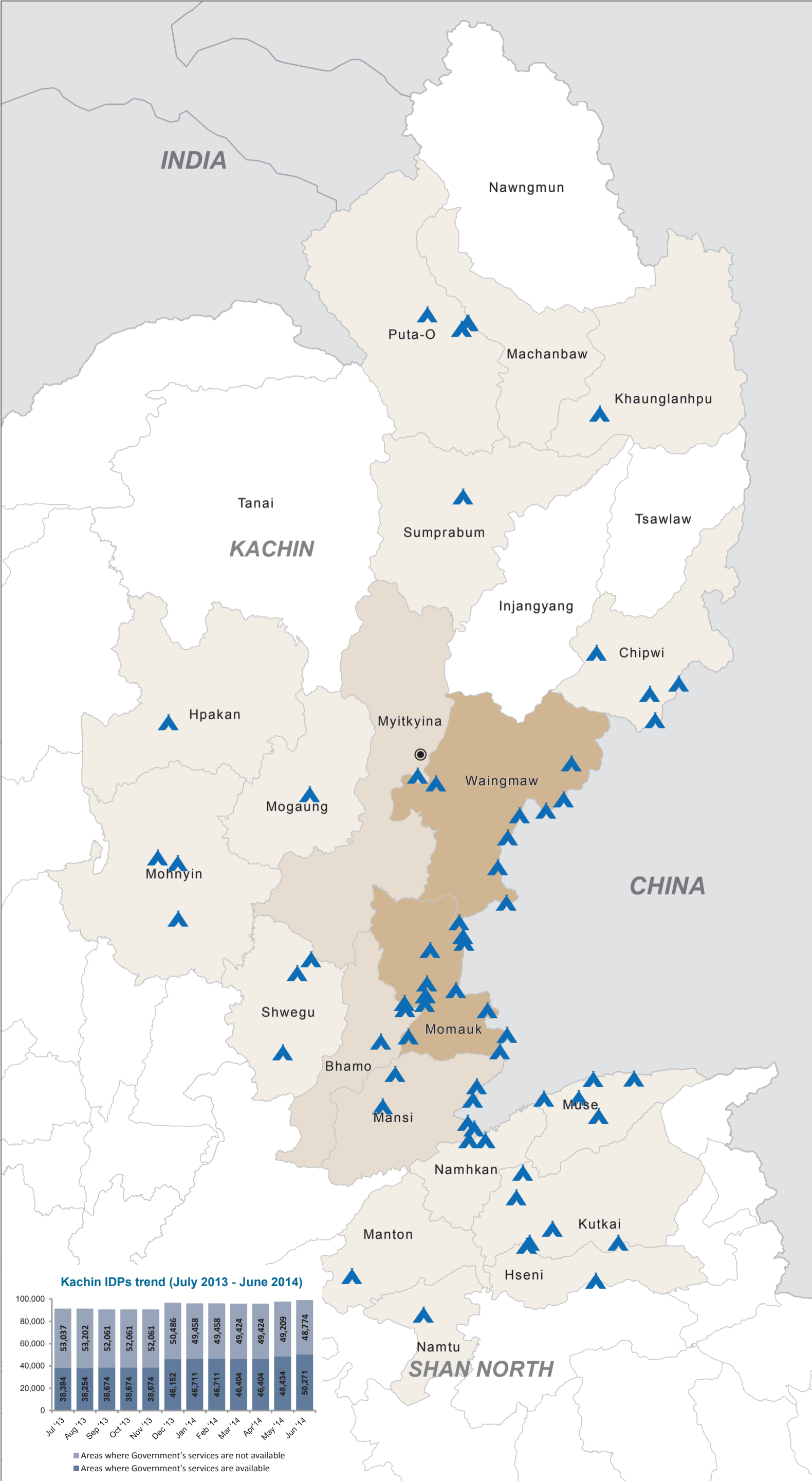


Myanmar: Internal Displacement in Kachin and northern Shan States (1 June 2014)

IDPs per Township

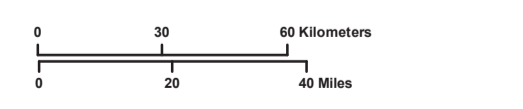
