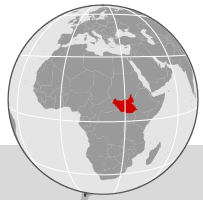


South Sudan: Registered refugees by nationality and location (state)

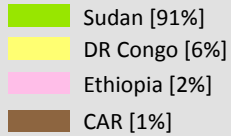

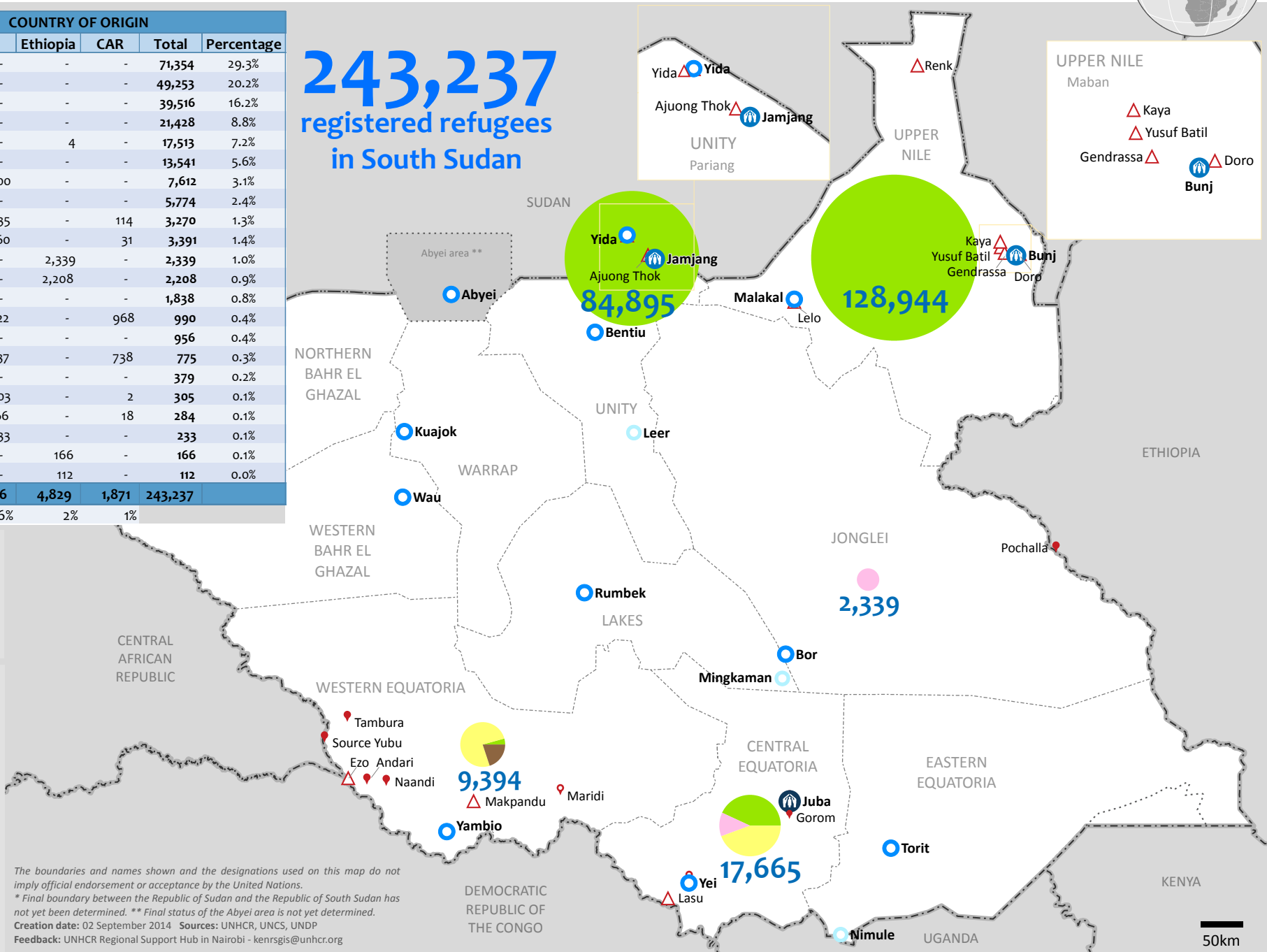
