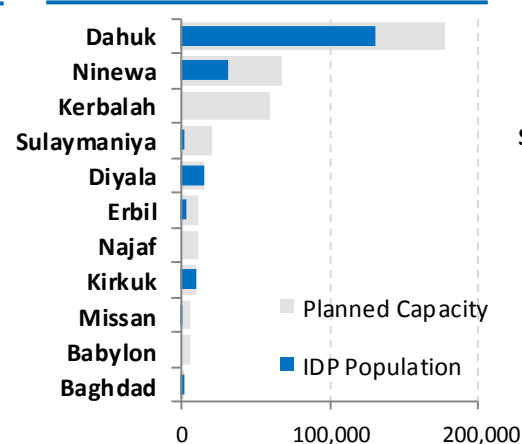
CCCM Role:

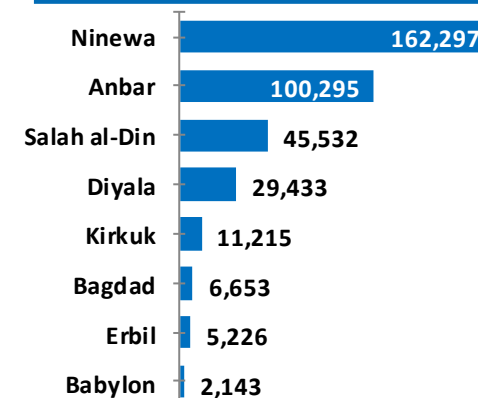
Open IDP camps:
